registering a third in this event last year. The home team puts forth a formidable challenge this afternoon, led by Lucky Owners (NZ) (Danehill), who bested Bowman's Crossing (Ire) (Dolphin Street (Fr)) in the G1 Hong Kong Mile in December. The mare Elegant Fashion (Aus) (Danewin {Aus}), second in this event in 2003, was an excellent third to Falbrav (Ire) in the G1 Hong Kong Cup and could venture overseas should she perform well today.

ZITO OFF TO OUICK START AT CHURCHILL

Sir Shackleton (Miswaki) won't be going on to next weekend's Kentucky Derby, but the Tracy Farmer homebred got Derby week off to an auspicious start for trainer Nick Zito, scoring his third consecutive victory in the GIII Derby Trial S. on opening day in Louisville. Second to the talented Forest Danger in his Feb. 14 bow at Gulfstream, the chestnut bounced back to win his maiden in Hallandale on Florida Derby day Mar. 13 and was coming into this off a powerful first-level allowance score at Keeneland Apr. 9. With the pace from between Quick Action (Carson City) on the rail and GIII Lafayette S. winner Bwana Charlie (Indian Charlie) to the outside, Sir Shackleton poked his head in front turning for home and dug in gamely to defeat Courageous Act (Exploit). "I've always wanted to win the Derby Trial," Zito admitted. "There are certain races you want to win and this is one of them. It's just a cool race. This is a very nice horse and our job now will be to take care of him, because it looks like he has a big future. This is an incredible way to start Derby week." Click for the brisnet.com chart.

Eased off the rail by jockey Jose Valdivia Jr. for the drive, Singletary went after the pacesetter approaching the final furlong and edged away to the narrow score. A respectable sixth in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot, he failed to make an impact during the remainder of his sophomore campaign, but shaped with promise on his return when third behind Gateman in the G3 Earl of Sefton S. at Newmarket last time Apr. 14. Racing keenly trapped wide in midpack in this contest, he settled when found cover and was full of run inside the final guarter as Gateman turned on the pressure from the front. He quickened past that rival with 250 yards to race and had enough to contain Gateman on the uphill climb to the line. "He traveled very well but pulls up in front," explained Dobbs. "The other horse was coming back to me, but he's very tough." The bay won the Tokyo City H. last year, his lone victory from six starts. In two trips to the post this term, the six-year-old was fourth in the GII San Carlos H. Mar. 7 and fifth to Dynever in the GII San Bernardino H. at Santa Anita Apr. 3. Trainer Wally Dollase had won graded stakes at Hawthorne, twice with Ten Most Wanted (Illinois Derby and National Jockey Club H.) and Bare Necessities in last year's GIII Sixty Sails H. He seemed destined to add to that streak vesterday, but Jim Tafel's Allspice denied the heavily favored Bare Necessities in her repeat attempt. A stakes winner in her final start at two, Allspice failed to find the winner's circle in just four starts in a sophomore campaign, which included runner-up finishes to Lady Tak in the Thelma S. and the Tiffany Lass S. over the winter. Fifth in the GII Silverbulletday S. in February and in the GI Ashland S. in April, the bay did not race again until finishing second in a Fair Grounds optional claimer Feb. 12. Seventh two back in the Krantz Memorial H. in New Orleans, she was most recently runner-up in a Mar. 25 two-turn event at Fair Grounds. Settled in second as Mavoreen went easily on the lead, Allspice responded when set down for the drive, collared Mavoreen with an eighth of a mile to run and just held off the favorite at the wire. "Things worked out perfect," said a breathless winning rider Chris Emigh. "I got a good start out of the gate and it felt like we were just walking. 
Chilly Rooster took a Dec. 19 optional claimer on the main track at Calder in his final start of 2003, but had been fourth in his four prior starts this term. The dark bay switched to the turf in his second outing of the year and finished two lengths behind Spotted Owl in a NW3X allowance at Gulfstream Park Jan. 23, then missed by a length and a half at that level Mar. 4. He had a new jockey last time, but clipped heels and nearly fell with Manoel Cruz replacing regular rider Sahannon Uske at Gulfstream Mar. 25. With Uske back in the irons for his stakes debut, Chilly Rooster tucked in behind the leaders to the final bend, drove between horses to take the lead at the top of the lane and turned back the challenge of 50-1 Union Place to post the upset. "I couldn't believe how great [the race] was setting up," said Uske, celebrating her second gradedstakes win (she got her first with Smokume in the 2003 GIII Cowdin S.). "I knew I had horse--that's why I sent him through there. I didn't want to get stuck in traffic." This was the fourth Fort Marcy score for trainer Allen Jerkens, who also won with Beau Bugle (1975) and John's Gold (1983), both owned by Hobeau; and with Joseph Allen's Saint Verre last year. Chancellor emerged on to the scene when taking the G3 Classic Trial at this track in 2001 and showed his affinity for Sandown's contours when adding this contest the following year. Winless since taking the G2 Royal Whip S. at The Curragh in August 2002, he had showed he retained his ability when fourth in the G2 Prix Dollar at Longchamp on his last start of 2003. After a lackluster ninth in the Listed Magnolia S. at Kempton on his return Apr. 12, he came in for a power-packed ride from champion jockey Kieren Fallon back on his happy hunting ground. He settled in a stalking role throughout the early stages, was driven to challenge the penalised Nysaean with 100 yards remaining and battled past that rival up the hill. Winner of the G1 Hong Kong Sprint last December, the bay gelding added the HK-G1 Bauhinia Sprint Trophy Feb. 1 and the HK-G1 Centenary Sprint Cup Mar. 13. An unlikely horse has emerged a possible threat to the favorite in the form of Electronic Unicorn. Named Horse of the Year in Hong Kong in 2002, the son of Housebuster was rumored to be on the brink of retirement after suffering a ruptured sheath around his left fore tendon. Second in consecutive runnings of the G1 Hong Kong Mile, the eight-year-old won his last three starts of 2003, including the G1-HK Champions' Mile last Apr. 27.

