"That looks great right now," Machowsky said of the Big 'Cap, "but I'm going to be real light on him for just a week, freshen him up a little bit and go from there." Machowsky also mentioned the GI Met Mile at Belmont in May as a possible aim for the lightly raced Southern Image, winner of the GI Malibu S. last month. "That's the ultimate goal for the next few months," Machow-sky said. "It's a good race and a perfect distance for him, I think, and it's a Grade I. If he cooperates, the Big 'Cap is definitely a possibility."

SHAKE YOU DOWN NOT SHOOK UP Trainer Scott Lake's Shake You Down (Montbrook) was in pristine condition following his facile victory in the Padua Stables Sprint at Gulfstream Park. "It's like he didn't even race," said Lake. "He came back great. He's doing perfectly." The gelding, making his seasonal debut, was impressive in beating Green Team (Huddle Up) by three lengths. Regarding future plans, Lake explained, "We've got plenty of time to figure out where to go next. We know we're not going to Dubai with him. The \$2 million purse is tempting, but there's no Lasix allowed there. We'll see how he bounces out of this."
