PLEASANTLY PERFECT OUT OF BIG 'CAP

Pleasantly Perfect (Pleasant Colony), the morning-line favorite at 6-5, has been scratched from today's GI Santa Anita H. due to a fever. "When I came in this



morning, I walked by his stall...he had eaten his dinner and he looked fine," trainer Richard Mandella said. "But an hour later when I was down at the track with a set of horses, [assistant Becky Witzman] Pleasantly Perfect Benoit Photo called me. We take all temperatures before we train every

day...and Becky called me to tell [Pleasantly Perfect's temperature] was 102, which is a sick horse." The sixyear-old's temperature had returned to normal by 9 a.m., but Mandella decided not to risk running him. "If I ran him [today] and he was a little sick, it could turn into pneumonia and I couldn't take that chance," he said. "I can only hope that it's not too bad...and there may be the chance that we'll go to Dubai [for the G1 Dubai World Cup, Mar. 27]. The next few days will tell that story."

LAYING IT ON THE LION

Undefeated Lion Heart (Tale of the Cat) bids for his

third straight graded-stakes score in the GII San Rafael S. at Santa Anita this afternoon. The three-year-old followed his Oct. 24 debut victory with a six-length tally in the Nov. 15 GIII Hollywood Prevue S., then tried two turns for the first time and led gate to wire in the Dec. 20 GI Hollywood Futurity. "We will see how he has matured from two to three," trainer Patrick Biancone told Daily Racing Form. "So far, all the signs are good." The \$1.4 million FTFFEB

juvenile has been working sharply for his sophomore bow. He blew out for the race Wednesday, going a half in :47 flat. But, Biancone cautioned, "Saturday is not a walkover. He has to give weight. He's running against very fit horses." San Rafael S. field, p3

THE PERFECT UNDERSTUDY

Trainer Richard Mandella may not have his big gun in the gate for today's \$1 million Big 'Cap at Santa Anita, but he has an able understudy in stablemate Olmodavor (A.P. Indy). The Wertheimer et Frere homebred ended 2003 with a rallying half-length score in the Dec. 6 GIII Native Diver H. at Hollywood Park. Third behind Star Cross (Arg) (Southern Halo) in the Jan. 3 GII San Pasqual H. to start the new year, the five-year-old comes into the race off a 3/4-length tally in the Feb. 1 GIII Whirlaway H. "He had an injury as a yearling and that compromised him a little bit, but lately he has been training better than he ever has and he could be in for a big day," Mandella said. The bay tries 10 furlongs for the first time, as does likely favorite Southern Image (Halo's Image). The four-year-old looks for his fourth straight after taking a 1 1/16-mile allowance at Del Mar in August, returning to post a 13-1 upset in the Dec. 26 GI Malibu S. at seven furlongs and making it three in a row in the Jan. 24 Sunshine Millions Classic at a mile and an eighth. "The way he trains, I'm not concerned about the mile and a quarter," trainer Mike Machowsky said. "He can sit just off the pace or set the pace, whatever we need him to do. That's to his advantage."

The chestnut almost always fires and rallied from dead last to be fourth, beaten just 2 1/2 lengths, in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile over track and trip Oct. 25. The 118-pound co-second highweight in the field, he charged five wide into the stretch of the GII Citation H. at Hollywood Nov. 29 before finishing 3/4 of a length second to Redattore (Brz) and comes into this off a head success in the Turf Paradise Breeders' Cup H. KEMPTON PLANS ALL-WEATHER

If plans to construct a floodlit all-weather track go ahead, Kempton racecourse may bid farewell to flat racing on the turf, according to a report in yesterday's Daily Telegraph. The track intends to stage year-round racing starting in 2006 if approval is granted by the local Spelthorne Borough Council. Kempton's managing director Julian Thick told the London-based newspaper: "The area where we've seen most growth has been on Wednesday nights in the summer. We feel there is a demand to sustain that interest throughout the whole year. There is a demand for good facilities and for the action to take place when people can attend, which is usually in the evenings after work. Eventually, we would like to have regular slots, Wednesday and Saturday nights, for example. At present we have 36 racedays at Kempton and we have found that a large part of our budget goes towards promoting these days. If we raced on Wednesday and Saturday all-year round then people would know automatically when it was on, and there wouldn't be the need for as much advertising and promotion." The Sunbury track's seven stakes races, the G3 September S., G3 Sirenia S., Listed Easter S., Listed Heron S., Listed Masaka S., Listed Magnolia S. and Listed Achilles S., will all be staged on the new surface when the project is completed. Kempton intends to preserve its hurdle and chase courses.
