The 'real' Philly Phanatic holds fort at Citizens Bank Park, is green and furry and torments unsuspecting baseball fans with his long snoot. Smarty Jones (Elusive Quality) is neither green nor fuzzy, but the



'phanaticism' surrounding the photogenic colt could continue to grow should he cross the line first in this afternoon's 129th running of the GI Preakness S. at Pimlico Race Course. With yesterday's scratch of The Cliff's Edge (Gulch) (see p9), a field of 10 will go postward in the 9 1/2-furlong Smarty Jones Horsephotos event, including four of Smarty

Jones' vanguished foes from the Kentucky Derby, two which tried to run for the roses and three other newcomers to the Triple Crown. But they've all got to answer to the Derby winner, who has a chance to become the sixth horse in the last eight years to go on to the Belmont with a shot at a sweep of the demanding three-race series. Undefeated and never seriously threatened in his seven trips to the post, Smarty Jones has taken the last two weeks very much in stride, playing to sellout audiences on the frontside and the backstretch at Philadelphia Park. However, trainer John Servis is trying to buck tradition. In the previous 128 runnings of the Preakness, never has the winner gone without a published workout in the



fortnight leading up to the race. But it's all moot, according to the conditioner. "The most important thing now is that he's a happy horse," Servis said yesterday, adding this warning. "For anyone to beat him, they will really have to run. While I haven't let him do that much the last two weeks, I have seen enough Lion Heart Horsephotos to know he's ready to roll." Who

better to stop that roll than Derby runner-up **Lion Heart** (Tale of the Cat), who will look to take the race to the favorite from the one hole. "It's the shortest way from point A to point B," trainer Patrick Biancone explained. (cont. p2)

While top handicappers Pleasantly Perfect and Medaglia d'Oro continue to recover from their Dubai exploits, Southern Image (Halo's Image) continued his ascent toward the head of the class with a hard-fought success in yesterday's GI Pimlico Special H. at Old Hilltop. In recording the third Grade I victory of his career, the Florida-bred defeated last year's Preakness runner-up Midway Road (Jade Hunter) by a length and a tail. Preakness winner **Funny Cide** (Distorted Humor) was declared from the race Thursday by trainer Barclay Tagg (see p9). Following his win in the GI Malibu S. Dec. 26, Southern Image took the Sunshine Millions Classic Jan. 24 and made it two consecutive triumphs in million-dollar races with a 1 1/4-length tally in the GI Santa Anita H. Mar. 6. Prompting the pace of Midway Road throughout, Southern Image bid outside that rival turning for home and inched clear late. "That was quite a stretch duel," admitted winning rider Victor Espinoza. Jockey Gary Stevens thinks so highly of the chances of **Rock Hard Ten** (Kris S.) that he has made the trans-Atlantic journey to pilot the imposing dark bay this afternoon. Second, but disqualified to third in the GI Santa Anita Derby, the colt was excluded from the Derby due to a lack of graded-stakes earnings. He has thrived in Baltimore, and connections are looking to this as his proving ground. "He's still learning what racing is all about," said trainer Jason Orman. "And it's time to take another test." **Eddington** (Unbridled), also unable to go in the Derby, has never been off the board in his career and was most recently third in the GI Wood Memorial Apr. 10. Trainer Mark Hennig has tabbed Jerry Bailey to ride the striking chestnut, who carries the gold and purple diamonds of Willmott Stables. After much deliberation, Steve Taub's Kentucky Derby third-place getter Imperialism (Langfuhr) will see if he can turn the tables on Smarty Jones. Well back in the early stages of the Derby, the grey colt stayed on best of all to complete the trifecta. Borrego (El Prado {Ire}), second in the GII Louisiana Derby and the GII Arkansas Derby, reportedly did not handle the sloppy Churchill surface and could do no better than 10th. But the chestnut turned in a best-of-46 half mile May 10 in :46 beneath the Twin Spires and is versatile enough to race close to a slow pace or well off a fast one. Water Cannon (Waquoit) is trained by Linda Albert, who sent out Magic Weisner to a second-place finish behind War Emblem in the 2002 Preakness. The lone gelding in the field, the grey carries a five-race winning skein into this, including the Federico Tesio S. at this track Apr. 17.

