#### EMA BOVARY BLOOMS IN LAS FLORES

Ema Bovary (Chi) (Edgy Diplomat) made it a clean sweep for Southern Hemisphere-breds in U.S. stakes action yesterday with an impressive 3 1/4-length victory in Santa Anita's GIII Las Flores H. Since losing her U.S. debut at Golden Gate last February, the five-yearold Chilean-bred had reeled off seven straight victories, most recently taking the Jan. 24 Orinda H. at Golden Gate. Making the jump to graded stakes company, Ema Bovary was sent off the 7-5 second choice behind 6-5 Buffythecenterfold (Capote). She stalked a swift early pace, angled out for running room on the turn and inhaled Buffythecenterfold in upper stretch to win going away in stakes record time of 1:08 for the six furlongs. "Buffy's a pretty nice horse, but Ema loves the mud, too," said winning trainer Larry Ross. "I was surprised that she won as easy as she did, carrying that much weight [121]." Bullish Luck continued a tremendous year for trainer Tony Cruz and jockey Felix Coetzee, storming from last to catch odds-on favorite Elegant Fashion for his first pattern victory. A two-time winner in Europe for trainer Pip Payne while racing as Al Moughazel, the bay has been a progressive sort since his arrival in Hong Kong and was coming into this with wins in two of his last three starts, including a 1 3/4-length success over 1600 meters Feb. 1. Trying this distance for just the second time in his career, Bullish Luck was content to trail early as they went only a moderate tempo on the front end. Still trailing as the field turned into the stretch, he was switched out to the grandstand side and kicked hard to catch Elegant Fashion in the shadow of the post. The latter had a very nice trip saving ground from fourth, took command with 300 meters to run, but could not hold the late charge of the winner. "He kicked very hard for me," the winning rider commented. "I wasn't sure if I was going to catch Elegant Fashion, because she is so tough, but he got there in the end. Great performance." For the victorious trainer and jockey combination, it was their fourth Group 1 win of the season. Bullish Luck and Elegant Fashion are likely to rematch in the G1 Audemars Piguet QE II Cup. David Hayes, trainer of the Australian mare, indicated that he would sidestep the Dubai World Cup program in favor of the QE II Cup, where Elegant Fashion was second a year ago.

"He's a fighter," trainer Ken McPeek confirmed after Hard Buck's gutsy win in yesterday's GI Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup H. "He's really focused in on winning and learning where the wire is at. We knew he could show the talent for this level. He's a fantastic horse to be around." Winning jockey Edgar Prado added, "I had a beautiful trip. He broke good and gave me a chance to sit behind the speed the way I wanted to do. When I set him down for the drive, he responded the way I thought he would. The way he was running I had a good feeling all the way around." McPeek said Hard Buck may be making a return trip to Dubai. "The people from Dubai are talking with my owners right now," the trainer said.
