But the Juddmonte Farms homebred failed to fire on racing's championship day and finished a distant fourth. "If she doesn't win this race, I'll probably never run her at Santa Anita again," trainer Bobby Frankel told Daily Racing Form. Sightseek makes her five-year-old debut in the Santa Monica. She faces Got Koko (Signal Tap) and Island Fashion (Petionville), who are both Grade I winners at Santa Anita. Got Koko, five-for-eight at the track, swept the 2002-2003 La Canada series. Freshened after running fourth in the GI Santa Margarita H. last March, she came back to finish second behind Azeri in the Aug. 10 GII Clement L. Hirsch at Del Mar, then added another Santa Anita score in the Sept. 28 GII Lady's Secret Breeders' Cup H. She has not been out since running third in the Breeders' Cup Distaff, but has been working sharply for her 2004 opener. Island Fashion comes off a scintillating six-length victory in the GI La Brea S. over track and trip.

#### A MILLION REASONS TO SMILE

Southern Image (Halo's Image), the winner in his most recent start of the seven-furlong GI Malibu S. Dec. 26, proved he is an equally good router after scoring a three-length victory in the Sunshine Millions Classic yesterday at Santa Anita. "The Malibu was very nice, but this is special, too," said winning trainer Mike Machowsky. "I couldn't be happier." Sidelined off a third to Kafwain in the GII San Vicente S. last February, the Florida-bred took a Del Mar allowance going two turns Aug. 2, but did not reappear until the Malibu. Sent up to stalk the pace of Excess Summer (In Excess {Ire}) from the outside, Southern Image kicked on gamely three wide into the stretch, took command in upper stretch and edged clear. Favored Peace Rules (Jules) attempted to race from off the pace, but never factored and put in a mild late bid to finish fourth. "He was strong when I didn't want him to be strong," commented jockey Jerry Bailey. "He very much resented trying to lay off the pace."

Fire Slam, who reportedly popped a quarter crack after kicking a stall door recently, certainly showed no ill effects yesterday, coming from just off the pace to take the Lecomte in his three-year-old debut. The handsome bay overcame a slow start to take his Oct. 15 debut at Keeneland and made it two straight with a 3/4-length allowance victory at Churchill Downs Nov. 15. Stretched out to a distance of ground in his latest, the colt was once again sluggish at the start, but rallied willingly to finish a strong second in the \$1-million Delta Jackpot S. at Delta Downs Dec. 5. Smoothly into stride this time around, Fire Slam stalked the early pace set by Two Down Automatic before going up after that rival with a quarter mile to run. The Stan Fulton colorbearer eased by that one in upper stretch and finished with good energy to easily account for the previously undefeated Shadowland. "He had his ears pinned back and was very comfortable," said winning rider Shane Sellers. "He stayed very alert throughout the race and when I nudged him, he responded very well." Beaten a nose in the GII Kelso Breeders' Cup H. Oct. 4, the Florida-bred was third in the Bonnie Heath Turf Cup Nov. 15 at Calder before being freshened up. He returned to run third in the GIII Appleton H. over this course Jan. 4 and went postward as the third choice in this 11-horse field. Jockey Rene Douglas settled the six-year-old in midpack as longshot Hear No Evil tried to take it all the way up front. Switched to the outside on the far turn, Proud Man shifted gears and took aim on the pacesetter, collaring him inside the final sixteenth and going on to win by a half-length. Valentine Dancer had traded decisions with several runners in this contest, but parlayed a perfect trip into a decision over main rival Moscow Burning. A threelength winner of the one-mile Harold C. Ramser H. over this course Oct. 12, she settled for third to Moscow Burning in the 10-furlong California Cup Distance H. Nov. 8 before winning the Cat's Cradle H. versus statebreds Dec. 14. The Cal-bred settled into a ground-saving fourth while favored Atlantic Ocean (Stormy Atlantic) went up to show the way. She had to wait for room at the top of the stretch, but came through a seam willingly under Jon Court and finished strongly up the rail to get the victory. "The owner and trainer gave me explicit and credible instructions of not only how to ride the race, but how the horse likes to run," said Court. "I just followed the directions to a 'T'. She is pretty much a push-button ride." Forced to take the overland route from post 11, Moscow Burning came up 3/4 of a length short. "He [jockey Jose Valdivia Jr.] got hung out to dry on both turns," said trainer Jim Cassidy, "and the other horse got the dream trip coming through on the inside." Though Florida-breds wound up winning six of the eight events in the Sunshine Millions, the F/M Turf featured California-breds sweeping the trifecta.


