LUCKY SEVEN FOR SMARTY JONES

Kentucky Derby hero **Smarty Jones** (Elusive Quality) will break from post seven and try to keep his undefeated streak alive when he takes on up to 10 rivals in Saturday's GI Preakness S. at Pimlico Race Course.

Smarty Jones, who was made the 8-5 morning-line favorite at yesterday's draw, galloped early Wednesday at Philadelphia Park before being shipped later in the morning to Pimlico. "He's eating good and acting great," said trainer John Servis. "He has been the same happy horse since Arkansas." Derrick Smith and Michael Tabor's **Lion Heart** (Tale of the Cat), second in the Derby, was installed the 3-1 second choice and will break from the rail Saturday. Originally not intended to

start in the Preakness following an 11th-place finish in the Derby, **Song of the Sword** (Unbridled's Song) was made 30-1, the second longest shot on the morning line, and will break from post position five. Song of the Sword, who breezed five furlongs in 1:01 4/5 yesterday at Aqueduct, will be partnered by Jorge Chavez in the Preakness. According to trainer Jennifer Pedersen, the colt is scheduled to arrive at Pimlico Friday afternoon.

Preakness Start Up in the Air for The Cliff's Edge

Robert LaPenta's **The Cliff's Edge** (Gulch), fifth in the Kentucky Derby May 1, is uncertain for Saturday's Preakness S. after the colt was discovered to have a bruise on his right front foot Wednesday morning. Trainer Nick Zito, who entered the colt in the \$1-million event yesterday, indicated that a final decision will be made today whether he will scratch out of the race. After the bruise was discovered, The Cliff's Edge walked the shedrow for 30 minutes, then circled the barn for another 45 minutes with rider Maxine Correa aboard before going to the track for a light jog. "It took him a long time to warm up [Wednesday]," said Zito. "It could be that something is jamming him. He looked all right on the track, but he was walking gingerly when he came back to the barn." According to Zito, the injury may have occurred when the colt lost both front shoes in the Derby.

RAY OF LIGHT

Kieren Fallon took the race to his rivals on strong stayer **North Light (Ire)** (Danehill) in yesterday's G2 Dante S. at York, and that proved a decisive move as the 6-1 chance strode to a half-length success over **Rule of Law** (Kingmambo). Settled in a stalking third on the inside rail throughout the early stages, the powerful galloper was sent to the front inside the final five furlongs before lengthening clear of the chasing pack. Only Rule of Law and Frankie Dettori emerged from the pack to challenge in the closing stages, but North Light had enough in the tank to provide Sir Michael Stoute with his fourth renewal of this trial for the G1 Epsom Derby June 5. Godolphin, who have won three of the last four runnings of this race, rely on **Highest** this time. Purchased after finishing runner-up in the G1 St Leger in September 2002, he has scored only once for his new connections in the Dubai City of Gold S. at Nad al Sheba last March. Subsequently seventh in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic back at that track later in the month, he kicked off his European campaign with a third in the G2 Jockey Club S. at Newmarket in May. After a game second in the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom the following month, he disappointed when fifth in the G2 Hardwicke S. at Royal Ascot in June and has been off the track since. **Millenary** will expose any rustiness here, having performed creditably than the margins suggest when third behind the runaway G3 Sagaro S. scorer Risk Seeker (GB) at Ascot last time Apr. 28. Last year's G1 Ascot Gold Cup winner **Mr Dinos** has to defy a five-pound penalty for that impressive success on his return. He was subsequently a disappointing sixth in the G1 Prix du Cadran at Longchamp in October and may need a sterner test of stamina than this.

Fast and Furious can atone for an unlucky third behind Voix du Nord (Fr) in the G2 Prix Noailles at this track last time Apr. 11. He took too long to emerge from the scrum that day, but had enough speed to get to within a short neck of the runner-up **Cherry Mix**, with **Malevitch** back in sixth. Previously he had looked a live contender for the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) at Chantilly June 6 when beating the subsequent winner Vassilievsky (Ire) in a Saint-Cloud conditions event Mar. 6. **Prospect Park** offers the greatest threat, having made the most of a five-pound advantage over Millemix (Fr) to beat that rival by a head in the Listed Prix de Courcelles here Apr. 4. That form received a boost when the runner-up went on to take the G2 Prix Greffulhe last time. Jean-Claude Rouget, trainer of Fast and Furious, also saddles the unbeaten **Lord du Sud** and he was game when winning a conditions event at Saint-Cloud last time Apr. 9.

