in the Mar. 6 GI Santa Anita H. at a mile and a quarter. "If he has a knock at all, it's he's a real excitable horse, that's my biggest thing with him," trainer Mike Machowsky told *Daily Racing Form*. "He's not a nervous horse, he's just aggressive." But

can he take his act on the road? While Southern Image will be racing outside Southern California for the first time, **Dynever** (Dynaformer) has shown an affinity for travel. Last year, the fouryear-old handled racetracks as diverse as Gulfstream, Lone Star, Meadowlands, Mountaineer and Santa Anita, winning the Aventura S. and GIII Lone Star Derby, running second in the GIII West Virginia Derby and GII Meadowlands Cup and ending the season with a third in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic.

UNBEATEN LORD DU SUD WINS HOCQUART

Lord du Sud (Fr) (Linamix {Fr}) stepped from the shadow of stable companion Fast And Furious (Fr) (Singspiel {Ire}) to win yesterday's G2 Prix Hocquart at Longchamp. The colt will now carry an unbeaten record into the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) at Chantilly June 6. Rising to prominence after a low-key start in the provinces, Lord du Sud followed a conditions tally at Toulouse Mar. 15 with another at Saint-Cloud Apr. 9. A 5-1 chance in his first stakes try, the grey was settled in a stalking third early and inherited the lead when long-time leader Malevitch (Ire) (Exit to Nowhere) drifted left under pressure at the guarter pole. He had first run on **Prospect Park (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) and held on to beat that rival by 3/4 of a length. "We built up his program slowly to see if he was fit to run against the best," commented conditioner Jean-Claude Rouget. "He won very nicely. We knew there was not much difference between him and Fast and Furious, who unfortunately refused to race in the straight. Lord du Sud has booked his ticket for the Jockey-Club and Fast and Furious may go there in blinkers." Fast and Furious tracked the early pace before tiring down the straight to be last of six. BHB TWEAK TRIPLE CROWN

Peter Savill yesterday unveiled the changes made to the British Horseracing Board's Summer Triple Crown initiative, inaugurated in 2003. Dropping the "Grand Slam" component of the series, the BHB will instead offer the £1-million bonus to horses successful in three of the four legs outlined. They will be made up of Epsom's G1 Coronation Cup and G1 Oaks June 4, G1 Derby June 5, and Royal Ascot's G1 Prince of Wales's S. June 16, constituting the first leg; the G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown July 3 which will form the second leg; Ascot's G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. July 24 as the third; and will end with the G1 Juddmonte International S. at York Aug. 17. The Middle Distance Championship, which operates on a points system and was won last year by Falbrav (Ire), will coexist with the new version of the Summer Triple Crown in 2004 and will offer a prize of £100,000. "The 2003 Summer Triple Crown initiative was a great success, achieving its objectives of encouraging British-trained horses to race in Britain rather than abroad and in assisting the development of a clearer narrative across the British Flat racing season," Savill said yesterday. "We hope that the £1-million prize coupled with the improved format will encourage even more owners and trainers to target the BHB Summer Triple Crown and we are confident that it will further increase racegoing attendance and media coverage. The views of many people have been taken into account, just as we promised, and I am convinced that the BHB Summer Triple Crown series will go from strength to strength."