His smooth success in the Listed Prix Policeman at Cagnes sur Mer Feb. 20 suggests he will be able to hold his own in this competitive trial for the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club at Chantilly June 6. Millemix was beaten a head by Prospect Park (GB) when runner-up in the Listed Prix de Coucelles at this venue last time Apr. 4 and holds both the third Blue Canari and sixth Saville Row on that form. Day or Night chased home Voix du Nord (Fr) when third in the Criterium de Saint-Cloud in November. He returned to record a fluent conditions score here Apr. 1 and warrants respect from the stable responsible for the 2002 winner Act One (GB). Sinister G (Matty G), upset winner of the GII Lane's End S. at Turfway Park Mar. 20, has been officially ruled out of consideration for the Run for the Roses by trainer John Toscano. The colt was scheduled for a breeze at Belmont Park yesterday morning, but has not sufficiently recovered from a cough. The work was scrapped, as were any plans to make the trip to Louisville. "We're out," the conditioner confirmed. "Sometimes Mother Nature takes over and if the horse is not right, to put him in the Derby would be foolish." The defection assures a spot in the starting gate for GII Coolmore Lexington S. third Song of the Sword (Unbridled's Song), who moves to 20th on the list of graded-stakes earnings.

Rock Hard Ten to Shoot for Derby

Rock Hard Ten (Kris S.) was scratched from yester-day's GIII Derby Trial S. and connections hope the colt will draw into the body of the Kentucky Derby when entries are taken Wednesday afternoon. "Our chances of getting into the field are looking a little better," trainer Jason Orman told *Thoroughbred Times*. "And if we get in, we'll want to have the best chance." If he does not make the Derby, Orman said Rock Hard Ten would work Monday for the Preakness May 15.