"He's got a lovely temperament and he's a very talented, scopy colt," Sir Michael Stoute said of North Light, who had taken a Goodwood maiden on his final start in September. "It was a very solid performance and he's done nothing wrong--he'll go for the Derby, where he has a solid each-way chance. He's a well-balanced, athletic horse." Fallon was equally impressed, "He was a lovely two-year-old last year and was always going to make into a nice staying type. He's got a great attitude and he's always felt like a really nice horse. He's a handy horse so he'll go anywhere and the ground doesn't seem to worry him as he's won on firm and this today." Godolphin's Racing Manager Simon Crisford confirmed that Rule of Law will join Snow Ridge (Ire) at Epsom. "I was really pleased as he was definitely a little short on work. He'll run in the Derby and will definitely get a mile and a half. Snow Ridge is the number one hope from the stable, but this horse is a very able number two."

Godolphin swooped for Crimson Palace after last year's G1 Cape Paddock S. winner had displayed her class when winning a conditions race at Nad al Sheba Jan. 29. She suffered a troubled trip when finishing a 3/4-length fourth in the G1 Dubai Duty Free back at that venue last time Mar. 27, but carried maximum confidence on her European debut here. That proved justified as she traveled easily throughout the early stages before cruising to the heels of Beneventa under a confident Frankie Dettori approaching the quarter pole. Quickening to lead with 300 yards remaining, she was always holding that game rival, who rallied under a strong drive from Seb Sanders in the closing stages. "She would prefer faster ground as she has a tremendous turn of foot when it rides fast," her rider enthused. "She's a star filly with a great future." Crimson Palace will take in the inaugural G2 Windsor Forest S. at Royal Ascot June 16, with her long-term aim being the G1 Beverley D S. at Arlington. IT'Z ALL FULTON AT BARRETTS MAY Stan Fulton's NW Management & Fleetwood accounted for the top two lots at Tuesday's record-breaking Barretts May two-year-olds in training sale at Hinds Pavilion in Pomona, California, including the sale-topping filly, It'z All Mine. By Belong to Me out of the Talinum mare French Lavender, hip 201 was knocked down for \$350,000 from the draft of Becky Thomas' Sequel Bloodstock, which purchased the filly as a Fasig-Tipton July yearling for \$50,000. It'z All Mine breezed the fastest of any filly going two furlongs at the under tack preview, zipping the distance in :21.10 during Saturday's second session. She is from the family of last year's GI Frank J. De Francis winner A Huevo (Cool Joe). Fulton also added hip 248 to his stable, a colt by Crafty Prospector that attracted a final bid of \$275,000. Terry Oliver, agent, consigned the Mar. 1 foal to the sale, who was the only juvenile to work three furlongs during the preview (:33.50). Despite a reduction in the catalogue of 100 horses, records fell as new marks were set in average (\$37,317), median (\$27,000), and gross (\$7,053,000). The buy-back rate of 15.6 percent also was a record low. **Statistics, p2**

Humaita, in her fourth career effort, broke her maiden in a Listed race in her native Germany, and in her fourth start in the States, added another black-type event to her resume. Returning from a seven-month break following her Listed win, she made up a lot of ground after a troubled trip to be fourth in a NW1X over a yielding Gulfstream lawn Feb. 7. A runner-up effort going nine panels at Gulfstream Feb. 29 was improved upon in her next, where she won as the 4-5 pick in an 11-furlong contest at the Hallendale oval Mar. 20. Officials at Newmarket are looking forward to a potentially fascinating renewal of the £250,000 G1 Darley July Cup July 8 after a clutch of international contenders emerged at the first entry stage. Of the 72 sprinters in the list for the six-furlong contest, representatives from Australia, Japan, Hong Kong, the United States, Canada, France and Ireland were included. The European contingent includes Susan Magnier's dual Group 1 scorer **One Cool Cat** (Storm Cat), the Duke of Roxburghe's G1 1000 Guineas scorer **Attraction (GB)** (Efisio {GB}), last year's G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp scorer **Patavellian (Ire)** (Machiavellian) and top sprinting filly **Airwave (GB)** (Air Express {Ire}). "This must be the strongest international entry that a race at Newmarket has ever received and, with a cracking home entry as well, it promises to be a race that befits the Darley July Cup's status as the top sprint race in Europe," commented Newmarket's Clerk of the Course Michael Prosser. "We have clearly benefited from Ascot's drive to attract international sprinters to the Royal Meeting, but the two Japanese have only been entered for Newmarket which I believe highlights the huge international reputation of our race. It wouldn't be a surprise if the likes of Attraction and One Cool Cat were in the final line up against seasoned sprinters like Exceed and Excel, Patavellian and Airwave."
