Quickening under minimal encouragement inside the final three furlongs, she gained an edge over that game rival and required just two smacks with the whip to pull a length clear in the closing stages. "I was having second thoughts about saying she was

AN IMPERFECT RETURN

The G1 Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp yesterday was billed as a match between star fillies Six Perfections (Fr) (Celtic Swing {GB}) and Nebraska Tornado (Storm Cat), but outsider Prince Kirk (Fr) (Selkirk) spoiled the party in

this dramatic renewal. Settled in fourth off honest early fractions, the blinkered colt was relegated to last at halfway and surrendered first run to Six Perfections inside the final quarter. He unleashed an impressive display of acceleration that carried him past that rival with 125 yards re-

maining and victory seemed assured until he slipped on the same patch of track that claimed the winning chance of Antonius Pius in last week's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains. A length in front when he lost his footing, he saw his advantage dwindle, but his momentum carried him to the line in front. "He worked well in the blinkers, so we thought we'd try them as he stops a little when in front," commented conditioner Emilio Borromeo, adding, "I'd like to dedicate this success to Dr. Dominic Giniaux [renowned vet/chiropractor who died of a heart attack two weeks ago at 59], who took care of this horse on several occasions." When in Rome...

Prince Kirk offers further evidence of the growing significance of Italian-trained horses on the international scene and of the current high standard of the leading domestic players. That is borne out by the fact that he was so readily subdued by Le Vie dei Colori (GB) when runner-up in the G2 Premio Parioli (Italian 2000 Guineas) at Rome last April and when 10th in the G1 Premio Vittorio di Capua in Milan in October. He fared better in France in the interim, finishing runner-up to Vespone (Ire) in the G1 Prix Jean Prat at Chantilly in June and third in the G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano at Deauville in August, After an easy score in the Listed Premio Andred at Pisa on his return Mar. 28, he finished third behind subsequent G1 Premio Presidente della Repubblica winner Altieri (GB) while attempting to give that rival four pounds in the Listed Premio Ambrosiano in Milan May 2. But he was at his best at Longchamp yesterday. "He needs two races to get him right," said Emilio Borromeo. As for what's next, he remarked, "We may take Prince Kirk to the G1 Eclipse S. [at Sandown July 3] next, but we'll take our time to decide."

Worth the Price of Admission...

Mark Johnston paid the €40,000 supplementary fee on behalf of owner-breeder the Duke of Roxburghe Tuesday, but Attraction had looked an unlikely Guineas contender by virtue of the speed she displayed over five furlongs in the first three runs of her career. After opening her stakes account in the Listed Hilary Needler Trophy last June, she powered to an authoritative success in the G3 Queen Mary S. at Royal Ascot later that month, but showed she could also quicken from behind when taking the G2 Cherry Hinton S. under a penalty at Newmarket in July. Subsequent injuries conspired to keep her off the track until her amazing comeback in the G1 1000 Guineas May 2, but she once again used her speed to good advantage at Newmarket and at The Curragh. "[Jockey Kevin Darley] says she does nothing in front and she just wins these races with an incredible cruising speed," Johnston said. "We have pacemakers who have a job keeping up with her, and yet she is so laid back."

Asked what lies ahead, Johnston remarked, "A mile is probably as far as she wants to go, but we have the option of going back in trip and taking on the older sprinters. I would prefer to keep her at a mile for the G1 Coronation S. [at Royal Ascot June 18], but the Duke is worried about her going round a turn." The G1 Epsom Oaks odds for the runner-up dropped from 25-1 to 10-1 after the race, but trainer Jim Bolger ruled that Classic as unlikely for Alexander Goldrun. "I will sleep on it for a few nights before deciding on plans," he told Racing Post. "I doubt you will see her run a mile again. We might try her over 10 furlongs next time, but we will wait and see." Third-placed Illustrious Miss (Kingmambo), who was also supplemented to the Irish 1000 Guineas, will target the June 18 G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot. Trainer Pat Haslam was pleased by her Classic effort. "She's run a big race in a good Guineas," he told Racing Post. "She just got a bit tired, which was understandable considering it was her first run of the season." Fourth-placed Kinnaird (Ire) (Dr Devious {Ire}) may tackle Epsom.

