The conditioner was equally confident in his charge's ability to get Saturday's distance, even against a solid group of Grade I males. "She broke her maiden at a mile, then she won the mile and a quarter," Polanco said, referencing her victory in the GI Alabama S. last summer. "I'm not concerned about the distance."

Tapit (Pulpit) worked one mile in 1:47 Tuesday afternoon at trainer Michael Dickinson's Tapeta Farm in Maryland, and will make his much-awaited sophomore debut in the GI Florida Derby at Gulfstream Park Mar. 13. "He'll work once more in Maryland, either Sunday or Monday and then ship directly to Gulfstream on Tuesday," David Fiske, racing manager for Ron Winchell's Winchell Thoroughbreds LLC, told Daily Racing Form. "Obviously we'll be giving something to the horses who've been in Florida and already run this winter. We're just hoping he runs well and is able to move on to the next stop." He could have his final Derby prep in the GI Wood Memorial at Aqueduct Apr. 10. Undefeated in two career starts, Tapit is unraced since taking the GIII Laurel Futurity Nov. 15. Jockey Ramon Dominguez has been aboard for his two wins, but Dickinson indicated that no rider has been secured for the Florida Derby.


