Plans for Majestic Desert on Hold

Mick Channon has put plans on hold for Jaber Abdullah's Majestic Desert (GB) (Fraam {GB}, who finished ninth in the classic. "Majestic Desert didn't travel as well as she normally does and it was her class which got her as close," he told PA Sport yesterday. "She seems to have come out of it fine and my feeling is that she may need a good break between her races. She is a generous little filly, but this was quite soon after [winning the G3 Fred Darling S. at] Newbury." He also revealed that he was "thrilled" with the performance of the eighth-placed Silca's Gift (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}). Nysaean endured a stop-start campaign after winning this race last season due to the prevalent fast ground. He disappointed when seventh in the G2 Prix Dollar at Longchamp in October but returned in good heart to finish fifth in the G3 Prix Exbury at Saint-Cloud Mar. 6 and fourth in the G2 Prix d'Harcourt at Longchamp Apr. 4. Gradually running himself into form, he followed a fifth in the Listed Magnolia S. at Kempton Apr. 12 with a fine second to Chancellor (Ire) in the G3 Gordon Richards S. at Sandown last time Apr. 24. When Haafhd lined up as one of the favorites for the 2000 Guineas, this Captain Kirk of the horse world was attempting to boldly go where no member of his immediate family had gone in recent years: the winner's enclosure after an English classic.

His half brother Munir had started third favorite for the 2000 Guineas three years ago, but failed to reproduce the form which had seen him easily beat the Guineas third Frenchmans Bay to win the G3 Greenham S. Munir finished sixth. Haafhd's sire Alhaarth had also tackled the 2000 Guineas in 1996, finishing only a modest fourth as the 2-1 favourite. Although Alhaarth's stoutly bred sire Unfuwain was never a candidate for the Guineas, he started second favourite for the 1988 Derby, only to turn in the one disappointing effort of his distinguished career in finishing seventh. I should add though that Unfuwain did sire an English classic winner in Lahan, who took the 1000 Guineas, a race also won by Unfuwain's second dam, Highclere.

Haafhd's dam Al Bahathri was also a classic contender. This wonderfully game front-runner started at 11-1 for the 1985 1000 Guineas, following an unexpected defeat in her trial, but showed her true worth at Newmarket. She flashed across the line in a three-way photo which showed her to be a short head behind Oh So Sharp, who went on to complete the Fillies' Triple Crown. Classic success didn't elude Al Bahathri, as she triumphed in the Irish 1000 Guineas three weeks later.

Haafhd's broodmare sire Blushing Groom would no doubt have won the English 2000 Guineas in 1977, but went instead for the French version, in which he easily recorded his fifth Group 1 success. Of course, Blushing Groom proved to be every bit as exceptional at stud, as witnessed by his whopping total of 92 stakes winners from 512 named foals. One of his finest achievements was to sire Unfuwain's brilliant half brother Nashwan, who became the only horse since Nijinsky II to win both the 2000 Guineas and the Derby. Haafhd's owner-breeder, the astute Hamdan Al Maktoum, has wisely decided that there isn't sufficient stamina in his colt's pedigree to attempt to match Nashwan's feat. *Caulfield cont. p5*

The fact that Unfuwain was a half brother to Nashwan played an important part in his stallion career, which was arguably more productive than Nashwan's. Breeders inevitably sent daughters of Blushing Groom to Unfuwain at the Nunnery Stud in Norfolk and were quickly rewarded. This pairing's first good winner, from Unfuwain's second crop, was the two-year-old group winner Mamlakah. The cross enjoyed further stakes success with Arabride, Ghaali, Shamikh, Elmutabaki and Kind Regards. These six stakes winners came from a total of only 19 foals bred this way--an eye-catching 32 percent--and Unfuwain also sired two stakes winners from mares by Blushing Groom's son Crystal Glitters.


Although daughters of Blushing Groom are now a dwindling breed, a few of them have been sent to Alhaarth in his first early years at Sheikh Hamdan's Derrinstown Stud in Ireland. Haafhd is the best of the four foals bred this way, which also include a Listed-placed filly, and Alhaarth has also sired Arabic Song, a graded-placed stakes winner in the U.S., from a mare by Blushing John.

I am delighted to see Alhaarth doing so well as a stallion, as he retired at only IR7,000 guineas after failing to scale the heights which once seemed likely. Alhaarth's original trainer, the late Dick Hern, was happy to race classically bred horses as two-year-olds and he produced Alhaarth as early as July. Starting favourite for a classy maiden race at Newmarket, Alhaarth won by a neck from the future 2000 Guineas winner Mark of Esteem. Alhaarth was kept quite busy by English standards, having a further four races over seven furlongs and he won them all. His victory over the previous Group 1 winners Danehill Dancer and Tagula in the G1 Dewhurst S. was good enough to earn him the title of Europe's champion two-year-old and the position as winter favorite for the 2000 Guineas and the Derby.

Alhaarth was to finish only fourth in the 2000 and fifth in the Derby and he'd suffered six straight defeats by the time he successfully ended his sophomore campaign in the G2 Prix du Rond-Point over a mile. After being switched to Godolphin, he collected Group 2 successes in Ireland and France in 1997, in the process proving that he stayed a mile and a quarter. The fact that he was rated 13 pounds below the best of his age both at three and four took some of the gloss off his shining juvenile record, hence his comparatively modest opening fee.

So, most of his Stakes winners have been in Germany, France and Italy — including, this weekend, miler **Madresal, Liquido** and sky's-the-limit filly **Quilanga**...

Well, they can only win where they are asked to run.



With his first crop doing well on the track in 2001, Alhaarth stood the 2002 season at the slightly increased fee of \notin 12,000 (IR9,000 guineas). He was then quickly booked full at a fee of \notin 20,000 in 2003 and it was the same story this year, with his fee raised to \notin 25,000. The size of his book has also increased, rising from around 80 mares in his first four years to 115 in 2002, so there is every reason to think that Alhaarth's record is going to get better and better.

Al Bahathri is visiting Alhaarth again this year at the age of 22. She also has a yearling colt from the second crop by King's Best. She has only a handful of surviving daughters, but one of them, the Zafonic filly Almurooj, produced Judhoor, a Listed winner over six furlongs, to Alhaarth. Another daughter, Alyakkh, is represented in the Shadwell stud book by Nafisah, a very useful middle-distance filly inbred 3x5 to that very good broodmare Generals Sister, the fourth dam of Haafhd. One of the best recent American representatives of this very good family was Spanish Fern, the ill-fated Yellow Ribbon S. winner, who was out of Al Bahathri's sister Chain Fern.
