NEW CODE FOR BLOODSTOCK INDUSTRY

British bloodstock agents and breeders will be asked to comply with a new industry code of practice. After yesterday's summit of representatives of racing and sales organisations at the Jockey Club, it was decided that a working group is to be created with the aim of developing a code of practice to apply to both private and public sales. This group, which will be chaired by the Thoroughbred Breeders' Association's Philip Freedman, will include a spectrum of interested parties. "The aim is to produce a code of practice which will further increase the transparency of sales transactions and promote confidence in the British bloodstock industry for the benefit of all concerned," the Jockey Club's Senior Steward Julian Richmond-Watson said yesterday. "Although the Jockey Club does not regulate the bloodstock industry, it will give every assistance to the setting up a code of practice and would be prepared to use its disciplinary powers to deal with breaches of the code."

THE BEST LAID PLANS by Christa Riebel

Most breeders struggle for years to produce a winner at the highest level, but for Carde Ostermann-Richter, it could not have worked out any easier. She is breeder of the globe-trotting seven-year-old Paolini (Ger) (Lando {Ger}), dead-heat winner of last Saturday's G1 Dubai Duty Free S. Paolini's renowned chestnut nose has been thrust into many of the world's most spectacular finishes, but it finally got him into the history books at Nad Al Sheba, making him the first German-bred and domestically trained horse to win at the highest level in Dubai. Besides his successes in the G1 Premio Presidente della Repubblica and G1 Gran Premio di Milano at four, Paolini also boasts second places in the 2001 GI Canadian International, last year's GI Arlington Million, 2002 G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup and G1 Hong Kong Cup, and the 2003 renewal of the G1 Dubai Duty Free.

Ostermann-Richter is typically grounded about the whole affair. "Naturally I am overjoyed about Paolini's victory here," she said from Dubai. "But I was always just as delighted when he finishes in the frame, like last year when he ended up a close second in this race. I am always happy to see him run well, but I am always glad when he returns safe and sound."

Such sentimentality is understandable considering the incredible fact that Paolini is the first Thoroughbred Ostermann-Richter bred.

Lando, the best son of German champion Acatenango (Ger), was not averse to international forays himself, having won the G1 Japan Cup in 1995. When he retired to stud at Gestut Ittlingen, Ostermann-Richter acquired the Listed-placed mare Prairie Darling (Ire) (Stanford {Ire}), who had already produced the Group 1-winning champion Platini (Ger), especially to send to the stallion. Her foresight was rewarded instantly when Paolini, the best of Lando's first crop and his best to date, arrived that spring.

While an honorable retirement is in the offing eventually, his proud owner-breeder believes the story is not finished yet. "He is such an easy-going character at seven and is as sound as a bell," she continued. "He still posesses that great turn of foot and his next targets will be the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup [at Sha Tin Apr. 25] and G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup [at Kranji May 16], but I am also thinking about possibly running him in the G1 Bayerisches Zuchtrennen [at Munich Aug. 1]. But I do not tend to make too many plans, I play it by ear and see how the horse goes."
