### **HEAR MY VOICE**

Baron Thierry de Zuylen de Nyevelt's Voix du Nord (Fr) (Valanour {Ire}) enjoyed a smooth and successful return to the races in yesterday's G2 Prix Noailles at Longchamp. Sent off the 13-10 pick in the first major trial for the Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby), the homebred stalked the tearaway Kensington (Ger) (Dashing Blade {GB}) and his own rabbit Alcinos (Fr) (Highest Honor {Fr}) before being asked the question by Christophe Soumillon approaching the quarter pole.

Winding up to top gear, he took command before building a comfortable three-length advantage over Cherry Mix (Fr) (Linamix {Fr}), as the luckless Fast and Furious (Fr) (Singspiel {Ire}) closed late for third. Voix du Nord emerged on the scene when splitting Gwaihir (Ire) and Toasted (winner of Saturday's

La Puente S. at Santa Anita) in the Listed Criterium du FEE at Deauville in August. He followed that with two fine efforts at this track when fourth behind Bago (Fr) in the G3 Prix des Chenes in September and second in the G3 Prix de Conde the following month. Stepped up to 10 furlongs for the first time, he proved that stamina was his strong point when besting Simplex (Fr) by 1 1/2 lengths in the G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud in November. He now has to defy the hoodoo faced by winners of that contest in attempting to win the following year's Chantilly Classic June 6. "He's real good," commented conditioner David Smaga. "He was the only group winner in the field, so that was no surprise to me. The question we were asking today was, 'had he come from the winter?' and he said, 'yes.' I like the way he did it and the G1 Prix Lupin back here [May 16] is the next stop before Chantilly." ### A TRIPLE CROWN HERO?

G1 Golden Slipper winner **Dance Hero (Aus)** (Danzero {Aus}) moved one step closer to taking Australia's two-year-old Triple Crown with his win in Saturday's seven-

furlong G1 AJC Sires' Produce S. at Randwick. Sent out 7-4 favourite, Dance Hero skipped away effortlessly from his wide barrier to take the lead and control the race. Settled a length ahead of stablemate Wager (Aus) (Flying Spur {Aus}) early, he was sent wide around the turn, as jockey Glen Boss felt that the track, rated dead, was uneven closer to the fence, but the extra ground proved no problem for the

professional little youngster as he held off Wager for a 3/4-length score. "He's an awesome horse, he can control the race and relax wherever you put him," said Boss. Asked if Dance Hero had the potential to be the best horse she has handled, trainer Gai Waterhouse replied, "I think so, and that's the really exciting thing. He is such a professional...he is a joy to train. They all come at him, but they can't get past him." Dance Hero will try to complete his Triple while carrying his speed a mile for the first time in the Apr. 18 G1 Champagne S. He would become the first juvenile since Burst (Aus) to win all three races, and only the fifth overall.

### **EARNINGS CRUNCH**

Who will get into the starting gate on the first Saturday in May...and who will be left out in the cold? With just one major prep race left for the 2004 GI Kentucky Derby, it is certain that there will be more than 20 three-year-olds vying for a berth at Churchill Downs. Solid performances Saturday have earned several colts spots into the field. Smarty Jones (Elusive Quality) picked up his first graded purse, pocketing \$600,000 for his win in the GII Arkansas Derby. Also adding their names to the mix were GI Wood Memorial hero Tapit (Pulpit), who jumped from 29th to fifth on the list, and Wood runner-up Master David (Grand Slam), who moved from 32nd to 19th. Borrego (El Prado {Ire}) kept his spot on the roster with a second at Oaklawn. For the top 30 three-year-olds, see p2.

### **Blue Grass Round-Up**

In addition to winner **The Cliff's Edge** (Gulch), four of the runners from Saturday's GI Toyota Blue Grass S. at Keeneland will head to Louisville for the May 1 Kentucky Derby. Trainer Patrick Biancone said of runner-up **Lion Heart** (Tale of the Cat), "He ran a great race. He ran very brave and he fought hard. We are here, we are

in good shape and we just have to cross our fingers for the next three weeks and hope nothing happens to him." Limehouse (Grand Slam), who pressed the pace before settling for third, is also Derby bound, but will likely employ new tactics in the Classic. "I don't think he liked being

close to the lead," jockey Jose Santos said. "When I took him back, he settled and responded. I'd love to ride him in the Derby. If he comes from off the pace, I think the distance will be no problem." Champion Action This Day (Kris S.) put in another lackluster effort to be sixth, but could still run in the Derby. "I'm disappointed," trainer Richard Mandella said. "I have no excuses. He is not running the way he did as a two-year-old and I don't know why." But, he added, "I will go on to Louisville and see what happens." Trainer Bob Baffert will also persevere with seventh-place finisher Preachinatthebar (Silver Charm), who is currently 20th on the earnings list. "He's going on to Louisville as long as there is nothing wrong with him," Baffert said.

