THE STAR ATTRACTION

Comeback stories hardly come any more dramatic than the victory of the Duke of Roxburghe's Attraction (GB) (Efisio {GB}) in yesterday's G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket. Sidelined due to injury since July, she had



provided no evidence of the requisite staying power for this Classic. But, after forming the arrowhead of the 16 runners in the centre of the track from the outset, she responded to all of Kevin Darley's questions as she stepped beyond six furlongs for the first time and resolutely Attraction J Herbert/Getty Images maintained the gallop all the way to the line to deny

Godolphin's Sundrop (Jpn) (Sunday Silence) by a half length. "She's an incredible filly," Darley said. "[Trainer Mark Johnston] said make it uncomplicated and let her bowl along. She got to the front, pricked her ears and was just lolling about." 1000 Guineas cont. p2

SMARTY JONES FINE AFTER DERBY WIN

Smarty Jones (Elusive Quality) exited his emphatic win in Saturday's GI Kentucky Derby in fine shape, according to trainer John Servis. "I won't know that much until he goes back to the track," Servis said yesterday. "But I can tell you right now, with the way he came out of the race, I'm tickled to death." Servis plans to ship Smarty Jones back to his home base at Philadelphia Park on Monday or Tuesday and, if all goes well, train there for the May 15 GI Preakness S. "I'm not going to do a whole lot with him, unless he gets to the point where I have to," the trainer explained. "He loves to train and trains hard and, in two weeks time, I don't think there's a lot to be done."

Also likely to start in the Preakness is Derby runnerup Lion Heart (Tale of the Cat). "We'll see in the next few days what we're going to do, but I'll talk with my owners and if the horse is well, we're going to go for the Preakness," confirmed trainer Patrick Biancone. "That's what we're going to aim for and, if the horse is happy and he tells me, 'Yes, boss I can go,' then we'll go." Of Saturday's sloppy conditions, Biancone added, "The Derby this year was on May 1 and we have to take what God gave to us. This is all the beauty of the Derby. The only thing I know is that the 18 horses in the race had the same track and everything was the same for everybody. All the trainers had the same wet shoes, all the owners had the same wet shoes and the women had the same wet hat. We were proud to be there and we take what we have. This year it was raining, next year it could be sunshine. We don't know. My horse was the second best yesterday and we just hope to reverse that result in two weeks."

GII Coolmore Lexington S. winner Quinton's Gold Rush (Wild Rush), eased in the Derby, exited the race in good order. "He came out of the race fine," trainer Steve Asmussen said. "Now he is going to spend some time at the Padua Farm in Ocala, Florida."

Other Derby runners expected to point toward the Preakness are: Limehouse (Grand Slam) (fourth), The Cliff's Edge (Gulch) (fifth) and Borrego (El Prado {Ire}) (10th). Third-place finisher Imperialism (Langfuhr) will likely skip the Preakness for the Belmont, with stablemate Cheiron (Maria's Mon) heading to Baltimore in his stead.

Tried and True

Attraction was never tried beyond six furlongs in five starts at two, but never looked in danger of losing her unbeaten record as she knocked off her major tests in the G3 Queen Mary S. at Royal Ascot in June and the G2 Cherry Hinton S. at the July Course here the following month. Plans to run her in the main events of the fall were thwarted by a pedal bone fracture and an examination that revealed bony changes in her knees. Rested and coaxed back to full training by Mark Johnston, the dark bay entered this contest with more questions to answer than most, but she had the class edge as the clear top-rated of her generation and sex in the International Classifications, and her conditioner was not surprised by the result. "This is fantastic," Johnston commented. "It's beyond belief. I said this morning she was probably the best chance I've ever had in a Guineas. This was the horse with all the form and all she needed to do was stay and she stayed it well. It has been a pretty worrying time, but everything has gone so smoothly and perfectly." Owner-breeder the Duke of Roxburghe added, "We are not a big operation and this is the most exciting thing that could happen to anyone involved in breeding. I've had dreams about this day for the last few months, she's finished everywhere from first to last and this still feels like a dream." Of Attraction's many setbacks, the owner explained, "We were convinced she would never come back, at one stage we were advised that she would never run again, but Mark's vets said she could come back. She went lame in the last week of August and her knees had to be nerve-blocked. There had been quite significant bone changes to the knees and we sent the x-rays to the top vets in Newmarket, who advised that she should be retired but Mark's vet said that we should try and get her back."

