

TEN LEFT IN OAKS

Godolphin's G1 1000 Guineas runner-up Sundrop (Jpn) (Sunday Silence) and G3 Musidora S. heroine Punctilious (GB) (Danehill) head a declared field of 10 fillies in Friday's G1 Vodafone Oaks at Epsom. As expected, Cheveley Park Stud's Poise (Ire) (Rainbow Quest), Newsells Park Stud's Kinnaird (Ire) (Dr Devious {Ire}) and Mrs. Niall O'Callaghan's Alexander Goldrun (Ire) (Gold Away {Ire}) were scratched from the Classic at yesterday's five-day stage. Aidan O'Brien has left in four fillies, including Listed Salsabil S. winner All Too Beautiful (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), G1 Moyglare Stud S. winner Necklace (GB) (Darshaan {GB}) and G3 Lingfield Oaks Trial victress Baraka (Ire) (Danehill). The conditioner has warned that the latter may be switched to the G1 Prix de Diane Hermes at Chantilly June 13 if the forecast rain fails to materialise. Others bringing Classic form into the race are Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid al Maktoum's 1000 Guineas third Hathrah (Ire) (Linamix {Fr}) and Saeed Manana's G1 Oaks d'Italia winner Menhoubah (Dixieland Band, while Lord Derby's Ouija Board (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}) will be stepping up in trip after winning the Listed Pretty Polly S. at Newmarket May 2.

STRIKERS WILL SUPPORT CLASSICS

Striking stalls handlers will work during next weekend's Epsom Derby meeting, but look likely to target Royal Ascot next month. Officials at the Surrey track were handed the reprieve after the Transport & General Workers' Union confirmed that stalls will be in operation for the two Classics, despite the plan to target one race at every flat meeting from Friday. Connections of Tahreeb have taken an experimental approach while looking for his ideal distance, campaigning him from five to 10 furlongs, but he seems to have found his metier at a mile now. He showed natural speed to finish third in the six-furlong G2 Mill Reef S. at Newbury last September and was far from disgraced when fourth in the G3 Cornwallis S. over Ascot's five furlongs in early October. After finishing last of four in the G1 Racing Post Trophy later in the month, he returned to finish fourth in the Listed European Free H. over seven furlongs at Newmarket Apr. 14.
