NOTHING IS SET IN STONE

Rock Hard Ten (Kris S.) has been entered for today's GIII Derby Trial S. at Churchill Downs, but his connections are going to wait until the last minute before



deciding whether to run--and if he is in the starting gate this afternoon, it is unlikely he will return for the May 1 GI Kentucky Derby. The ebony colt is currently 23rd on the Derby list for graded earnings. Trainer Jason Orman is hoping for a last-minute miracle to get his colt into the field, but will use the Derby Trial as a prep for the May 15 GI Preakness S. if his prospects for the first Saturday in May look less than rosy. "If it looks like we won't get into

the Derby, we'll probably run [in the Derby Trial]," Orman said. "It just buys us some time and then we'll have a prep for the Preakness." Rock Hard Ten was impressive winning his first two starts, taking a seven-furlong maiden test at Santa Anita Feb. 7 and adding a one-mile allowance score Mar. 3. Stepped up sharply for the Apr. 3 GI Santa Anita Derby, Rock Hard Ten was bet down to 3-1 and crossed the finish line just a head behind Castledale (Ire), but was disgualified and placed third for drifting in during the stretch drive. The \$60,000 difference in purse money would have earned him a Derby berth. "It's frustrating, but it might be for the best," Orman said. "You never know." The 3-5 choice on the morning line, Rock Hard Ten faces the streaking Bwana Charlie (Indian Charlie), who made it three in a row with a 3 1/4-length tally over Quick Action (Carson City) in the Apr. 4 GIII Lafayette S. at Keeneland.

EPICENTRE OF THE ELKHORN UNIVERSE

Epicentre (Kris S.) lost out on a first stakes win when he was disgualified from a narrow score in last fall's GI Hollywood Turf Cup, but the Juddmonte homebred broke through vesterday with a 4 3/4-length triumph in the 1 1/2-miles GIII Elkhorn S. at Keeneland. Epicentre, who began his career with John Gosden in England, won his U.S. debut over the Keeneland turf last April and was sixth in the GIII C F Burke H. at Santa Anita before his Turf Cup run Nov. 22. He returned from a three-month layoff to win a Feb. 20 optional claimer at Santa Anita, but was coming off a fifth-place effort in the Mar. 14 GIII Golden Gate Breeders' Cup H. Made the 6-5 Elkhorn favorite. Epicentre was never far back behind slow fractions, angled out for running room at the quarter mile and reeled in the pacesetters with a furlong to run to win going away. "I was just hoping he could get out turning for home," admitted winning trainer Bobby Frankel. "This is the best this horse has ever been since I've had him. Last year's San Fran Mile winner **Ninebanks** makes his 2004 debut. The six-year-old battled to a nose decision in the 2003 edition of the race, then was off the board in two of his next three starts before rebounding to take the California Turf Championship H. over course and distance Sept. 1. Third in the Sept. 26 GIII Bay Meadows Breeders' Cup H., the bay has not been out since running second in the Oct. 26 Pacifica H. He is four-for-six lifetime at a mile. Singletary went to the bench after tiring to be fifth in the Sept. 6 GII Del Mar Derby. The four-year-old returned to take the Feb. 11 Thunder Road H. at Santa Anita and was most recently second, beaten a half length by Sweet Return (GB), in the Mar. 6 GII Kilroe Mile H. Motel Staff, haltered from three consecutive starts between November and January, followed a win versus \$25,000 claiming company Jan. 18 with a five-length score for a \$40,000 tag under new management Feb. 5. The seven-year-old gelding switched to the dirt and finished a distant fourth in an optional claimer Feb. 28, but returned to the winner's circle after a neck success on the Golden Gate lawn Mar. 20. He has been on the board in eight of nine Bay Meadows tries.



Saeed Suhail's Sublimity looks to be in the typical mold of an improving older horse trainer Michael Stoute excels with. He may have found the ground too fast when fourth in the Listed Hampton Court S. at Royal Ascot last June, but shaped with promise when filling the same spot in the Listed Ben Marshall S. at Newmarket in November. Looking a different horse on his return in the Listed Doncaster Mile last time Mar. 25, he picked up Gateman in smooth fashion en route to his first stakes score. That rival defeated Sublimity's well-regarded stable companion Kalaman (Ire) in the G3 Earl of Sefton S. at Newmarket Apr. 14. He is also typical of his trainer Mark Johnston's stock in that he relishes a battle, something the Sandown hill usually brings into play. G1 Fillies' Mile winner and G1 Coronation S. runner-up Soviet Song was disappointing when second on her return in the Listed Snowdrop S. at Kempton Apr. 10 and needs to bounce back.

