A total of 19 horses, headed by defending champion Thady Quill (Nureyev), have been nominated for the Sandy Lane Barbados Gold Cup, to be held at the Garrison Savannah Racecourse on Saturday, Mar. 6. Mrs. Gay Smith, owner of last year's winner, has an additional three horses entered, each representing the United States, including Bis Repetitas (Red Ransom), Inesperado (Fr) (Zayyani {Ire}) and Sharp Impact (Siphon {Brz}). They will each be trained by W.C. Marshall, who has saddled the last four winners of the Gold Cup and six overall. Owners Eugene and Laura Melnyk, who finished second and fourth last year with Zoning and Warleigh, respectively, have nominated four horses to the race. Todd Pletcher trains Kathir (Woodman), an allowance winner at Gulfstream Park Jan. 9, while Tony Reinstedler conditions Moonshine Hall (Spinning World), winner of last year's Charley Barley S. at Woodbine. Mark Casse is the listed trainer of the Melnyks' Pie Corner (Grand Slam) and Waltzin Storm (Storm Creek), 12th in last year's race.

DESERT DEER ON THE MOVE

Last season's impressive G2 Sandown Mile winner Desert Deer (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) has been transferred from the Middleham stables of Mark Johnston to John Gosden's Manton base on the instruction of owner Jaber Abdullah. The son of Cadeaux Genereux has been off the track injured since finishing ninth in the G1 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot on his only other start last term. Joe Mercer, Abdullah's racing manager, told Racing Post: "John Gosden already has a number of horses belonging to Jaber Abdullah and Desert Deer was actually the only one left with Mark Johnston. The owner does like to go and see his horses and by being based with John it cuts down his travelling. He's very often over in Britain and when he has been starting from London he has had to go 250 miles to York and then from there he has had to get to Middleham. As far as I know the horse is fine but he had his leg screwed in December so we'll have to see how he gets on."

TONY CLARK CALLS IT A CAREER

Jockey Tony Clark, who piloted the likes of champion Warning (GB), Lear Fan and Ile de Chypre (GB), has announced his retirement from the saddle at the age of 42. He cited the lack of opportunities as his reason for hanging up his tack. In a career which produced over 800 winners across the world, Clark is perhaps best known for his connection to Guy Harwood in the days when the stable also boasted Dancing Brave, Kalaglow (GB) and Ela-Mana-Mou (Ire). "I have been very lucky and have ridden some unbelievable horses in my time," Clark told Racing Post. "To ride Warning in a race was incredible and the same could be said of Lear Fan," Clark said. "Ile de Chypre was a horse who took a lot of knowing, but he was very game and I don't think he got the credit he deserved -- he was a great favorite." Clark's last major success came with Turbo (Ire) in the November H. at Doncaster.