Menhoubah relished the long Milanese straight and prevalent fast ground to capture this Classic in convincing fashion under Darryll Holland. A model of consistency at two, she rounded off her campaign with a fine third behind Necklace (GB) in the G1 Moyglare Stud S. at The Curragh in August and a fourth-place finish to Red Bloom (GB) in the G1 Fillies' Mile at Ascot the following month. Taken to Nad al Sheba for her spring campaign, she followed a second to Catstar in the UAE 1000 Guineas Feb. 7 with a third placing in the UAE Oaks Mar. 11. Her record of never finishing out of the first four was blemished when taking on the colts last time in the G2 UAE Derby at Nad al Sheba Mar. 27, but she bounced back when runner-up to Hidden Hope (GB) in the Listed Cheshire Oaks at Chester last time May 5. Settled in a stalking fourth off this tepid early pace, she was full of run at the quarter pole, where she accelerated through a gap near the rail. Taking command soon after, she was always holding the challenge of Step Danzer to win a shade cosily. "Today she showed what she has got," conditioner Clive Brittain told PA Sport. "She certainly is very strong and she stays, the two most important qualities in a filly. After this result, we have to consider running her in the G1 Epsom Oaks [June 4]." Powerscourt turned in an awesome display to outclass his opponents in this contest and book his ticket to Royal Ascot. After displaying precocity at two by finishing runner-up to Brian Boru (GB) in the G1 Racing Post Trophy, his sophomore campaign was interrupted by training setbacks and he was playing catch-up by the time he was reintroduced in the G1 Irish Derby at this track in late June. He was not competitive, but also not disgraced in finishing sixth in a strong renewal fought out by Alamshar (Ire) and Dalakhani (Ire). Given a confidence-boosting outing in a 10-furlong Leopardstown conditions event the following month, he subsequently turned the tables on Brian Boru when beating that rival by a neck in the G2 Great Voltigeur S. at York in August. He performed with credit when finding only Vinnie Roe (Ire) and Gamut (Ire) too strong in a vintage renewal of the G1 Irish St Leger at this track the following month, suggesting he could enhance Ballydoyle's new policy of keeping older horses in training. He did so in style here, leading his rivals a merry dance from the outset under Jamie Spencer before powering clear inside the final quarter for an emphatic success. "Jamie gave him a super ride," said winning trainer Aidan O'Brien. "He loved that fast ground and will go to Ascot for the G1 Prince of Wales's S. [June 16]." Remarkably, runner-up Livadiya was running in her second group event in a 24-hour span, having finished second to Soviet Song in Saturday's one-mile G2 Ridgewood Pearl S. Sam-Son homebred Eye of the Sphynx continued to assert herself as the top Canadian-bred filly of her generation with a hard-fought, neck tally in yesterday's featured event at Woodbine. The bay, who has yet to race over a dry track, opened her account with a facile three-length victory in the slop at Keeneland Apr. 22, then successfully handled the ascent into stakes company with a wire-to-wire win in the restricted Fury S. going seven panels over a muddy Woodbine track May 9. The piping hot 1-5 pick in her route bow, she pressed the pace through a quick opening quarter of :22.97 over a tiring track. Putting away fellow pace factor Ontheqt (Mazel Trick) after six furlongs, Eye of the Sphynx locked horns with the running-on Silver Bird, lost the lead to that foe in mid-stretch, but found something left and battled back gamely. "She's a wonderful filly," exclaimed trainer Mark Frostad, who picked up his first Selene crown. "She's had a lot thrown at her in a hurry, but she'll really appreciate the three weeks off before the [June 13, restricted Labatt Woodbine] Oaks." Frostad said that there is an outside possibility that Eye of the Sphynx, following an appearance in the Oaks, could take on the colts in the Queen Plate S., the first leg of Canada's Triple Crown. Meath returned from a Cork maiden success in October to force Grey Swallow (Ire) to work for a head success in the Listed Leopardstown 2000 Guineas Trial Apr. 18. Runner-up at that track last time out in the one-mile Listed Amethyst S. May 9, Meath turned in a strong galloping display in his first try past a mile. Taken to the front in the early stages by Jamie Spencer, he found extra when tackled by Barati to win a shade comfortably as the 4-5 pick. Cairdeas rallied to finish second. INJURED MADCAP ESCAPADE OUT FOR YEAR

Bruce Lunsford's Madcap Escapade (Hennessy), winner of the GI Ashland S. and runner-up in the GI Kentucky Oaks, has suffered a hairline fracture to her hip and will be sidelined for the remainder of the year. The injury, discovered following a nuclear scan at the Hagyard-Davidson-McGee equine clinic, in Lexington, Ky, is not expected to be career-threatening. "The prognosis for recovery is 100 percent, but she's pretty much done racing for the year," said trainer Frank Brothers. The exciting three-year-old made her winning debut at Gulfstream in early January before rattling off three straight stakes wins, culminating with a victory over Oaks heroine Ashado in the Ashland S. at Keeneland Apr. 3. Brothers sensed something was amiss after Madcap Escapades' sharp five-furlong move in :58 3/5 at Churchill last Thursday, her second work since the Apr. 30 Oaks. "It probably started in the Oaks, although you couldn't really detect it" explained Brothers. "She trained well, but she just wasn't 100 percent--it's such a fine line. But we sent her over [Saturday] and thank God we found it."
