#### **Slow Work for Friends Lake**

Friends Lake (A.P. Indy), looking to become the second straight New York-bred to win the GI Kentucky Derby, had his final major prep for the race at Churchill Downs yesterday morning. Working over a very sloppy

track, the chestnut went five furlongs in 1:03, but trainer John Kimmel was not disappointed by the slow final time. "He worked in driving rain," Kimmel said. "But he looked good and he finished good. It was hard to see the last eighth, but I caught him in under :12." The clockers timed Friends Lake



the colt in splits of :13, :26 and :39 and had him galloping out six furlong in 1:17. Friends Lake, who has not been out since taking the Mar. 13 GI Florida Derby, shipped in from Payson Park at the end of last week. "I thought about giving him his final work [at Payson] on Saturday and then shipping up, but decided to come early and get a work in over the track," Kimmel said. "But the weather has been terrible since we got here. I hope he got what he needed from the work."

#### Wimbledon Aces Final Prep

While Friends Lake may have been slowed by the sloppy strip, Wimbledon (Wild Rush) showed an affinity

for the track. Working in company with stablemate Determined, the gray dashed off his five furlongs in a bullet:59.40 yesterday and went out threequarters in 1:12.20. "It was very nice," trainer Bob Baffert said of the move. "The track was demanding and, because of Wimbledon that, I think it's hard to gauge,

but I think he got a lot out of it...I knew he would like it here and every work has been great." He added, "This is a big old dude with a lot of natural raw talent, like a big dorky kid, [but] he's getting it down now."

"When you take a closer look, you'll see that there were only 18 horses during that period who came into the Derby without an April race," he said. "Of those, only four had a legitimate shot at winning. So it's really only 0-for-four, and even the best hitter in baseball has an O-for-four day." Read the Footnotes is set to have his final work today.

#### Pletcher Duo Beat Bad Weather

The early bird beats the rain. Trainer Todd Pletcher had Limehouse (Grand Slam) out at 5:45 a.m. yesterday, before the skies opened up and turned the track into a sea of slop. Coming off a third in the Apr. 10 GI Toyota Blue Grass S., the colt went five-eighths in 1:01 with stablemate Speightstown. "We went head-andhead for most of the work," said exercise rider Michelle Nihei, who was aboard Limehouse for the breeze. "Limehouse got the best of [Speightstown] right at the finish. He was strong out there today." She added, "The track was pretty good--it was holding together." Pletcher was back out with GII Illinois Derby winner Pollard's Vision (Carson City) at 6:15. Also working in company, the one-eyed runner drew off from his stablemate at the wire and was clocked in 1:00.80 for five furlongs. "I was happy with both their works," Pletcher said. "It was what we needed to get them ready."

#### All Systems Go for Borrego

Also working five furlongs over the wet strip at Churchill yesterday was GII Arkansas Derby runner-up Borrego (El Prado {Ire}), who went his five-eighths in 1:03 3/5. The chestnut clicked off splits of :13, :25.80, :38 and :51.20 and galloped out three-quarters in 1:19.60. "I liked what I saw," trainer Beau Greely remarked. "It was a good work for him--just what we wanted. Basically it was just a maintenance work. He's plenty fit."

## **Belmont Breeze for Eddington**

Eddington (Unbridled) will need at least a couple of defections to get into the Derby field, but is keeping fit

just in case. The Mark Hennig trainee worked at Belmont yesterday morning, going five furlongs in 1:00 and galloping out three-quarters in 1:13 1/5. The colt is not already at Churchill because of a lack of graded earnings, but Hennig does not disagree with the system used to determine who gets into the race. "I don't think there's a lot wrong with it," he said. "We had our opportunities." If

