The defection of One Cool Cat (Storm Cat) leaves Aidan O'Brien with the duo of Grand Reward (Storm Cat) and Newton (Ire) (Danehill) in Saturday's G1 Irish 2000 Guineas and promotes His Highness the Aga Khan's Azamour (Ire) (Night Shift) to favoritism. This is the only domestic Classic to have eluded conditioner John Oxx to date, but Azamour, a winner over course and distance in last year's G2 Beresford S., holds strong claims after finishing third in the Newmarket version. "I'm sure if Sinndar or Alamshar had run in it, they would have run well, but we went another way with them," Oxx told Irish Racing Online. "It would be nice to win it and so far I would say this fellow is the best chance I've had. He seemed in quite good shape during his last bit of work and one would hope the race at Newmarket would bring him on." Despite losing One Cool Cat, O'Brien remains optimistic with Grand Reward. "I always thought Grand Reward was a very good colt and he didn't have the best of luck and a few little things went wrong with him last year," O'Brien said. "When he was second in the Tetrarch, we were delighted with him as it was his first run [of the year] and we're hoping he runs a good race." Grey Swallow (Ire) (Daylami {Ire}), fourth behind Azamour at Newmarket, bolsters the domestic defence after what Dermot Weld described as a "satisying" piece of midweek work. "He has progressed since Newmarket as we expected him to," he told the Racing Post. "He does appreciate some ease in the ground, but genuine good ground will be fine for him." Track manager Paul Hensey, who is keeping an "open mind" about watering the straight Guineas course as the dry spell continues, described the ground as "perfect." Brian Meehan will saddle his first runner in an Irish Classic in G3 Tetrarch S. scorer Leitrim House (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}). "He's improving all the time," the conditioner told the Post. "I think he'll take plenty of beating." The Duke of Devonshire's colors will be carried by the James Tollertrained Bachelor Duke (Miswaki), seventh in the Newmarket Classic last time. "He ran such a good race at Newmarket, where I thought the ground and possibly the lack of a race just found him out a bit because he traveled very well," the trainer explained. Field p2

Smart Gesture

Trainer Dermot Weld had been considering the June 5 GI Belmont S. as a target for his charge Relaxed Gesture (Ire) (Indian Ridge {Ire}), but has opted out of a trip to New York in favor of the G1 Derby Italiano May 30, according to Thoroughbred Times. "Smarty Jones is an outstanding horse who is winning all the races and he's a good reason not to go," Weld told the Times. "I have a lot of respect for Smarty Jones, and rather than go all the way across the Atlantic, I'd rather go to Rome for a very prestigious Group 1 worth \$1.2-million [€990,000]. I've won both races, and I think Relaxed Gesture has a better chance right now in the Italian Derby." Weld, who brought over Go and Go (Ire) for a surprise Belmont victory in 1990, ran Relaxed Gesture in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, with the colt finishing eighth. In his most recent outing, the Moyglare Stud homebred finished second to Epsom Derby ante post favorite Yeats (Ire) in the G3 Ballysax S. May 9. "I have confidence in him on turf right now," Weld added. "There is a good chance he will come to America later in the year, but for right now, I think he will stay on turf."

PREAKNESS RATINGS BEST SINCE '90 Smarty Jones' win in last Saturday's Preakness S. generated the best television ratings for the event since Summer Squall's victory in 1990. The total 110-minute broadcast on NBC delivered a national rating of 6.1 and a 15 share, representing a 22-percent increase over the 5.0/13 share in 2003. The Preakness was viewed by an estimated 15 million people, 25 percent more than the 12 million who tuned in to see Funny Cide last year. The rating achieved its peak of 8.6/21 from 6-6:30 p.m. as Smarty Jones cruised to a record 11 1/2-length victory in the second leg of the Triple Crown. An ontrack crowd of 112,668 watched the Preakness card. Wagering finished at \$85.1 million, including nearly \$59 million on the Preakness alone.

POISE DOUBTS FOR OAKS

"Sir Michael [Stoute] wanted to leave her in to have the option, but we've had one or two little hiccups and it hasn't been plain sailing," Managing Director Chris Richardson said yesterday. Godolphin will be represented in the Classic by G1 1000 Guineas runner-up Sundrop (Jpn) (Sunday Silence) and G3 Musidora S. heroine Punctilious (GB) (Danehill). "I am very pleased with both fillies," trainer Saeed bin Suroor said yesterday. "Sundrop worked over a mile this morning with New South Wales and she went extremely well. It is a case of so far, so good, and she will have one more piece of work next week which will put her spot on for Epsom. Punctilious also galloped this morning, going seven furlongs, and we were also very happy with her. We will soon have to sit down and decide which one Frankie [Dettori] rides, and Kerrin [McEvoy] will partner the other one." Of the remainder of the 21 fillies left in at yesterday's stage, Lord Derby's impressive Listed Pretty Polly S. victress Ouija **Board (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) and Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid al Maktoum's 1000 Guineas third Hathrah (Ire) (Linamix {Fr}) are also set to run, with Kieren Fallon booked to partner the former. Conditioner John Dunlop also revealed that Hathrah would line up at Epsom. "Hathrah has done very well since her run in the Guineas and it is definitely the plan to run her in the Oaks," he said. "My only reservation is that she would not want the ground too fast; good would be acceptable, but good to soft would be even better." Aidan O'Brien has left in five fillies headed by Listed Salsabil S. winner All Too Beautiful (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) and Listed Lingfield Oaks Trial S. scorer Baraka (Ire) (Danehill).
