#### **WISE GUYS**

They aren't the glamour races of the three-year-old division, but three stakes will be contested today which feature some up-and-coming names. The most well known is unbeaten **Smarty Jones** (Elusive Quality), who

travels to Oaklawn for the Southwest S. He has won each of his three career starts by open lengths and is coming off a fivelength win in Aqueduct's Count Fleet S. Jan. 3. In winning his two-turn debut, the powerfully built chestnut earned a 105 Beyer Speed Figure. "My horse has blazing speed, that's obvi-

ous," said trainer John Servis, "but we have been teaching him to relax, and he's responding. If he's going to get the Derby distance, he'll have to overcome his [sprint] pedigree." He faces a promising pair of colts owned by Mrs. James Winn and trained by Bob Holthus, Proper Prado (El Prado (Ire)) and Pro Prado (El Prado {Ire}). Also in the field is the speedy Wildcat Shoes (Forest Wildcat), who will be stepping up to a mile for the first time. Over at Turfway, 11 sophomores will contest the \$100,000 John Battaglia Memorial S. Local stalwart Silver Minister (Silver Deputy), looking for his fourth straight victory, will meet undefeated Maryland shipper White Mountain Boy (Meadowlake) and Whirlaway S. hero Little Matth Man (Matty G). And at Laurel, the highly regarded Capac (Deputy Minister) will try a route for the first time in the Miracle Wood S.

The handsome chestnut duly won a seven-furlong allowance at the Maryland oval Feb. 4 as the 2-5 chalk. "I don't think we got to see his talent that day," said jockey Jeremy Rose. "I didn't ride him the way I will this time. I'll make him break out of the gate. I think he'll be awfully tough in here." Shortly after his Nov. 28 maiden win at Churchill, Jayeff B Stable

RECORD DEL MAR STAKES IN '04 Del Mar will offer 27 stakes races worth a record \$6,325,000 during its 2004 season. Topping the track's schedule is the \$1-million GI Pacific Classic, which will be run Aug. 22. The GII Del Mar Derby will be worth \$400,000 this year, an increase of \$100,000 for the nine-furlong grass contest. The race will be run on Sept. 6. The Bing Crosby Breeders' Cup H. has been upgraded to a Grade I event for the 2004 renewal, which will be worth \$250,000 and will be run on July 25. Other notable stakes on the schedule include: the \$400,000 GI John C Mabee H. on July 24; the \$400,000 GI Eddie Read H. on July 25 and the \$300,000 GI Del Mar Oaks on Aug. 21. The GI Del Mar Debutante will be run on Aug. 28 and the GII Del Mar Futurity will be run on Sept. 8. Both juvenile races will be worth \$250,000. Of the 27 stakes races, six are Grade Is, 11 are Grade IIs and two are Grade IIIs. "I like our stakes schedule immensely and I think horsemen and racing fans are going to feel the same way," said Tom Robbins, Del Mar's vice president for racing and the track's racing secretary. "We've given it some first-rate enhancements and with our prime dates this year, we should be in position to showcase our best in the best of circumstances." #### NEW GI AMERICAN OAKS TOPS HOLLYWOOD

Hollywood Park has announced that the 2004 Spring/Summer Meet will have a \$9.2-million stakes schedule with eight Grade I races, including the upgraded \$750,000 American Oaks, which was inaugurated two years ago. "We're thrilled the American Oaks has received Grade I status at first opportunity," said racing secretary Martin Panza. "That does not happen very often. It speaks highly of the quality of the fields the first two years and it will make the race even more attractive to horsemen in the future." Carded at 10 furlongs on the turf for three-year-old fillies, the American Oaks will be contested July 3. It is the co-richest event on the Hollywood schedule, joining the GI Hollywood Gold Cup July 10. The other Grade I races are the \$250,000 Vanity H. (May 9), \$350,000 Gamely Breeders' Cup H. (May 31), \$350,000 Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile (May 31), \$350,000 Charles Whittingham Memorial H. (June 12), \$300,000 Triple Bend Breeders' Cup H. (July 3) and \$250,000 Milady Breeders' Cup H.
