Trainer Bobby Frankel, who shipped into Fair Grounds to take the Feb. 29 GII New Orleans H. with Peace Rules, returns with Nothing to Lose and Euro import Burning Sun. The former, a four-year-old who is a perfect two-for-two at nine furlongs on the turf, made his first start for Frankel in the Jan. 19 Gll San Marcos H. and finished second, beaten only a half length by subsequent GII Kilroe Mile H. winner Sweet Return (GB). The bay has been freshened since that effort, but his conditioner scores at a 31-percent clip with runners coming off a two-month layoff. Virginia Derby hero Silver Tree ended his sophomore campaign with a solid fourth behind Sweet Return in the Nov. 30 GI Hollywood Derby. He made his first start of the new season in a Feb. 21 Gulfstream allowance test and won handily, and draws jockey Jerry Bailey to Fair Grounds for this race. Proud Man, first or second in 15 of his 23 tries on the grass, will join the ranks of millionaires if he can add to that record today. The six-year-old was a troubled third in the Jan. 4 GIII Appleton H., but enjoyed clear sailing in his latest, rallying for a half-length score in the Jan. 24 Sunshine Millions Turf. Herculated, undefeated in four starts on the Fair Grounds lawn, steps up after a 1 3/4-length win over optional company Feb. 28, a performance that earned him a 104 Beyer Speed Figure.

Jockey Patricia Cooksey, who suffered two broken legs in a horrific spill at Keeneland last April, returned to race riding Friday at Turfway. Though Cooksey finished fifth aboard Religious in the 10th race, the 46-year-old rider was rejuvenated by the experience. "Once I got in the post parade, then in the gate--it was exhilarating," she said. "There's nothing like being on the back of an 11-hundred pound animal going 40 miles an hour." Cooksey has worked hard for her return. "I got a little winded," she admitted. "I've been swimming--I can't tell you how many laps I've done. But there's nothing like riding a daggone race to tell you what kind of shape you're in. But my legs felt great." It was the second major comeback in Cooksey's career, who returned to the saddle in 2002 after undergoing treatment for breast cancer in 2001. Her goal this time is simple. "I want to stand in the winner's circle again," she said. "I want to stand in the hallowed winner's circle at Churchill Downs." O'BRIEN WARMS UP HIS STARS

Aidan O'Brien will lead out his customary team of Classic hopefuls for workouts after racing at the Curragh today, opening day of the 2004 Irish season. The select cast will be headed by G1 Phoenix S. and G1 National S. winner and ante-post G1 2000 Guineas favorite **One Cool Cat** (Storm Cat). He will be joined by maiden winner **Yeats (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), who also holds pole position in the current market for the G1 Epsom Derby, G2 Railway S. scorer **Antonius Pius** (Danzig) and G2 Mill Reef S. runner-up **Grand Reward** (Storm Cat). O'Brien saddles four runners on the eightrace card, including juvenile colt **Russian Blue (Ire)** (Danehill) in the opener, who will be the first mount of Jamie Spencer as the official first jockey at Ballydoyle.

AZAMOUR HEADING TO LEOPARDSTOWN

His Highness the Aga Khan's Azamour (Ire) (Night Shift) is being targeted for the Listed Leopardstown 2000 Guineas Trial Apr. 18, where he could clash with fellow Classic prospect Grey Swallow (Ire) (Daylami {Ire}). Conditioner John Oxx revealed to *Irish Racing* Online that last year's G2 Beresford S. winner is likely to wait for livelier ground than is likely for the Listed Loughbrown S. at The Curragh Apr. 4. "We will wait for decent ground with Azamour, which means that the Loughbrown is probably unlikely, so a week later at Leopardstown could be a better option," he told the website. "He is entered in the Guineas and that is in our minds as a possible race for him, but he would like a run beforehand. We will have to play it by ear because he has to improve a fair bit to figure in a Guineas. But all the horses seem fit and well and pretty forward." Dermot Weld also confirmed 2003 G3 Killavullan S. winner Grey Swallow on course for the Guineas Trial.
