ADORATION WINS MARGARITA

Breeders' Cup Distaff heroine **Adoration** (Honor Grades) returned to the winner's circle for the first time since her front-running championship victory last October in yesterday's GI Santa Margarita Invitational H. at Santa Anita. The bay mare chased **Star Parade (Arg)**

(Parade Marshal) home in both the GII Bayakoa H. last December, where she was second, and the Feb. 16 GI Santa Maria, where she tired to fourth. The Argentinian mare once again set the pace yesterday through easy fractions of :23.20, :46.76 and 1:11.07, while **Adoration**, with an extra half-furlong to work with here, bided her time in second. She collared the pacesetter in upper stretch and forged clear down the lane to win by two lengths. **Star Parade** gamely held off favored **Bare Necessities** (Silver Deputy) for second. *Cont. p. 2*

PREACHIN' HOLDS ON BY A PRAYER

Preachinathebar (Silver Charm) has been a slow learner for trainer Bob Baffert, but the gray colt put it all together for a determined win in the GII San Felipe S. yesterday at Santa Anita. "I was taking my time with him," Baffert admitted. "He was a little bit late coming around but he ran like we thought he would." A maiden winner in his fourth start last December, the Mike Pegram homebred returned as a three-year-old to run fourth behind **St. Averil** (Saint Ballado) in the Jan. 17 GII Santa Catalina before a third-place effort behind Master David in the Feb. 8 Sham S. In the first yards of the San Felipe, **Laditude** (Lil's Lad) stumbled badly, losing rider Mike Smith, before rushing up between horses into the first turn.

"I had a relaxed position coming to the first turn, and I saw [Laditude] coming in inside of me and my horse got bumped and took off on me," winning jockey Javier Santiago explained of his unexpectedly forward early position. After pressing the pace while racing three wide, **Preachinathebar** took a narrow advantage into the lane, opened up by 1 1/2 lengths in upper stretch and then just barely held off the late rush of favored **St. Averil**. Of the winner, Baffert said, "He's starting to fill out and you don't know how exciting it is to win a stake with [a son of Baffert-trained] Silver Charm." Santiago teamed up with Baffert to win last week's GII Louisiana Derby aboard Wimbledon. After riding the narrowly beaten favorite **St. Averil**, Tyler Baze said, "Mike Smith's horse cost me the race. That's it. I was five wide at the [first] turn. I still thought I'd won it." Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner **Action This Day** (Kris S.) rushed up to stalk the pace but never made a serious move and finished seventh. "When he went into the first turn there was some jamming and he's got a big gash behind his ankle on his right hind leg," said trainer Richard Mandella. "[Adoration] just ran dynamite," said winning rider Mike Smith, who only three races before the Santa Margarita was thrown to the dirt when his mount stumbled badly at the start of the San Felipe. "When I got on her today and was warming her up, she was just oozing confidence. And on the backside she was just taking me wherever I wanted to go and it was pretty much over after that. Once I hit the front I kept after her just enough to keep her busy." Winning trainer David Hofmans added, "The strategy was just to stay back and let Star Parade do her thing. The difference between a mile and a sixteenth [the distance at which Star Parade beat Adoration twice] and a mile and an eighth is huge. A lot of horses that can go a mile and a sixteenth, can't go a mile and an eighth." Hofmans said the May 9 GI Vanity H. at Hollywood Park could be next for Adoration. Of his Star Parade's runner-up effort, trainer Darrell Vienna said, "Everything went our way. That other filly ran great today. We've been beating up on her and she got back." Bare Necessities missed Star Parade by just a head in the Santa Maria, and was again a head short of that mare, this time for second, as the 8-5 favorite yesterday. "They went in 1:11 and [jockey Jose Valdivia, Jr] was sitting five or six [lengths] out of it into a slow pace," trainer Wally Dollase lamented. Sightseek, who had to settle for second in her first three starts last season while racing at Santa Anita, blossomed after being sent cross country. Juddmonte's homebred reeled off four consecutive Grade I wins east of the Mississippi, taking the Humana Distaff H. at Churchill Downs, the Ogden Phipps H. at Belmont Park and the Go for Wand H. at Saratoga, then returning to Belmont to make it four in a row in the Beldame S. But the chestnut did not appreciate it when she was shipped back to California at the end of the year, finishing a distant fourth as the 3-5 favorite in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff. Trainer Bobby Frankel gave the mare one more chance in the Golden State, but after watching her fill the role of beaten favorite once more when fourth behind Island Fashion in the Jan. 25 GI Santa Monica H., he put her back on the plane. "She's nine-for-nine on dirt tracks other than Santa Anita," Frankel explained. "[Santa Anita] is a real dirt track without much sand in it--she just doesn't grab hold of a real dirt track like that." Bet down to 1-2 with the return to the East Coast, Sightseek broke sharply and settled off the hip of Roar Emotion (Roar) as that one set moderate early fractions. She went up to join the pacesetter as they raced past the quarter pole, put that rival away in about two strides and was under wraps late, winning as much the best. The five-year-old will return to California to train, but don't expect to see her in the Santa Anita starting gate. Limehouse started his career with three straight wins, including the GIII Bashford Manor S. at Churchill Downs last July, but came up short in his last three juvenile appearances. The chestnut was a distant third in the Aug. 13 GII Saratoga Special S., then tired to be fifth in the Aug. 30 GI Hopeful S., but showed promise at two turns when capping the campaign with a third behind Eurosilver in the Oct. 4 GII Lane's End Futurity at Keeneland. A 2 1/4-length winner in his three-year-old bow, the Feb. 14 GII Hutcheson S. at Gulfstream Park, the Dogwood Stable colorbearer was odds-on stretching out in his second start of the season. Limehouse was on the heels of the leader early, dropped back a bit as he switched to the outside for the stretch drive, but came on again to grab the lead in the final sixteenth. Mustanfar closed along the rail and was on even terms as they raced past the sixteenth pole, but couldn't hold off the winner while outgaming SwingfortheFences for second. "Around the turn it looked like maybe he wasn't going to fire, then he kind of took off again," winning trainer Todd Pletcher said of Limehouse. "Maybe there was some concern at some point, but knowing this colt's style and knowing [jockey] Pat [Day]'s style, I wasn't concerned." Day added, "[Limehouse] got by the leaders and then got to waiting just a little but as the competition heated up he got back into it and right about the sixteenth pole he went up." Smok'n Frolic knocked heads with the big girls all last season and held her own, notching the GIII Turfway Breeders' Cup and running second in the GII Shuvee H. The gray mare began her 2004 campaign with a second-place finish in the restricted Sunshine Millions Distaff Jan. 24, then ran a dismal seventh as the 2-1 chalk last out in Gulfstream's GIII Sabin H. Feb. 15. The crowd's pick to take this race two years straight, she stumbled at the start, raced close to the leaders, rallied on the turn for home and drew away to post a decisive victory. "I wasn't thrilled with my trip on the first turn because I didn't like being four wide," winning jockey Richard Migliore said. "Honestly, I couldn't do much about that. I felt like I was on the best horse. At least she was relaxed and settled, so I didn't have to get into a fight with her or get into her mouth. I just let her be happy and when I pushed the button coming to the quarter pole, she responded." Coney Kitty had been knocking on the door of graded stakes success, but finally got through with a game performance. The chestnut mare finished 2003 with a narrowly beaten third in the GIII Athenia H. at Aqueduct last November. She returned this term for a runner-up finish in the Jan. 3 GIII Honey Fox H. before a third-place effort behind Madeira Mist over this course in the Feb. 10 Endeavour S. Unhurried early, Coney Kitty worked her way through traffic on the second bend, split foes to take the lead with a furlong to run and battled bravely to the wire despite drifting out on favored Madeira Mist. The mare survived a steward's inquiry and an objection to earn her first graded stakes victory. "My filly was very relaxed," jockey Jose Santos said of the winner. "The last time she ran third, but with this race a little longer, I know she can kick out." Of the inquiry, Santos added, "It was a very tough call, but I'm very happy." Tronare began his North American campaign with a pair of off-the-board finishes over Southern California turf courses last summer and resurfaced after a six-month layoff to run second in a Jan. 11 optional claimer at Santa Anita before a third-place finish in a 10-furlong optional claimer at that track Feb. 11. The Chilean-bred chestnut bided his time while stalking the dueling pacesetters, moved to challenge front-running Soud three-wide on the final turn and outbattled the favorite to the wire in a contentious stretch drive.

