No Rebel for Tiger Hunt

Team Valor president Barry Irwin confirmed Wednesday that **Tiger Hunt** (Kris S.) will be forced to skip the Mar. 20 GIII Rebel S. at Oaklawn Park. The three-year-old colt spiked a fever last weekend and missed some training time ahead of what would have been his first start of the year. "The fever lasted only one day," said Irwin, "but the colt didn't eat for two days, and he missed two days of training. He's back on

the racetrack now, but he's going slow. The bottom line is...he can't make the Rebel." Irwin remained hopeful that Tiger Hunt could still get back on the Triple Crown trail. "We'll monitor him on a daily basis and go from there," he continued. "I'm still hoping he can make the

[GII] Arkansas Derby [Apr. 10]." At two, Tiger Hunt captured the Cradle S. prior to running second to Eurosilver in the GII Lane's End Futurity. He closed out his juvenile campaign with a troubled fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. "All I can say," Irwin added, "is we'll do the right thing for Tiger Hunt. This game is full of disappointment, and we'll roll with the punches. We have no choice." Team Valor's other main Classic contender **Shadowland** (Distant View) is scheduled to run in Sunday's GII Louisiana Derby. "Shadowland has been training great," said Irwin. "We believe he has a shot, especially with Pat [Day] aboard. His last race was good." The chestnut was second to Fire Slam in the GIII Lecomte S. at Fair Grounds Jan. 24 in his most recent outing.

Minister Eric (Old Trieste) worked six furlongs at Santa Anita on Thursday in 1:14.60. Trainer Richard Mandella has not targeted a specific race for the Breeders' Cup Juvenile runner-up, who failed to draw in off the also-eligible list in Saturday's GIII Baldwin S. "It was just enough to get him by until we find out where we're going," Mandella explained.

Pick Six Records Fall at Santa Anita:

Wednesday's Pick Six gross pool at Santa Anita reached a record \$7,202,848, an all-time North American high. The pool--which included a three-day carry-over of \$1,413,136--broke the mark of \$6,657,311 set at Santa Anita on Jan. 23, 1991. A total of \$5,889,712 was bet into the pool on Wednesday. That's the second biggest single-day pool ever, topped only by the \$6,494,349 wagered on the 1998 Breeders' Cup Pick Six at Churchill Downs. Wednesday's Pick Six was held on races three through eight and the winning combination of 2-2-6-5-2-1 returned \$1,567,984. There were three tickets with six correct, all sold offtrack at New York OTB, Kentucky Hub and Viejas Casino in Alpine, California. There were 445 consolation tickets with five correct, each worth \$3,169.