#### A Late Bloomer...

Sold during the summer of 2002 to Hong Kong Jockey Club Chairman Ronald Arculli and later gelded, River Dancer struggled to find the winner's circle, but turned in some promising efforts, most notably a fourth in last year's QE II Cup. However, he had managed just two minor placings in 11 starts since that appearance and was coming off a 10th to Elegant Fashion in the Chairman's Trophy over a mile Mar. 21. Settled in sixth early as fellow European import Saturn (Ire) (Marju {Ire}) set a moderate gallop, he advanced on the final turn, raced in tandem with Elegant Fashion past midstretch and edged clear from the five-year-old mare late to light up the tote at 57-1. "He was always travelling well and it was the first time there has been speed on for him," commented winning rider Glyn Schofield. "He's a good honest horse and I knew he would keep finding for me, which he did." River Dancer becomes the first locally based winner of this event since 2000. Most on hand thought that distinction would fall to Lucky Owners (NZ) (Danehill), the G1 Hong Kong Mile and Hong Kong Derby winner who was dispatched the 6-5 favorite. But the Tony Cruz trainee never looked comfortable, came under pressure with a half mile to run and struggled home sixth. "He just never picked up for me," a dejected jockey Felix Coetzee said. "It was disappointing." Both River Dancer and Elegant Fashion, who filled the runner-up spot for a second consecutive year, are possible for the G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup, the second leg of the World Series Racing Championship, at Kranji May 16. As if it was a mere formality, Silent Witness broke cleanly from the two hole, took command midway on the turn and waltzed home an easy winner to complete a clean sweep of the Champions Sprint Series and set an all-time Hong Kong record for consecutive wins at 11. The victory was his fourth in a row at Group 1 level and earned his owners a bonus of HK\$2 million for the sweep. Confidently handled by jockey Felix Coetzee, Silent Witness held the rail throughout, but let Able Prince (Aus) (Hurricane Sky {Aus}) set the early pace. He eased by that rival approaching the stretch and was on cruise control from there, winning by a comfortable margin. Cape of Good Hope ran on for second while Electronic Unicorn, first-up off a year's absence, rallied strongly from last to earn third and announce his return. So, with all of the local competition conquered, what's next? "He'll have an early summer. He won't be going to Royal Ascot," owner Archie da Silva said. "We are undecided about the G1 Sprinters' S. in Japan Oct. 3, because there might be no lead-up race for him here. He's a Hong Kong horse and, as you can see, the public love him. He goes for the G1 Prix Lupin [at Longchamp May 16] now before hopefully running in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club [French Derby at Chantilly] June 6." After closing to finish second, Esperanto (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), ridden by the suspension-plagued Jamie Spencer, was demoted to fifth for causing interference to the second and fourth finishers. A Group 2 winner in her native land at three, Spring Star made one U.S. start that season, finishing a very close sixth in the GI Garden City Breeders' Cup H. at Belmont Park. She was sidelined for 8 1/2 months after that effort, then alternated wins and third-place finishes in five tries last year, capturing the Sept. 7 GII Palomar Breeders' Cup H. in her penultimate appearance before filling the show spot in the Dec. 29 GIII Monrovia H. to close out the campaign. Making her first outing of 2004 here, the bay mare gave the starters a hard time before finally entering the gate with the aid of a blindfold, but broke well and shadowed 54-1 Fudge Fatale (Roar) through six furlongs in 1:10.49. The Wertheimer homebred took over in the stretch and powered home a decisive winner in stakes-record time. "She was just incredible," jockey Alex Solis said. "We've always thought she was a nice mare, and now she's putting it together. You just have to get along with her because she has a mind of her own. But obviously all that acting up at the gate didn't take anything out of her." Added trainer Richard Mandella, "She's very hard-headed--got a little mean streak in her. She reminds me of a girl I used to date...then I married her." Dimitrova, the 9-5 favorite in her seasonal debut, stalked the pace, but didn't have an answer when the running began in earnest and settled for fourth.

Grey Lilas captured this trial for the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches, to be contested over course and distance May 16, and provided the all-new Andre Fabre-Gary Stevens axis with their first Group success. The imposing grey filly had handed Hall of Famer Stevens his first score of the French season in a hot conditions event over this track and trip last time out Apr. 4, breaking her maiden in the process. Keen in the early stages while stalking Petit Calva here, she had settled by the halfway marker and was full of run as the favorite Denebola was trapped behind horses under Christophe-Patrice Lemaire. Hitting the front with a flash of the tail 300 yards out, Grey Lilas needed only two slaps with the whip to stretch away from the game long-time leader and Denebola, who was unable to quicken when in the clear inside the final eighth. "It's a huge day and she's a lovely filly," Stevens commented. "I wanted her to settle better than she did early on, but they went very slow and she settled nicely for me eventually. She was well within herself in the last 100 metres and it was like driving a Formula One car--she just won very easily." Dietrich von Boetischer's racing manager Christian de Mowbray said the winner will likely point for the mile Classic, along with stablemate Nyramba (GB). Click for the racingpost.co.uk chart.

Juddmonte Farms' American Post punched his ticket for the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2000 Guineas) when he wired this prep under a confident ride by Christophe Soumillon. Aware that the favorite can race freely when there is not suitable pacesetter, the deputy for the injured Richard Hughes sent his mount to the lead from the gate, where he traveled with ease. Antonius Pius and Jamie Spencer came at him in the final quarter, forcing the Belgian to ask a question, but last year's G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere and G1 Racing Post Trophy winner answered with a telling turn of acceleration that was enough to comfortably hold off Antonius Pius under a hand ride to the line. Antonius Pius, who crossed the wire in second, was disqualified and placed last for interference with chief market rival Diamond Green. American Post, who won the Listed Prix Omnium at Saint-Cloud last time Mar. 31, will now head to the French 2000 Guineas over this course and distance May 16. "It's nice to see him win like that as he quickened really nicely," conditioner Criquette Head-Maarek said, adding, "We will look at the G1 Epsom Derby [June 5] after the Poulains."

Searching for her first victory at the group stakes level, she disputed the early lead under Seamus Heffernan, gained command inside the final quarter and drew clear of Golden Nun, who hung with her challenge in the closing stages. "Like her brother King of Kings she carries her head a bit high, but she's tough and has a high cruising speed," said Heffernan. "She has class and I see her as an Oaks filly."