Madcap Escapade Sizzles in Oaks Work

Undefeated Madcap Escapade (Hennessy) worked five furlongs in a bullet :58.20 over a sloppy Churchill track yesterday. The filly, winner of the GI Ashland S. in her most recent trip to the post, galloped out six furlongs in 1:11.20. "She was in-hand," trainer Frank Brothers said of the work. "It's hard to believe one would work like that in-hand, but you really had to see the work. But that's pretty much the way she usually works and it wouldn't bother me if it came up muddy for the [Apr. 30 GI Kentucky] Oaks, I'll tell you that. I don't want to have a bad day, but she surely liked the 'off' track." Of the speedy filly who has won her only four races to date, Brothers added, "She's just a hell of an athlete. There's not many of them that come along like that. That doesn't make her win the Kentucky Oaks, by no means, but she's a pretty special filly."

Also working towards Friday's Oaks: GII Fantasy S. winner **House of Fortune** (Free House) worked six furlongs in 1:12.60 at Hollywood Park Friday; Fantasy runner-up **Island Sand** (Tabasco Cat) worked five furlongs over Churchill's sloppy track yesterday in 1:01 and galloped out six furlongs in 1:15.20; GI Santa Anita Oaks winner **Silent Sighs** (Benchmark) breezed five furlongs in 1:00.80 at Santa Anita yesterday.

African Dream, a gelding claimed from the Paul Cole stable for £20,000 by Peter Chapple-Hyam out of a 1 3/4-length victory at Lingfield Feb. 21, continued the fairytale story by taking this contest in style. His success is even more remarkable due to the fact that he "is lame 90 percent of his life," according to his trainer. "He can't walk, can't trot, but he can canter all right and he gallops not too bad either," he added. He demonstrated that quality when taking a conditions event over easy ground at Kempton by nine lengths Mar. 27 and a Newbury handicap a week previous to this affair, after which connections decided to take the plunge. Settled in third by Jimmy Quinn throughout the early stages, he was full of run in the straight and quickened to the front with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining. Despite spooking inside the final eighth and veering to the left, he lost no momentum as he maintained the gallop up the hill to comfortably hold odds-on favorite Privy Seal and Frankie Dettori. African Dream is destined to race abroad now. "We can't run in the Epsom Derby as he's been gelded and he's not far from being a pretty useful horse," added Chapple-Hyam, enjoying his first stakes win since returning from Hong Kong. JOCKEYS PROTEST VALENZUELA RULING

Members of the Southern California jockey colony are upset by a decision to allow Patrick Valenzuela to ride while awaiting the appeal of his suspension. Valenzuela had his conditional license suspended Jan. 23 after he failed to submit to a drug test, and, on Apr. 2 stewards chose not to reinstate the much-troubled jockey at least through the end of 2004, but California Horse Racing Board chairman John Harris granted a stay of that suspension. A letter addressed to Harris and signed by 18 Southern California riders called Valenzuela, "a detriment to the horse racing industry and all those who abide by its rules" and added, "He continues to tarnish the professionalism and integrity that jockeys must display to the public for the betterment of the entire industry." The jockeys called for an additional evaluation to determine Valenzuela's mental and physical fitness for riding. The riders who signed the letter are: Paul Atkinson, Tyler Baze, Omar Berrio, Alex Bisono, Jon Court, Kent Desormeaux, Victor Espinoza, Matt Garcia, Angel Gonzalez, Jr., Luis Jauregui, Corey Nakatani, Mick Ruis, Chris Russell, Mike Smith, Javier Santiago, Alex Solis, Jose Valdivia, Jr., and Octavio Vergara. The letter was also signed by Jockeys' Guild vice president Albert Fiss. Valenzuela is expected to return to race riding Sunday at Hollywood Park.

Keeneland Meet Ends With Record Attendance:

An all-time record 232,826 people attended Keeneland's 15-day spring meet, which concluded yesterday. The previous record was 232,499 for 17 days in the fall of 2003. The daily average attendance of 15,522 was also a record, topping the 14,649 for 15 days in the spring of 2001. "Everything fell into place during the spring meeting," said Keeneland President Nick Nicholson. "Hard work by our employees, outstanding racing, tremendous support from our corporate partners, successful promotions and an enthusiastic community combined with outstanding weather to produce the record figures."

Given a shot on the main track, the bald-faced chestnut defeated subsequent Classic winner Empire Maker in the Sham S. last February, but had his Triple Crown dreams derailed with a seventh-place effort in the GII San Felipe S. and was shelved off his 10th-place finish in the GII Arkansas Derby just over a year ago. Aggressive off the layoff, Man Among Men dragged his way to the front, was allowed to dictate even fractions on the front end, turned back the bid of Moonshine Hall at midstretch and edged clear. The win gave jockey Jerry Bailey a sweep of the late Pick Three.

KUANYAN (f, 4, Carson City--Plate Queen {MGSW, \$279,139}, by Pilgrim) returned from a six-month hiatus to run a close third in a Gulfstream allowance Feb. 20 before posting a 5 3/4-length triumph at the same track Mar. 29. The 2-1 second choice went up to duel for the lead, but shook loose at the head of the lane and pulled away to score by 3 1/4 lengths under a hand ride.
