**OCTET SET FOR SHEEPSHEAD BAY**

A competitive field of eight turf distaffers has been entered for today's GII Sheepshead Bay H. at Belmont, topped by morning-line favorite **Meridiana (Ger)** (Lomitas {GB}). The chestnut has won three straight, including Gulfstream's GII Orchid H. Mar. 21 and the GIII Bewitch S. a month later at Keeneland in her most recent outing. She outslugged **Alternate** (Seattle Slew) that day, but faces a host of new challengers.

**Spice Island** (Tabasco Cat) posted a three-race winning streak of her own capped by the GII Long Island H. Nov. 15, but clipped heels and fell in the GII La Prevoyante H. at Calder Dec. 27, forcing her to the sidelines. "She was body sore for a couple months and it took her a little while to get back to herself," explained trainer John Pregman Jr. Returning with a sixth in the Orchid, the dark bay then faced males in a Churchill allowance Apr. 29, missing by 3/4 of a length to MGSW Senor Swinger while defeating MGSW Startac. "I wanted to run her in a race for fillies the day before, but it didn't fill," Pregman continued. The California-bred **Moscow Burning** (Moscow Ballet) makes her first New York foray. She had shipped to Florida in March, finishing fifth in the Orchid, before returning home to trump state-breds in the Fran's Valentine S. at Hollywood Apr. 24. "The Orchid was a disappointment," admitted trainer James Cassidy. "We wanted her on the lead and she never got to it. I really want to turn the tables on Meridiana."

**Smarty Sails Through Breeze**

Triple Crown hopeful **Smarty Jones** (Elusive Quality) completed seven furlongs in 1:29 1/5 under a motionless Stewart Elliott yesterday morning at Philadelphia Park. Eager to break off, the chestnut colt was under a tight hold in the early stages, picked up the pace on the turn and wasn't asked for anything more approaching the wire. "I wanted to keep him relaxed," said Elliott. The official splits for the move were :26 3/5, :39 1/5, :51 1/5, 1:03 1/5 and 1:16 1/5; he galloped out a mile in 1:44 2/5.

Trainer John Servis was pleased with the colt's work. "I was very happy with it," he said. "He settled real nice. I didn't want him to gallop out too strong. As far as I'm concerned, we're right on schedule." Smarty Jones came out of the breeze in good order. "He got to playing a little bit toward the end of his cooling-out period," Servis added. "He let out a couple of squeals...I was real happy with where he's at right now." The colt will be shipped to Belmont either Tuesday or Wednesday for his date with destiny. But though Servis is quietly confident, he is aware of the things which can trip up a colt in the Test of Champions. "I don't like handicapping a race until I see post positions," Servis said when asked how he thought the race would shape up. "It's a horse race--there's a whole lot that can go wrong. I can't tell you how many times I've run the best horse and gotten beat. But that's what makes horse racing so exciting. Look at War Emblem stumbling at the start; Funny Cide blew out in :58. So many things can go wrong, but you just try to think about the positive and hope everything goes right."

Lucky Strike emerged on the international scene winning the G3 Prix de la Porte Maillot at Longchamp for his Dutch-based trainer Jan Pubben last June. He subsequently dead-heated for fifth in the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville in August before finishing third in the G2 Goldene Peitsche at this track in September. Transferred to the German base of Andreas Trybuhl afterwards, he returned to take the Listed [www.galopp-sms.de](http://www.galopp-sms.de)-Sprintpreis at Cologne May 2 and was sent off the favorite for this competitive contest. Breaking in his customary sharp style under Adrie de Vries here, he grabbed the lead and despite veering right in the straight had enough in the tank to maintain his advantage.

After kicking off his career with three straight victories including the GIII San Miguel S., the dark bay faltered with added distance, finishing second to Imperialism in the seven-furlong GII San Vicente S. Feb. 7, fifth in the one-mile GII San Rafael S. Mar. 6 and 10th in the WinStar Derby going 1 1/16 miles Mar. 28.

**Post Impresses**

Juddmonte Farms' **American Post (GB)** (Bering {GB}) came through his left-handed gallop at Chantilly with flying colors yesterday, but connections are delaying a decision on his participation in next Saturday's G1 Epsom Derby until Monday. Last year's G1 Prix Jean-Lagardere and G1 Racing Post Trophy winner had looked uneasy over the fast ground when winning the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains at Longchamp last time May 16, but was more at home yesterday on the watered surface, reading 3.5 on the penetrometer. Working the wrong way around the track, the colt started off at the winning post with two stable companions and appeared to have no problems with the downhill part of the track. He quickened up impressively at the end of the 10-furlong gallop and was clear of his companions as he neared the racecourse stables on the back straight. "I was very happy with him and he looks great," commented conditioner Criquette Head-Maarek. "He seems to have recovered from his last race well and handled the downhill bend very nicely. We will make a decision with the owner on Monday." Jockey Richard Hughes, who partnered the colt in the exercise, added, "He went very nicely and gave me a good feel. He was feeling the ground at Longchamp, but was lengthening his stride and stretching out here and I liked the way he did it."

