READ ALL ABOUT IT

Beaten only once in six career starts, **Read the Footnotes** (Smoke Glacken) heads a field of 10 in today's GII Florida Derby at Gulfstream Park. The winner of the GIII Nashua S. and GII Remsen S. at two, the bay came

back after a 2 1/2-month break and made it three in a row with a game neck victory in the Feb. 14 GII Fountain of Youth S. "You hope he doesn't have to run as hard as he did in the Fountain of Youth," trainer Rick Violette Jr. said. "I hope he can actually regress a little bit, numbers and sheets wise, and still get the job done [today]." Taking on several promising sophomores, the talented New York-bred will not be able to take too many backward steps. Also lining up for today's \$1

million event is **The Cliff's Edge** (Gulch), who captured

the 2003 GIII Iroquois S. by an impressive 7 3/4 lengths and ended the season with a 3/4-length score in the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. The Robert La Penta runner made his 2004 debut in the Feb. 21 Sam F. Davis S. at Tampa Bay and closed to be second. Undefeated **Tapit** (Pulpit) makes his first start of the season this afternoon. The gray was last seen cruising to a 4 3/4-length tally in the Nov. 15 GIII Laurel Futurity. The \$625,000 KEESEP yearling clearly has ability, but trainer Michael Dickinson cautioned, "There's no changing the fact that the other horses in the Derby have had a race and I haven't. I think this horse is fit enough to run, but I don't think he's fit enough to win." **Value Plus** (Unbridled's Song) looks for his first two-turn victory. He tried a route for the first time in the Oct. 4 GII Lane's End Futurity and finished fourth, but trainer Todd Pletcher said, "He had what I would describe as a nightmare trip in that race." Steadied early, he hustled up to press the pace before tiring late. After dumping his rider in his 2003 finale, the Nashua, Value Plus returned in an entry-level allowance going seven furlongs at Gulfstream Park Feb. 14 and won by 5 3/4 lengths.

PREMIER T'BRED VENTURES UNVEILED

Bob and Beverly Lewis will have company in the winner's circle this year...lots of it. In an effort to bring new owners to horse racing, the Lewises have agreed to sell a 10-percent share in their 2004 two-year-olds bought at public auction to a new partnership, Premier Thoroughbred Ventures. The goal of the partnership, which will be made up of 15 hand-picked newcomers to the Thoroughbred industry, is to introduce high-profile individuals to racing, as well as to bring publicity to the sport through their involvement. The recruitment of investors for the partnership will be an industry-wide effort. "We believe this is a unique opportunity for new owners to get involved in the Thoroughbred business for a very reasonable investment and to experience it at the highest level," Keeneland President Nick Nicholson said. Halfbridled and A.P. Adventure go into the starting gate undefeated, but only one can end the day with their perfect record still intact. Champion Halfbridled could be at a slight disadvantage, as she has not been out since capturing the Oct. 25 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. A.P. Adventure didn't make her first start until five days after the Breeders' Cup, but has been unbeatable as well, taking a Santa Anita maiden test Oct. 30, the GIII Santa Ysabel S. Jan. 4 and the GI Las Virgenes S. Feb. 15. She bested GI Hollywood Starlet heroine Hollywood Story by a half-length in her latest. "My filly is coming into the race beautiful," trainer Wally Dollase said. "She's right on schedule. I couldn't be happier with the way she is training." Stonerside's Miss Coronado made her dirt debut in the Feb. 7 GII Davona Dale S. at Gulfstream Park and led from gate to wire, hanging on for a head tally.

Brilliant in her first two starts, Madcap Escapade gets a class test here. She was described as a freak following her 10-length maiden win Jan. 4, and jockey Rene Douglas compared her to Ruffian when she romped by 11 3/4 lengths in the Old Hat S. on Valentine's Day, an effort which earned her a 108 Beyer Figure. The bay gets jockey Jerry Bailey as she stretches out to seven furlongs while facing graded-stakes winners La Reina and Wacky Patty. "I couldn't be happier with what she's done and the way she's going into this race, but the water gets deeper as you go along," trainer Frank Brothers told Daily Racing Form. "It's difficult to keep a horse who has run like she has at that level--especially sprinting and especially a filly." La Reina broke her maiden at this distance in September prior to taking the GIII Tempted S. Nov. 4. She closed out 2003 with a nose second to Ashado in the GII Demoiselle S. Nov. 29 and will be using this race as a springboard to route races this spring. "We've been pointing her for this race all along," said trainer Shug McGaughey.

HOUGHTON FOLDED INTO OCTOBER SALE

Officials at two of Europe's major auction houses, Goffs in Ireland and Tattersalls in England, have re-leased their sales schedules for the fall of this year. Goffs will stage their premier sale, the Orby, beginning Monday, Sept. 27. It will be followed by the Challenge Sale, set for Friday, Oct. 2, and will incorporate the former Autumn Bonus Sale. Tattersalls will combine their boutique Houghton Sale into Part 1 of the October Yearling Sale. That auction will take place Tuesday, Oct. 5 through Friday, Oct. 8. The Tattersalls October Sale Part 2 will resume Monday, Oct. 11 for a six-day run to conclude Saturday, Oct. 16. Tattersalls Chairman Edmund Mahony and Goffs Managing Director Matt Mitchell issued a joint statment, saying, "We are pleased to have resolved any outstanding issues and, with valuable input from both the British and Irish Thoroughbred Breeders' Associations, to have negotiated a settlement which we firmly believe to be in the long-term interests of not only Tattersalls and Goffs, but also, most importantly, of the vendors and purchasers."
