MCCANN'S POTRERO GRANDE

The lightly raced McCann's Mojave (Memo (Chi)) battled his more-fancied rivals and forged clear down the lane to win his graded stakes debut by a widening 1 3/4 lengths in a spill-marred GII Potrero Grande Breeders' Cup H. vesterday at Santa Anita. The four-year-old colt won back-to-back allowance contests over the Santa Anita strip last spring, but was away from the races for nearly 10 months before resurfacing to run seventh in a Jan. 24 optional claimer over track and trip. He rebounded to take the Sensational Star H. down the hill Feb. 14. Sent off at 6-1 yesterday, McCann's Mojave vied with Unfurl the Flag (Bertrando) and favored **Bluesthestandard** (American Standard) through fractions of :21.88, :44.30 and 1:08.89. Bluesthestandard began to fade nearing the stretch, while McCann's Mojave battled Unfurl the Flag into submission and pulled clear in the final furlong. "My horse just got in front and he's game, he'll put any horse away," said winning rider Jose Valdivia, Jr. The race was marred when Casas Caballo (Boston Harbor) broke down midway on the turn and Watchem Smokey (Alphabet Soup) fell attempting to avoid the stricken horse. Casas Caballo suffered a condylar fracture of his left front cannon bone and was euthanized. Watchem Smokey appeared uninjured, Jockey Martin Pedroza, aboard Casas Caballo, was taken to Arcadia Methodist Hospital for observation. Click for the brisnet.com chart or catalogue-style pedigree. NUMBERS DIP AT MAGIC MILLIONS PREMIER

"We were disappointed with [Sunday's] results, especially after having had record results at all our other sales so far this year," admitted Magic Millions Manager Director David Chester. "We thought the quality was better than last year, but the overall result is disappointing in comparison." Of the 266 yearlings on offer, 177 sold for A\$2,824,250, or an average of A\$15,956. Last year, 285 yearlings entered the ring, with the 220 that sold bringing A\$3,520,000, or an average of A\$16,000. The session's RNA rate of 33.5 percent was a substantial increase from the 2003 rate of 22.8 percent. The second and final session of the sale begins this morning at 10:30 a.m.
