Pollard's Vision (Carson City) worked five furlongs at Keeneland Sunday morning in 1:01. The breeze was the colt's first since winning the Apr. 3 GII Illinois Derby. After the drill, Pollard's Vision and stablemates **Limehouse** (Grand Slam) and **Ashado** (Saint Ballado) shipped to Churchill Downs.

St. Averil (Saint Ballado), most recently sixth in the Apr. 3 GI Santa Anita Derby, worked five furlongs at Santa Anita yesterday in :59 2/5. Jockey Tyler Baze was in the irons. Trainer Rafael Becerra was happy with the work, but said a decision on the Kentucky Derby would have to wait. "I would just like to see how he does the next couple of days and we will wait and see," Becerra said. "He will have one more work here [at Santa Anita] Saturday and then we will really decide."

GI Santa Anita Derby third-place finisher **Rock Hard Ten** (Kris S.) worked seven furlongs at Churchill Downs in 1:27 3/5. Retired jockey Corey Black was in the irons. The giant colt currently stands 29th on the graded earnings list of Derby hopefuls. "We will just wait and see what happens," said trainer Jason Orman. "If we don't get in, we will probably go to the Preakness." Orman added that a start in the GIII Derby Trial a week before the Derby to boost Rock Hard Ten's graded earnings was unlikely, but possible. "We will probably give him a breeze next Monday and then see what happens Wednesday," Orman said. "I just think three races in a month is too much for a young horse, especially when you are probably going to run the toughest race of your life in the next start."