Sent off at 74-1, Secret Request came bounding up on the outside to spring the biggest upset of the Sunshine Millions, edging defending champion Smok'n Frolic in this \$500,000 contest. After winning a Calder optional claimer going a mile Oct. 20, the bay couldn't get there against some of these rivals, running third to Scapade and Redoubled Miss (Adhocracy) in the Elmer Huebeck Distaff Nov. 15 and a close fourth to the latter in the Stage Door Betty H. at Calder Dec. 27. At the back of the pack through the opening half mile, Secret Request began to move up while saving ground, then angled to the outside and finished up strongly to deny Smok'n Frolic. The 2-1 favorite House Party (French Deputy) failed to mount a serious challenge and finished seventh, while the vaunted Pesci (Stormy Atlantic) was a flat ninth at 7-2. The bay returned to the East Coast to take the Dec. 7 Bluffs Dividend S. going five furlongs on the turf at Calder, and kicked off her 2004 campaign with a second in the Jan. 3 Minaret S. at Tampa Bay Downs. Overlooked by the California racing fans on Sunshine Millions Day, Mooji Moo broke well and went right to the lead. She zipped through fractions of :21.67 and :44.24, opened up a couple of lengths on the field at midtretch and was all out to hold off 49-1 Bold Roberta to the wire. "All I had to do was keep her out of trouble and get her around the racetrack and that's what I did," jockey Corey Nakatani said. Added Bruce Brown, assistant to trainer Tim Hills, "I wasn't really expecting the other horses to let her go like that. If she can get a breather around the turn, she's usually pretty tough." In her most recent effort, the Cal-bred hopped at the start, but recovered nicely and charged home a three-length winner of the California Breeders' Champion S. Dec. 27, defeating Yearly Report, who would return to win the GIII Santa Ynez S. A sluggish start cost Silent Sighs early position and she was forced to wait in behind horses. Still crying out for room in upper stretch, she found a seam inside the final furlong and was all out for the win. "It kind of reminded me of a French race on the turf where they only race the last 200 yards," commented winning trainer Julio Canani, who said his filly would get a break before being aimed for the GI Kentucky Oaks Apr. 30. He won't let anybody by him, that's for sure." As for the favorite, jockey Jerry Bailey said, "It was kind of a screwed up race. I couldn't get him to give me a solid eighth of a mile anywhere. #### Valenzuela Suspended After Missing Drug Test:

Jockey Patrick Valenzuela was suspended by Santa Anita stewards Friday a day after taking off his mounts and not appearing for a drug test. Valenzuela had called steward Ingrid Fermin mid-day Thursday to report he had twisted an ankle leaving his house on the way to the track and was unable to ride. According to *Daily Racing Form*, the stewards asked Valenzuela to appear for a routine drug test, which the 41-year-old rider is required to do under an agreement with the California Horse Racing Board. Pending a hearing before the Board of Stewards at Santa Anita, Valenzuela is denied access to all premises in the jurisdiction, and cannot work horses during the ban. Valenzuela, who swept all five California riding titles in 2003, is an Eclipse Award finalist.

#### Action This Day Tunes Up for Sham:

Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner **Action This Day** (Kris S.) sharpened up for the Feb. 8 Sham S. with a stiff one-mile workout yesterday in 1:37 4/5 at Santa Anita. Trained by Richard Mandella for B. Wayne Hughes, the \$150,000 Keeneland July graduate was to have made his three-year-old bow in the GII Santa Catalina S. Jan. 17, but was instead rerouted to the Sham, which drew the likes of Empire Maker and Ten Most Wanted in 2002.

#### California Workers' Comp. Woes Continue:

New California Governor Arnold Schwarzenneger Thursday vetoed a bill which would have provided relief to the state's racing industry, according to the California Thoroughbred Breeders' Association website. The bill, which called for a .5 percent increase in the takeout for exotic wagers on California races, would have generated approximately \$10 million in an effort to offset the cost of insurance. Schwarzenegger's veto message said: "I have several concerns with this bill, which would allow money, allocated from an increase in the takeout from the pari-mutuel pools on horse races in California, to be used to help defray the cost of workers' compensation insurance within the California horse racing industry. While I agree with the concept in this bill, providing additional takeout to help defray increased workers' compensation costs for horse racing, the entire workers' compensation system needs to be reformed in a comprehensive manner. As with other industries in California, the racing industry is severely impacted by the workers' compensation crisis." The bill had passed cleanly through the Assembly 78-0, and its supporters were not expecting a veto by the governor. Assemblyman Jerome Horton has reintroduced an amended bill.