winners, Russian Rhythm and Refuse to Bend will meet for the first time. They are in the best hands as far as this contest is concerned, as the former's trainer Sir Michael Stoute has taken five renewals of the Lockinge, and the latter hails from the Godolphin stable, which has been responsible for three of the last six winners. While Refuse to Bend failed to build on his 3/4-length score over Zafeen (Fr) in the colts' Classic at Newmarket in May, Russian Rhythm used her 1 1/2length defeat of Six Perfections (Fr) the following afternoon as a springboard to greater things. After triumphs in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot in June and G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood in August, she chased home Falbrav (Ire) at a respectable two-length distance in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. back at Ascot the following month. She may have been feeling the effects of a long season when subsequently fifth in the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket in October, but she has strong claims of ending a long drought for fillies in this race. Refuse to Bend, whose only subsequent success came in the G3 Desmond S. at Leopardstown in August, needs to improve on his eighth in the G1 Dubai Duty Free at Nad al Sheba last time Mar. 27, but Racing Manager Simon Crisford is hopeful. "Refuse to Bend is working nicely and we are pleased with him," he said. "We think it's the right thing to do to start him over a mile to kick off his European campaign."

Canadian champion Wando capped his Triple Crown campaign with a 1 1/2-length score in the Breeders' S. at a mile and a half on the grass. The chestnut colt faced older horses in his next start and was not disgraced, finishing fourth while beaten just 2 1/4 lengths in the Sept. 14 GI Atto Mile. Put on the shelf after tiring to be third in the Oct. 4 GIII Indiana Derby on the main track, the four-year-old returned in an allowance test on the Keeneland turf and led nearly every step before holding on to take it by 3/4 of a length. Herculated, a winner in four of his six grass starts, was a 13-1 outsider in the Mar. 21 GII Mervin Muniz Jr. Memorial H. at Fair Grounds, but just missed, closing to get second. The four-year-old gelding was freshened after that effort and has been training sharply at Arlington Park. Claimed for \$100,000 after a win at Saratoga last summer, confirmed frontrunner Warleigh came back to win a pair of stakes at Louisiana Downs, then was second by a half-length to Hard Buck (Brz) in his 2003 finale, the Nov. 16 GIII River City H. at Churchill. The six-year-old was second by a neck in his seasonal debut, the Col. E.R. Bradley H. at Fair Grounds Jan. 3, but was given a break after running sixth in the Jan. 31 Fair Grounds Breeders' Cup H. The chestnut made his return in the Apr. 10 J. B. Connally Breeders' Cup H. and led every step, hanging on to take it by a half length. Silver Tree, winner of the Virginia Derby and fourth in the GI Hollywood Derby last season, was sent off the 2-1 chalk in the Muniz, but weakened in the lane and finished eighth. He was given a break after that performance and looks to improve with jockey Jerry Bailey back in the irons.

POST SET TO DELIVER

Juddmonte Farms' American Post (GB) (Bering {GB}) will face only six rivals in tomorrow's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains at Longchamp as he bids to provide Khalid Abdullah with his first renewal of this Classic. Last year's G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere and G1 Racing Post Trophy winner was reported in peak condition by his conditioner Criquette Head-Maarek yesterday. "His preparation has gone very well--no problems so far," she told PA Sport, before dismissing fears that the prevailing soft ground may work against him. "I won't be using the ground as an excuse," she continued. "He doesn't mind the ground. He has run on every ground possible and that would not be an excuse for him. The excuse would be if there is a better horse than him in the race." He will have a rematch with Michael Tabor and Susan Magnier's Antonius Pius (Danzig), one of two Aidan O'Brien-trained runners; and the Lagardere Family's Diamond Green (Fr) (Green Desert), the first French Classic mount of Gary Stevens. They finished second and fourth, respectively, behind American Post in the G3 Prix de Fontainebleau over course and distance last time Apr. 25, before the former was demoted to last place by the stewards. The prospect of a small field and lack of pace is of no concern to Head-Maarek. "He's an easy ride," she said. "You can wait with him if there is enough pace or if there is not enough pace he can lob along. You always have to fear all the horses in a race. You never know what can happen." Richard Hughes will be reunited with the likely favorite after returning from injury.

