

No mention has

been made of Crimson Palace's next start, but she just might follow in the footsteps of another ex-South African runner, Ipi Tombe (Zim). That filly took the Jebel Hatta in early March before capturing the G1 Dubai Duty Free on the World Cup undercard. Now retired, Ipi Tombe was partly owned by Team Valor, who have been doing very well with fillies recently. Offered a discount for buying into fillies, the syndicate members reaped a significant reward last fall when Maple Syrple, a \$350,000 two-year-old purchase, captured the Clarendon S. at Woodbine and was acquired by Sheikh Mohammed for a reported seven-figure sum.