**Hazyview Joins the Party**

Tom Mohan's **Hazyview (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) looks certain to be supplemented to next Saturday's G1 Epsom Derby. Connections will pay the £75,000 fee to add Saturday's Listed Fairway S. winner to the Classic, which may also be bolstered by Gatwick (GB). Eddie Ahern has been booked for the colt, who was beaten 10 lengths by Percussionist in the G3 Lingfield Derby Trial May 8 before his success at Newmarket. "We have had six races this season and it is an unorthodox route to Epsom, but he thrives on his racing and is such a laid-back horse that the big occasion won't worry him at all," trainer Neville Callaghan's son Simon told the *Racing Post*. "We will just keep him ticking over until the race. We wouldn't want it soft, but barring accidents it is the intention to run."

**Out of Action**

Plagued by back problems throughout the spring, champion **Action This Day** (Kris S.) will be turned out for 60 days at owner B. Wayne Hughes' ranch in Malibu, California, according to *Daily Racing Form*. The bay ran sixth in the G1 Kentucky Derby May 1. "He came up sore after the Kentucky Derby," trainer Richard Mandella told *DRF*. The lay-up will force the colt out of consideration for the Breeders' Cup Oct. 30. "I sure don't plan on making that," Mandella continued.

### TOBA COMMITTEE TO STUDY JOCKEY

**ADVERTISING** The Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association has formed a committee to study the usage of jockey advertising during the running of live races. Bill Casner, Cot Campbell, Tracy Farmer, Trudy McCaffery and Debbie Oxley make up the committee. TOBA has also hired attorney Joel Turner, Esq. to advise them on the legal rights of owners regarding jockey advertising. "Thoroughbred owners need a collective voice to address this important issue," said TOBA President Dan Metzger. "Owners make a multi-billion dollar investment into racing each year and we believe that they should be very involved in the process of jockey advertising. We intend to present a plan that benefits the entire sport and creates opportunities for new revenues for its participants."

**Pataki Proposes Major Changes to NY Racing:**

New York Governor George Pataki has proposed a three-point plan to reform New York's racing and gaming laws. The first part of Pataki's plan would be the establishment of a New York State Gaming Commission, which would consolidate the regulatory functions performed by the New York State Racing and Wagering Board, the Capital Investment Fund and various breeders' funds. The second article of the proposed legislation create a New York Racing Association Oversight Board that would monitor NYRA's financial practices during the 3 1/2 years remaining during its franchise. The final part of the Pataki plan would facilitate the implementation of video lottery terminals at Aqueduct. "The sweeping reforms we are proposing will fundamentally restructure and strengthen the regulation of gaming and horse racing in New York State," Governor Pataki said. "By centralizing all of the State's regulatory functions for gaming under one agency and providing for stronger oversight, we will eliminate redundant functions, remove obsolete entities and instill a higher degree of accountability that will promote public confidence in the racing and gaming industry. The people of New York deserve no less." NYRA Chairman Barry Schwartz issued a statement in support of the Governor's proposed legislation. "[It] will facilitate the opening of video gaming entertainment at Aqueduct Race-track, which will generate hundreds of millions of dollars annually for education in New York State," read Schwartz's statement. "It will provide a substantial increase in purses for our horsemen. I hope the necessary legislation will pass swiftly so that NYRA can make a \$140-million investment to open our video gaming facility as soon as possible."

**KY Governor Amends Ban on Texas Horses:**

Kentucky Governor Ernie Fletcher has amended a ban on the importation of Texas livestock into the Bluegrass State following the discovery of vesicular stomatitis (VS) in Texas. A 1998 law banned livestock coming into Kentucky from states affected by VS. Three horses on a remote Texas ranch were discovered to have clinical signs of the disease last week, but no further cases have been reported since, even among additional animals on the same ranch. Fletcher's amendment allows for livestock to travel to Kentucky from Texas, provided they are not from any of the 60 western Texas counties surrounding the infected ranch. The news comes as relief for Lone Star Park, which is scheduled to contest several graded stakes on Memorial Day. "This is extremely positive news," said the track's Vice President and General Manager Jeff Greco. "We're hopeful that we might be able to add a runner or two to our races."

**Cooksey Gets Her Picture Taken:**

Jockey Patricia Cooksey, sidelined nearly a year after breaking both legs in a horrific spill at Keeneland, earned the first victory of her comeback when she successfully piloted Donner Pass in Thursday's third race at Churchill. It was the 2,137th career win for Cooksey. "Ooh, that felt good," said the 46-year-old rider, who also successfully battled breast cancer in 2001-02. Many questioned whether Cooksey would return to race riding, but the jockey was determined to win again. "I didn't want to go out that way and let that be my last mount [at Keeneland], but believe me--I'll be honest--it's been tough," she said. "In order to get through that fear--I'll say the word, that fear--you have to ride a lot of races." She had considered retirement upon getting one in the win column, but those plans are on hold for now. "Hopefully we can finish the meet," she said. "I knew this was going to happen. You win one and you're going to feel like, 'well, maybe one more.' But I'll ride at least to the end of the meet." Cooksey has postponed surgery, scheduled for June 8, to remove a rod placed in her left leg following the spill. "If I get it done June 8, then you're done for the rest of the meet," she said. "This is where you want to ride, right here at Churchill."
