MEDAGLIA D'ORO TAKES DONN GOLD

Medaglia d'Oro (El Prado {Ire}) strode home imperiously yesterday to add the GI Donn H. to his trophy collection. The handsome five-year-old capped a big day for trainer Bobby Frankel, who saddled Miss Coronado

to win the GII Davona Dale S. earlier on the card at Gulfstream Park. It was the fourth straight win at nine furlongs for Medaglia d'Oro, who has come up second-best in 10-furlong events such as the GI Breeders' Cup Classic (twice) and the GI Pacific Classic. "Bailey [jockey Jerry]

said this was one of his strongest races," said Frankel. "We'll go back to California tomorrow. I really haven't figured out what's next, maybe Dubai [G1 World Cup, Mar. 27]. I'll see how he comes out. My horse nicked his quarter, but it doesn't look like anything too serious." **Cont. p2**

GOLDEN BOY Medaglia d'Oro (El Prado {Ire}), second by a head in the 2002 GI Wood Memorial, competed with distinction in the Triple Crown, posting a fourth in the GI Kentucky Derby and a close second in the GI Belmont S. He returned to dominate the GII Jim Dandy S. and added a game score in the GI Travers S. before concluding his sophomore campaign with a runner-up finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. The Edmund Gann colorbearer kicked off 2003 with a facile win in the GII Strub S. and followed up with a 1-10 win in the GII Oaklawn H. in April, but was sidelined with a hoof problem after kicking the stall. After recovering, the dark bay captured the GI Whitney H. at Saratoga Aug. 2, but returned just three weeks later at Del Mar and had no answer for Candy Ride (Arg) in the GI Pacific Classic Aug. 24, coming in second during his rival's track-record setting performance. He made just one more start in 2003, settling for second in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic Oct. 25 after dueling for the lead.

How the Race Was Run...

The 3-5 favorite was content to let 74-1 Predawn Raid (Sir Cat) set the pace, tracking him from second, then moved up on his outside to put a head in front turning for home. **Bowman's Band** (Dixieland Band) looked as though he would make a race of it on the rail, but the tiring pacesetter closed that hole; the pair bumped soundly and clipped heels. Bowman's Band stumbled badly and could not recover from the incident. But all of that had no bearing on Medaglia d'Oro, who quickened up nicely after shrugging off a challenge from Eclipse champ **Funny Cide** (Distorted Humor). "He ran like he did in the Strub last year," said winning rider Jerry Bailey. "He runs really well fresh. At the top of the stretch I saw [Funny Cide] was on my hip again, but I was never really worried. The way my horse exploded at the 3/8-pole, I don't think there are too many horses that could have had me worried."

 Domestic Dispute hadn't had his picture taken in 13 months, but overcame traffic problems and a very game During in this contest. After capturing the GII Santa Catalina S. last January for trainer Bob Baffert, the blaze-faced chestnut ran fifth to Buddy Gil (Eastern Echo) in both the GII San Felipe S. and the GI Santa Anita Derby, then ran third in the GII Coolmore Lexington S. He was sold after that race and transferred to Paddy Gallagher, who saddled him to finish 10th in the GI Kentucky Derby. Domestic Dispute didn't start again until finishing a distant ninth in the Pennsylvania Derby on Labor Day, then ran a bang-up fourth in the grassy GII Oak Tree Derby Oct. 4. A decent sixth in the GI Malibu S. back on the main track Dec. 26, he had a troubled trip when fourth to During in the GII San Fernando Breeders' Cup H. Jan. 10. Sent off at 14-1 this time, the four-year-old stalked the pace, but had to wait for running room turning for home. Still blocked at the furlong marker, he angled to the outside, collared a gritty During and just got by him approaching the wire. "I knew he was full of run, I just had nowhere to go," said winning rider Kent Desormeaux. Gallagher was pleased to get his first win with this colt. "I was very grateful for [owners] Chuck Winner and David Bienstock," he said. "They put up a lot of money [to buy the horse] and it's nice to have a big day out like this."