Another Day in the Sun

Sundrop, who was purchased for ¥50,000,000 from the 2001 JHRA Select Sale of foals, will be pointed for the G1 Epsom Oaks June 4, according to trainer Saeed bin Suroor. "She ran a big race, but she needs further," he said. "The Oaks will be her target. She needed this race and she will come on a lot for it." Third-place finisher Hathrah is also Oaks bound. "She'll either go to Epsom or for the G1 Prix de Diane Hermes [French Oaks at Chantilly June 13]," trainer John Dunlop said. Turning bad fortune into good, Execute made it third time lucky as he caused an upset in this contest. Second to Aquarelliste (Fr) in this race in 2002 and to Fair Mix last year, the veteran was due to miss the gig this time in favor of last Sunday's G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup at Sha Tin. However, a minor foot abscess ruled him out of that overseas foray and pitched him back into familiar territory. Settled in a stalking fourth by Thierry Gillet as Vespone cut out the fractions under Christophe-Patrice Lemaire, he was in ideal striking position at the top of the stretch. Favored Polish Summer (GB) (Polish Precedent) was reined back by a confident Gary Stevens, but failed to pick up as expected, and it was Execute who delivered the decisive turn of acceleration to lead with 150 yards remaining and score with authority. "This is his race and he always runs well in it," commented Henri Chalhoub's Racing Manager Jean-Pierre Deroubaix. "He deserved this. The soft ground made a difference, as did Vespone, who set a good pace. We were disappointed he didn't make Hong Kong, but these things happen for a reason." Conditioner John Hammond added that the winner would return to this track for the G1 Prix d'Ispahan May 23 if the ground is soft. Elusive Diva, fourth as the even-money choice in her Jan. 24 debut, graduated in her second start Feb. 14 and added a Mar. 10 \$80,000 optional claimer before running fourth in the stretch out to 1 1/16 miles in the Apr. 9 GII Fantasy S. at Oaklawn Park last time out. With blinkers on for this cut back to seven furlongs, the bay filly sat just off the early pacesetters. After waiting for racing room entering the straight, Elusive Diva split foes to take the lead at the sixteenth pole and was all out to hold off the late rush of M.A. Fox for a fastdiminishing neck triumph. "I was a little worried with the addition of blinkers today, if she would get a little too speedy early," admitted trainer Mark Glatt, who was winning his first graded stake at Hollywood Park. "But horses relax great for Pat [Valenzuela] anyway and she really settled behind the speed nicely. As soon as it opened up, there was a hole there and she shot through." As for his filly's possible distance limitations, Glatt said, "I think she will run 1 1/16 miles, I think she just might have not been ready for it against that caliber of horse. The blinkers are going to make a big difference and as she gains more experience, it's going to help a lot. We're going to see how she comes out of the race and play it by ear." It looked as if he had a tough race, but Richard Hills said that he actually gave a buck as he went past the post--he was obviously well pleased with himself."

Wind Misses Out

Juddmonte Farms' **Phantom Wind** (Storm Cat) was forced to skip yesterday's G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket, but may head to the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas) at Longchamp May 16 or the Irish equivalent at The Curragh May 23. The filly was scratched after coming down with a fever, according to conditioner John Gosden. "It's a shame, but that's racing," Gosden said yesterday. "We had been battling against the clock, but now we will prepare for a tilt at either the French or Irish 1000 Guineas."

Fine Tooth Comb for the Cat

Aidan O'Brien will have Saturday's G1 2000 Guineas disappointment **One Cool Cat** (Storm Cat) tested this week to unveil the extent of the problem. The 15-8 pick finished 13th of the 14 runners, but was found to have an irregular heartbeat by the racecourse vet. O'Brien said yesterday, "We will do an ECG [electrocardiogram] on him this week and hopefully by the end of the week we'll know more about what was troubling him. He seems absolutely fine now and his heartbeat seems to be normal again."

DERBY WAGERS REACH A NEW HIGH Total wagering on the 130th Kentucky Derby and the Churchill Downs undercard crushed North American records set in last year's event for total betting on an individual event. A total of \$99,348,706 was wagered on the Derby, up 13 percent from the previous record total of \$87,968,037 established in 2003. Gross betting on the 12-race card rose nearly two percent, to \$142,775,857, from the previous North American record of \$140,379,426 wagered on the 11-race Derby Day program in 2003. Total on-track wagering on the Derby rose to a record \$9,488,539, an increase of nearly four percent from the 2003 record of \$9,135,919. Attendance was down six percent from last year's 148,530, but Saturday's crowd of 140,054 was the largest ever for a Kentucky Derby run over a wet track. The 1994 attendance of 130,594 was the previous rainy high.

DERBY RATINGS BEST SINCE '92 NBC Sports' broadcast of Saturday's Kentucky Derby recorded an 8.3 overnight rating and an 18 share, tying the numbers for NBC's 2001 and 2002 telecasts as the highest rated Derby since 1992. The 8.3/18 represents an eight-percent increase from last year's 7.7/17. Ratings peaked at 11.9/25 from 6-6:30 p.m. ET. The race segment of the telecast produced a 10.1/22--up 13 percent over last year, while the pre-race generated a 6.0/14--11 percent better than the 2003 ratings. Louis-ville (36.9/63) was the top-rated individual market, followed by Cincinnati (16.7/36) and Ft. Myers (13.3/26).


