MAGICAL MYSTERY TOUR

Six furlongs into yesterday's GII Mervin H. Muniz Jr. Memorial H., **Mystery Giver** (Dynaformer) had just one horse beaten and was looking for a way past the eight ahead of him. The prospects weren't promising for the 15-1 shot, but under an enterprising ride by Robby Albarado Jr., the bay threaded his way through the field as they raced down the Fair Grounds stretch and outfinished

fellow longshots **Herculated** (Louis Quatorze) and **Skate Away** (Belong to Me) for a 3/4-length victory. The six-year-old, a close fifth in this event last year, had shown an affinity for the course, winning three of six prior Fair Grounds appearances. Coming off a rallying neck score over Skate Away in the Jan. 31 Fair Grounds Breeders' Cup H., he now owns a piece of history at the track, as his final time of 1:48.29 was a course record. MERIDIANA BLOSSOMS IN ORCHID

It took her a few stateside races to find her best stride, but **Meridiana (Ger)** (Lomitas {GB}), a Classic winner in Europe, looked to be back in top form as she powered to a 1 1/4-length victory in the GII Orchid H. at Gulfstream yesterday. The chestnut, a Listed stakes winner in her native country, saved her best European performance for last, taking the G1 Oaks d'Italia last May. But she struggled in her first four starts in America, finishing off the board in the American Oaks, G1 Sword Dancer Invitational H. and GII Long Island H. last year. The four-year-old showed some improvement to run fourth in her 2004 debut, an optional allowance at Gulfstream Feb. 12, and signaled a return to form with a rallying victory at that level Mar. 5. Changing tactics in the 1 1/2-mile Orchid, Meridiana went right to the front, cruised along through pedestrian fractions and sprinted away from her rivals at the top of the lane to win handily. Luck apparently had little to do with it when Lucky Owners, winner of the G1 Hong Kong Mile over this course Dec. 14, scored a comfortable victory in Sunday's G1 Mercedes-Benz Hong Kong Derby at Sha Tin. Well placed throughout the 2000-meter contest, the New Zealand-bred gelding took command at the top of the stretch and held off the late challenge of Tiber. Tiber previously had finished ahead of Lucky Owners in their latest match-up last month in the G1 Hong Kong Classic Mile. "He's becoming a better racehorse and the extra trip was just what he needed," said winning trainer Tony Cruz. "Felix [Coetzee] got him into a lovely position from a wide draw and with the track riding fast, I was always confident he would be very hard to get past." According to Cruz, the gelding appears likely to make his next start in the Apr. 25 G1 Audemars Piguet QEII Cup, where he may face last year's Hong Kong Derby winner Elegant Fashion (Aus). "He'll definitely stay in training next year," Cruz added. "There's so much to aim for."

Last year's Hong Kong Derby winner Elegant Fashion proved she could run with the best in the world when she finished third in the Dec. 14 G1 Hong Kong Cup. Just 3 1/2 lengths behind Falbrav (Ire) in that 2000-meter test, the chestnut mare showed her versatility this time, dropping back in distance to record her first Hong Kong win at a mile. Rated off the pace of Self Flit early, she charged down the center of the track to take the lead in the final 200 meters and held off the late bid of Palette Natural for the victory. "She had never won over a mile here before, so I got a real kick out of that," trainer David Hayes said. "The plan was to ride her a bit colder and Gerald [Mosse] carried it out perfectly. That was as good as I've ever had her looking in the parade, too, so we can look forward to a great race next month." Making her third start of the year yesterday, Elegant Fashion was coming off a half-length second in the Feb. 22 CSL Hong Kong Gold Cup. She goes next in the Apr. 25 G1 Audemars Piguet QEII Cup.
