BE GENTLE RETIRED

Multiple graded stakes winner **Be Gentle** (Tale of the Cat--Gentlelilstar, by Risen Star) has been retired from racing after suffering a fracture to her right front ankle.

As a two-year-old last season, the filly won the GII Darley Alcibiades S., GII Golden Rod S. and GIII Debutante S. She was also second in the GI Spinaway S. The injury was discovered after her win in the Golden Rod S. last November. The dark bay filly, trained by D. Wayne Lukas, was on the

board in five of seven starts, with four wins and earnings of \$523,078. She is owned by Tom Van Meter, partner in Eaton Sales. Breeding plans are uncertain.

DOLLAR BILL'S STUD CAREER DELAYED

Dollar Bill (Peaks and Valleys--Saratoga Dame, by Saratoga Six) will miss the 2004 breeding season as he continues to suffer from the effects of a fetlock injury which caused his retirement from racing last summer. The six-year-old underwent surgery to repair his right fetlock, but then suffered laminitis in his left front fetlock. Dollar Bill had been expected to begin his stud career this year at Signature Stallions in Reddick, Florida. "We are very disappointed that Dollar Bill could not enter stud in 2004 as he would have easily been one of the most popular stallions in Florida this year," Adam Staple, stallion coordinator for Signature Stallions, told *Thoroughbred Times*. "But more important is the horse's health. This horse had way too much talent and heart to bring him to stud at anything under 100 percent for breeding." Dollar Bill won the 2000 GII Brown and Williamson Kentucky Jockey Club S., was second in the 2002 GI Stephen Foster H. and third in the 2001 GI Travers, GI Toyota Blue Grass S., 2002 GI Oaklawn H. and 2003 GI Suburban H.

FIRST FLORIDA BREEZE FOR TAPIT

Tapit (Pulpit), impressive winner of the GIII Laurel Futurity last November, had his first Florida breeze Tuesday at the Palm Meadows Training Center as he eyes a possible GI Florida Derby berth. The colt worked an easy seven furlongs in 1:30 3/5 for trainer Michael Dickinson. "He had four breezes in Maryland before shipping," Dickinson said. "So far, so good. We don't know yet where or when his first race will be. When I get him fitter [Winchell Thoroughbreds racing manager] Solomon Fiske will pick out a race for him. We realize we have a lot to prove. We'll start to see

what we have soon." Undeclared in two starts, Tapit won his Oct. 19 debut at Delaware Park by 7 3/4 lengths before his 4 3/4-length Futurity victory. "He's a happy horse," Dickinson commented. "He's a very intelligent horse and he seems to enjoy his life no matter where he is. There's the saying that life is boring for boring people. Well, this horse is not a boring person. He'd make fun no matter where he goes." One thing Tapit is not is apparently for sale. According to *The Blood-Horse*, Winchell Thoroughbreds has turned down an offer from Michael Gill of \$3 million for the colt.

Lopez Wins 3000th:

Jockey Chuck "C.C." Lopez recorded his 3000th victory with a win in the seventh race at Aqueduct Thursday. Aboard 5-2 second choice Sunnyridge Sam, the 43-year-old Brooklyn native improved his record to 3,000 wins, 2,611 seconds and 2,448 show finishes from 20,182 lifetime starts. "I can't tell you what it means to me," Lopez said. "I consider Aqueduct a home away from home. It was nice to do it here. I hope I can continue performing at this level."

Trio of Million Dollar Races at Woodbine in '04:

A trio of million-dollar-plus races highlight the 2004 stakes schedule at Woodbine. In all 101 stakes races, worth \$20 million, will be offered at the Toronto track this year. The prestigious Queen's Plate, first leg of Canada's Triple Crown, will be worth \$1 million and is scheduled to be run June 27. The Breeders' S., third leg of the Triple Crown, will be run Aug. 8 and offers a purse of \$500,000. An additional \$500,000 bonus will be offered if a horse sweeps the Triple Crown, which includes the July 18 Prince of Wales S. run at Fort Erie. The richest event on the stakes schedule is the \$1.5-million GI Pattison Canadian International. The 1 1/2-mile turf event will be run Oct. 24, the same day as the \$750,000 GI E. P. Taylor and \$250,000 GII Nearctic S. The eighth renewal of the GI Atto Mile, worth \$1 million, will be held Sept. 19. "We try to build and strengthen our stakes schedule each and every year," said Chris Evans, Woodbine Entertainment's Director of Thoroughbred Racing. "And I believe we've done it again in 2004." Woodbine's 167-day meet opens Apr. 17.

WATHAB JOINS WELD'S WORLD

Haif Mohammed Al-Ghatani's **Wathab (Ire)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) has been added to Dermot Weld's team for the upcoming flat season. Formerly trained by Kevin Prendergast, the three-year-old finished a length runner-up to One Cool Cat in the G1 National S. at The Curragh in September after winning the Listed Round Tower S. at that track at the end of August. Weld also revealed that three-time G1 Irish St Leger winner **Vinnie Roe (Ire)** (Definite Article {GB}) would be aimed at the G1 Ascot Gold Cup at the Royal meeting in June; he was the runner-up in that race two years ago. "He's a tough and genuine horse and we can look forward to a very big year," the Rosewell House conditioner said. "He will be aimed at the top staying races, including the Ascot Gold Cup, which will be his first major target. He could well end up in the G1 Melbourne Cup, but there are no definite plans as yet." Weld has yet to commit last year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile eighth **Relaxed Gesture (Ire)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}) to the GI Belmont S., but described him as a "nice colt who learned a lot from the Juvenile," adding that "we'll see how he progresses, but it is an obvious target."