the injury happened then. We thought this would be his best year because of his Deputy Minister [sire] line." A \$70,000 FTSAUG yearling and a \$145,000 FTFFEB two-year-old, the handsome bay rose to national prominence with an impressive tally in the GII Illinois Derby, but had a rough journey when ninth in the GI Kentucky Derby. Second in the GI Belmont, he went on to post victories in the GI Travers S. and the GII Super Derby, a double completed by his sire when trained by Dollase in 1997. Ten Most Wanted endured a troubled trip when fifth as the favorite in the GII New Orleans H. Feb. 29 before returning to the winner's circle at Hawthorne. Owned by a 10-member syndicate headed by J. Paul Reddam, Ten Most Wanted was produced by a half sister to GI Hollywood Gold Cup hero Cutlass Reality.

THE CLIFF'S EDGE OUT OF PREAKNESS Robert

La Penta's The Cliff's Edge (Gulch) was officially declared from today's Preakness S. by trainer Nick Zito. The dark bay, who registered his most important victory in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. Apr. 10, threw two shoes during his fifth-place finish in the Kentucky Derby. He continued to train up until this past Wednesday, when an abscess was discovered in his right front foot. The abscess popped Thursday afternoon. "After it came out, he was acting more like himself [Thursday] afternoon," Zito commented. "But he wasn't the same way [Friday]. I decided to scratch him as soon as I saw him today. It was an easy decision." Zito, who will be represented in the race by GIII Derby Trial winner Sir Shackleton (Miswaki), said that plans call for The Cliff's Edge to run in the Belmont S. in three weeks "if he gets over this."

MIGLIORE INJURED Jockey Richard Migliore, who is scheduled to partner with **Little Matth Man** (Matty G) in this afternoon's Preakness S., was injured yesterday in a gate incident prior to the fifth race at Belmont Park. The veteran reinsman was aboard Gold Dancer when the filly flipped and threw Migliore. After lying on the ground for a few minutes, the rider was put on a stretcher and was taken by ambulance to North Shore University Hospital. He was complaining of ankle pain. In addition to his Preakness mount, Migliore is also named on Millennium Dragon (GB) in the GII Argent Dixie S., Seattle Fitz (Arg) in the GIII William Donald Schaefer H. and Artie Schiller in the Woodlawn S. Gold Dancer, while scratched from her race, did not appear to be seriously injured.

FUNNY CIDE OUT OF SPECIAL Funny Cide (Distorted Humor), the 2003 Kentucky Derby and Preakness S. winner, was scratched Thursday afternoon from yesterday's GI Pimlico Special H. due to the prevailing hot and humid conditions. "He ran in the heat and humidity in the Haskell last year and that knocked him out for the rest of the year," Jack Knowlton, managing partner of Sackatoga Stable, told *The Blood-Horse*. "Of course I'm disappointed. We've been pointing to this race all spring." The four-year-old chestnut gelding will now be aimed at the GII Massachusetts H. June 19.

Salmonella Outbreak Closes New Bolton:

The George D. Widener Hospital for Large Animals at the University of Pennsylvania's New Bolton Center was closed Monday after an outbreak of a multi-drug resistant strain of Salmonella was discovered. The outbreak has resulted in an undisclosed number of equine fatalities. The bacteria attacks the digestive system and can cause a number of diseases. It is usually spread through contaminated feed or water. The hospital will be closed for six to eight weeks so that the barns and clinic buildings can be decontaminated. It will be reopened after a bio-security program is instituted.

Fee Change for Breeders' Cup Stallions?

The Breeders' Cup could begin basing stallion nomination fees on the size of the stallion's book, *The Blood-Horse* reports. Currently, an owner is charged one year's stud fee in order to maintain Breeders' Cup eligibility, but a committee has reviewed the matter over the past 12 months and has recommended that stallions breeding to 90 mares or less per year be charged one year's stud fee, but that there be a surcharge for each mare over 90. There would be a cap to the fee. "The board of directors approved in principle that there should be a change to the rule to take into account the disparity of book sizes," Breeders' Cup President D.G. Van Clief Jr. told *The Blood-Horse*. A rule change could be made at the Breeders' Cup's June meeting.