Making her first start on dirt, Miss Coronado kicked off a big day for trainer Bobby Frankel at Gulfstream Park by leading every step of her stakes debut. After missing by 3/4 of a length in her career opener over the Hollywood lawn Nov. 20, the dark bay graduated going nine furlongs at Santa Anita Jan. 4. Frankel was eager to try his charge on the main track, but wanted no part of a clash with undefeated titans Halfbridled and A.P. Adventure in next week's GI Las Virgenes S. So after a bullet breeze in 1:13 last Sunday at Hollywood, Miss Coronado joined stablemate Medaglia d'Oro on a flight bound for Florida. Breaking alertly from the rail, the Stonerside homebred went up to show the way while tugging at the reins. She turned for home and was immediately besieged by the three favorites, but kept digging in and finding more to earn her first graded stakes victory in one of the most thrilling finishes so far this year. "She really knows how to fight," said winning rider Cornelio Velasquez. "[Frankel] told me to ride with confidence. He's the biggest trainer in America, so it was a lot of pressure, but not when I had so much horse at the top of the stretch." Miss Coronado will now head back home, according to Frankel. "We'll take her back to California and keep our options open," he said. Eye Dazzler was four wide, but was a head back of the winner. Immediately to her inside and finishing a neck back in third was 4-5 Society Selection, with 5-2 Last Song (Unbridled's Song) another neck back in fourth.

By far the most experienced runner in the field, Imperialism made his Southern California debut a winning one, upsetting the previously undefeated Hosco. The grey colt had one prior start over seven furlongs, a 1 1/2-length maiden win versus \$25,000 company at Calder last July 19, but had been plying his trade over the turf of late. Second in entry-level allowance company over that surface Oct. 16, he took a Nov. 8 off-the-turfer by a length in Miami, was second in the grassy Mecke S. and was most recently an even fifth in the Gill Tropical Park Derby Jan. 1. After breaking inward at the start, Imperialism was taken off the inside and allowed his five rivals to go on with it as he was content to race in last for the opening half mile. Given his cue by jockey Victor Espinoza, he advanced leaving the three-eighths pole, circled four wide into the lane, took aim on front-running Hosco at the eighth pole and charged home to victory. "I was not worried about it," the winning rider said, when asked about being so far back early on. "When it was time to go, I just loosened the reins a little bit and I had a lot of horse in there." Doug O'Neill, who trains the runner-up, was not discouraged by the effort. "He ran dynamite," he said. "No one saw the one [horse]. He kind of came out of nowhere. Hosco won the race he was in, but the one kind of caught him off guard."

In the end, it was a son of Grand Slam in the winner's circle, just not the one most of the crowd expected. A graded-stakes placed performer at two, Alke was second in the Southwest S. and fifth in the Mar. 22 Gill Rebel S. before leaving the barn of Bob Holthus. Given time off following knee surgery, he resurfaced to take a first-level allowance at Belmont by 1 1/4 lengths and made it two straight with a victory by the same margin at Aqueduct Nov. 29. The half-length winner of a \$75,000 optional claimer at this track Jan. 9, he was the second choice in the wagering. Quickly into stride, Alke hounded favored Cajun Beat through moderate fractions of :23.04 and :46.05. He dug in gamely to put a head in front at the eighth pole and drew clear. "It went perfectly," said winning rider John Velazquez. "He stayed close to the pace and let me do what I wanted with him. It was a sweet victory." Victorious trainer Todd Pletcher is hopeful that the colt will be invited for either the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen or G2 Godolphin Mile in Dubai Mar. 27. [Click for the brisnet.com chart.](#)

Having his first start in over three months, Lonhro came barreling through the final 250 meters to snatch victory from the jaws of defeat in the G1 C.F. Orr. The five-year-old had a typically taxing spring campaign, with five starts in the span of eight weeks. The winner of the G1 George Main S. Sept. 27, the bay added a one-length victory in this track's Oct. 11 G1 Caulfield Cup over 10 furlongs before faltering in the G1 W.S. Cox Plate to finish fourth. Favored in a race which has been dominated over the years by three-year-olds, Lonhro raced in midpack behind a swift early pace and looked to have his work cut out for him. He shifted out with a little more than a furlong to run, bumping with Vocabulary, but covered his final 600 meters in :34.03 and got the photo. "Once he had the line in his sights, he was like a bulldog the last 100 meters," commented winning jockey Darren Beadman. The win was the ninth in Group 1 company for Lonhro, who retires to stud in the spring.