Servis All Smiles Following Smarty's Work

Undefeated Smarty Jones (Elusive Quality) delighted his connections when he worked five furlongs yesterday morning in a crisp:58 at Churchill Downs. It was the fastest of 34 works at the distance. Sent out immediately after the renovation break, the GII Arkansas Derby winner was caught in fractions of :22 4/5 for his opening quarter mile, :34 4/5 for three-eighths and out six furlongs in 1:11 1/5. "I am tickled to death. It went very good," trainer John Servis enthused following the move. "He looked good. I think he really liked the track. He was ready for a work." Servis explained that the breeze did not unfold exactly according to plan. "He had a horse break off in front of him going to the threeeighths pole....kind of dropped over in front of him. [Exercise rider and jockey] Willie [Martinez] had to take a hold of him. He said as soon as he took a hold, he came back to him. He hollared at the girl and the girl eased out. She didn't leave much room and he gave him his head and he shot right through there."

Birdstone Flies His Five Eighths

By a Kentucky Derby-winning sire and out of a mare which produced the winner of last year's GI Kentucky Oaks, Marylou Whitney's Birdstone (Grindstone) may be the hunch horse in this year's Derby. The diminutive bay went a long way toward proving that he could be a factor in this year's race when he cruised through a five-furlong workout yesterday morning in :58 2/5. Working to the seven-eighths pole, the winner of last year's GI Champagne S. galloped out six furlongs in 1:12 3/5 to the delight of trainer Nick Zito. "He went very well," he said. "Good horses work this way. It was a great work and I think it gives him a decent shot next Saturday." For all his accomplishments, the homebred figures a big price come post time, but should not be overlooked, according to his trainer. "He was high on the pole as a two-year-old and it wouldn't be that much of a surprise if he were to win. He got sidetracked for a while, but he's back now." The winner of a Gulfstream allowance Feb. 14, Birdstone was a disappointing fifth in the GII Lane's End S. He was scratched from the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. Apr. 10 with an elevated high white blood cell count.

A pair of California-based horses, neither of which has been confirmed as a starter in the Derby, had their major pre-race workouts yesterday morning in the Golden State. At Hollywood Park, GI Santa Anita Derby hero Castledale (Ire) (Peintre Celebre) breezed a strong six furlongs in 1:11 4/5 beneath his regular rider Jose Valdivia Jr. Owned in part by TVG personality Frank Lyons, the colt galloped out an extra eighth of a mile in :12 1/5. "He went really good," trainer Jeff Mullins commented, who indicated that a decision on whether to run in the Derby would be made this morning. "The day after is always the key day," Mullins explained.

A decision is also pending on the Derby status of **St Averil** (Saint Ballado), who worked three-quarters of a mile in 1:11 4/5 at Santa Anita for trainer Rafael Becerra. The Stan Fulton runner, who has been plagued by foot problems, was fitted with a bar shoe and was guided through the breeze by his jockey Tyler Baze. "He seems OK, in good form," Becerra commented. "He went his last quarter in :23 2/5, but when he's good he can do this."

Big Names Breeze Ahead of Oaks

Grade I winner Ashado (Saint Ballado) tuned up for next Saturday's GI Kentucky Oaks with a sharp drill, covering five-eighths in :59. "It was a little faster than we normally go with our horses," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "But this track was faster than normal this morning after the break. The main thing was she skipped right along doing it. A horse broke off in front of her and that got her going." Joining Ashado was California shipper A.P. Adventure (A.P. Indy), who went five furlongs in 1:00.80. "The work was good," said trainer Wally Dollase. "Not too fast, but not too slow. Raul [exercise rider Vizcarrondo] said she really wanted to go. He said she finished up strong." Victory U. S. A. (Victory Gallop), who upset champion Halfbridled in the GII Stonerside Beaumont S. Apr. 8, cruised through five panels in 1:00.40...Out at Hollywood Park, Hollywood Story (Wild Rush) completed six furlongs in 1:13.40. "She went along at her usual good clip," said assistant trainer Michelle Jensen, who was in the irons for the work. "She cooled out fine." The three-year-old is scheduled to ship to Churchill Monday.
