After defeating Del Mar Show in a nine-furlong allowance Jan. 11, the dark bay stepped up to take the GIII

Mac Diarmida H. over this trip Jan. 25 and makes another class rise today. "I think it might be a little ambitious going into a Grade 1 for his third start," admitted trainer Stan Hough. "But he seems to be doing every-

thing right at this time so now has to be the time to try and do it." Kicken Kris (Kris S.) proved himself to be one of the best sophomores going long on the turf last year and faces his elders for the first time in his 2004 bow. After pairing up maiden and allowance victories over this course last winter, the bay captured the GI Secretariat S. over 10 furlongs and the GIII Lawrence Realization H. over 12 furlongs before concluding his campaign with a close third, beaten a length, in the 10furlong GI Hollywood Derby Nov.

THIS KITTEN HAS CLAWS

Kitten's Joy (El Prado {Ire}) remained unbeaten on turf with a professional victory in the GIII Palm Beach S. yesterday at Gulfstream. The Ramsey homebred celebrated the New Year with a win in the GIII Tropical Park Derby at Calder and was 3-5 to keep the streak alive.



After breaking from the rail, the chestnut skimmed the hedge and turned for home full of run, but with no place to go. Jockey Jerry Bailey found a seam and Kitten's Joy pounced on the leaders as they straightened into the lane, then fended off a host of challengers in the final sixteenth. "He looked like

Kitten's Joy Equi-Photo he just exploded out there," said winning trainer Dale Romans. Though a Triple Crown nominee, Kitten's Joy will target the big turf races in his division. Fun House and jockey Gary Stevens raced in midpack over the soggy going, with Stevens taking the five-year-old to the outside approaching the stretch. Fudge Fatale inherited the lead when Maiden Tower began to stop, but she was tackled immediately by Fun House, who smoothly strode by. "She loved that stuff [the wet grass]," said Stevens. "It's really soft out there...when you get one that handles it like she just did it's fun, because you know the rest of the horses are struggling, and she was skipping through it. Nice, nice filly."

The powerfully built filly Alinghi burst jockey Damien Oliver's Blue Diamond hoodoo in stunning fashion. An A\$80,000 Inglis Premier Sale purchase for syndicators Rob and Corinne Slade, Alinghi settled one from last as Wager led the field and scooted to a four-length lead entering the straight. Wager seemed to have the race to herself as Oliver crept through the middle of the field with Alinghi, still some six lengths from the leader with only 250 meters remaining. But the long-striding Alinghi put her head down for a herculean effort to deny Wager the race by a length. "This is a fantastic filly, to make up the sort of ground she did, she's just sprouted wings in the last 200 meters," said trainer Lee Freedman, shaking his head in disbelief. Oliver, who has some 68 Group 1 wins, but has yet to enjoy a Golden Slipper victory, believes she is dominant enough to complete an arduous double. If Alinghi can add the Golden Slipper to her Blue Diamond success, she will become the first horse since Courtza in 1989 to do so. But Freedman, who celebrated an incredible 98th Group 1 win and his third Blue Diamond success, believes Alinghi has the ability to capture both races.

"This is my 30th Group 1 win overall and my eighth since returning from Africa, it's been very satisfying," he said, adding that Reactive was being weighted out of stakes races against her own sex so he and the mare's owners decided to go for broke first-up as she only had 52 kilograms. Emerging rider Matt Pumpa worked hard to put Reactive on the rails and hit the lead with 50 meters remaining to take the race from Salinger Stakes winner Ancient Song. Reactive now has three wins and two placings from six attempts at the trip, and she will contest the G1 Newmarket H. at her next start.