Florida Derby Wrap-Up

Friends Lake (A.P. Indy) exited his win in Saturday's GI Florida Derby in fine shape and will likely not start again until the Kentucky Derby. "He shouldn't have any trouble staying fit over the next eight weeks and I think the whole idea is to have a fresh horse for the Derby," explained trainer John Kimmel. "Running back in the Wood or Blue Grass would leave just three weeks until the Derby and I don't want to have a hard race in one of those spots." Friends Lake won the Florida Derby eight weeks after a third-place effort in the GIII Holy Bull S.

Trainer Rick Violette reported that Florida Derby favorite **Read the Footnotes** (Smoke Glacken) was "basically fine," after his fourth-place effort Saturday. "He was a little tired and we found a little muck in his lungs after scoping him," the trainer commented. "It looks like a combination of things, but I'd have to think his race in the Fountain [of Youth] had to top the list." Violette said the Apr. 10 GI Wood Memorial at Aqueduct would likely be the next stop for Read the Footnotes.

Florida Derby sixth-place finisher **Tapit** (Pulpit) came out of Saturday's race coughing. "Walking back from the race, he coughed 10 times," said trainer Michael Dickinson. "It's a legitimate excuse. We were disappointed in his race, but I feel a little better knowing we've identified the problem. We'll have to see what we do now after he comes out of this race."

Two of trainer Nick Zito's powerful sophomore division raced Saturday at Gulfstream, with **The Cliff's Edge** (Gulch) a late-running third in the Florida Derby and **Eurosilver** (Unbridled's Song) running second in the GIII Swale S. "It was a good day, but it could have been better," Zito admitted. Eurosilver is expected to start next in the GI Blue Grass S. at Keeneland Apr. 10. A start has not been named for The Cliff's Edge.