### **Master David Headed for the Derby**

Trainer Bobby Frankel, who finished second in the Derby with Aptitude in 2000 and again with Empire



Maker last year, will try to earn his first victory in the event with Master David (Grand Slam), a solid second in Saturday's GI Wood Memorial S. at Aqueduct. "He's in the Derby," Frankel said. "He ran great [Saturday] and I'm

Master David Benoit photo very happy with him. I think he got beat because he didn't see [Tapit] on the outside." Added Alex Solis, who has run second in three Derbies since 1997, but has yet to win one in 13 tries, "He just got a little tired. He needed the race. This will set him up good for his next race."

### **Awaiting the Belmont**

Little Matth Man (Matty G), who was seventh in the Wood and is unlikely to have enough earnings to get into the Derby field, will likely be taken off the Triple Crown trail until the final jewel, the June 5 GI Belmont S. "I think we're going to take a shot with him in the Belmont," trainer Michael Ciresa said. An \$11,000 OBSWIN juvenile purchase, the dark bay took the Whirlaway S. and was third in the GII Lane's End S. at Turfway Park.

### **Eddington Out on Earnings?**

Eddington (Unbridled) ran a very promising third in the Wood, beaten only a half length, but is 28th on the



Derby list for graded-stakes earnings and will need a lot of help to get into the race that his sire won 14 years ago. Still, trainer Mark Hennig was pleased with his effort. "He lost interest [at the top of the stretch], but then he picked it up again when he saw Master David coming on the inside," Hennig said. "He started run-Eddington Horsephotos ning again. It was a terrific race, and I would love to run in the Kentucky

Derby. I just hope he has enough earnings to get in."

### But Borrego is a Go

Borrego (El Prado {Ire}), runner-up in the GII Arkansas Derby and 15th in graded earnings, is likely to go on to Louisville. "I am delighted with my horse's race," trainer Beau Greely said. "He is getting better at the right time. I am thinking Kentucky Derby." Currently 26th on the list, third-place finisher Pro Prado (El Prado {Ire}) will need an assist to get into the Derby, but trainer Robert Holthus is hoping for the chance to run. "Our horse fits with these and always runs his race," Holthus said, adding, "I have been around a while. It may be my last chance for the Derby. [Mr. James A. Winn, husband of the colt's owner] isn't in good health--it could be his last Derby opportunity as well."

### Castledale Still on the Fence

Trainer Jeff Mullins said yesterday that Castledale (Ire) (Peintre Celebre), upset winner of the Apr. 3 GI Santa Anita Derby, has rebounded well from his victory, but is still an uncertain Kentucky Derby candidate. "We're just light training," Mullins said. "But he's eating good and doing good, so he's starting to come back around a little bit. He's probably 50-50 [to run in the Derby]."

A SECRET NO LONGER True Love's Secret (Desert Secret {Ire}) was an 11-1 outsider in yesterday's Yankee Affair S. at Gulfstream Park, but that didn't stop him from setting a new world record as he dashed through five furlongs on the turf in :53.85 over a firm course. The old mark of :54.60 was set by General Express at Monmouth Park in 2000 and equaled by Bop at Penn National in 2002. The seven-year-old True Love's Secret, who could have been claimed for \$40,000 from his latest start, had won 11 of his 21 prior tries at five-eighths on the lawn. "This horse is a warrior," trainer Rudy Wolfendale, who has conditioned the gelding for four years, said. "When the chips are down, he always finds a way to come through. I thought he was beat about two or three times [yesterday] and he just kept coming on and found a way. I'm so proud of him."

The Sir Michael Stoute-trained Fort Dignity (Seeking the Gold) will line up against Three Valleys (Diesis {GB}) in Thursday's G3 Craven S. at Newmarket, the Racing Post revealed yesterday. Britton House Stud's Fort Dignity, a Yarmouth conditions scorer last out, impressed in his workout alongside fellow Classic hopefuls Imperial Stride (GB) (Indian Ridge {Ire}) and Eden Rock (Ire) (Danehill) and older horse Gamut (Ire) (Spectrum {Ire}). Conditioner Roger Charlton also expressed himself pleased with the progress of Juddmonte Farms' Three Valleys, who will turn up for the mile prep, "as long as the ground isn't slow."
