Groom Tesse delivered a strong late run to overwhelm Dayano for a popular local success. Held up towards the rear by Dario Vargiu off moderate early fractions, the grey was in the slipstream of Dayano as that one battled past Privy Seal at the quarter pole. Reeling in his rival with every stride, the 10-1 Groom Tesse hit the front with 200 yards remaining before lengthening clear. The winner had looked far from a Classic contender when eighth in the Listed Premio Rumon at this track in October, but bounced back from that disappointing effort to beat Vol de Nuit (GB) in the G3 Premio Guido Berardelli later that month. After returning to this track to take a conditions event Apr. 11, he found Distant Way (Distant View) too strong when runner-up in the Listed Premio Botticelli May 9, but rebounded to give the Camici family their first Derby success in their 27th try. "It's the biggest day of my life," commented Fabrizio Camici. "I was hopeful of his chance because he needs fast ground and the blinkers to show his best. I think this horse still has a lot of improvement left in him, but we have no plans for the future. The only entry he has is for the G1 Gran Premio di Milano [in Milan June 20]. We'll have to sit with the owners and make some decisions, but at the moment its just a great fiesta and lets enjoy it." You give him a little breather and then he comes again. This was very satisfying. He hasn't won a race in a year and a half." Dedication, a Group 1 winner against the boys in France last fall, was coming off a win in the May 1 GIII Beaugay H. The gray mare was bumped at the start and on the backstretch, but battled gamely down the lane to come up just a half-length short. "She ran a good race," said Christophe Clement, trainer of the beaten favorite. "She finished very strong. We just got a little unlucky at the end. This is a good prep for the [June 5 GII] Just a Game."

Mr Dinos looked a certain future staying champion when winning the G1 Prix Royal-Oak (French St Leger) at Longchamp in 2002. Papineau has been supplemented after an impressive conditions score at Goodwood May 19, but needs to prove his stamina over an extra half mile in this contest.

The colt went in company with maiden winner With Probability. Jockey Jerry Bailey was aboard for the move. "Everything is well," trainer Mark Hennig said. "I put him in company today and wanted to see if the quicker work woke him up. I put blinkers back on him becase that's what he's going to have on race day." Added Bailey, "He breezed very well. He was real sharp. I just hope he runs with that much focus on Belmont Day. He disappointed me in the Preakness because he completely lost his focus for a large portion of the race. I've said it before--he's like a big dumb kid. All the tools are there, he just hasn't put it all together."

Two on the Fence

The connections of GII Peter Pan S. winner Purge (Pulpit) and third-place finisher Master David (Grand Slam) are considering a run in the Belmont. "I'm probably going to work him Monday and make a decision after that," trainer Todd Pletcher said of Purge. "There is a chance. There's probably a better chance now than there was a week ago." Master David's trainer Bobby Frankel said Saturday, "I might enter, but that's about it. Something more than [the defection of Tapit] has to happen [for the colt to run]." The colt worked yesterday, going six furlongs in a bullet 1:13 at Belmont.

Originally slated to contest the GI Stephen Foster H. at Churchill the same afternoon, Howard opted to send the colt northward in an effort to avoid divisional leader Southern Image, winner of the GI Santa Anita H. and GI Pimlico Special. "We're going on the premise that if Southern Image is coming here [Churchill], that horse is doing good," said Howard. "Our horse raced so hard the other day up at Pimlico [second in the Pimlico Special, May 16], although he came out of the race well, that we were concerned about subjecting him to that kind of race and stress again." Midway Road will have his final breeze at Churchill Downs Saturday before heading to New York on the following afternoon.

CHURCHILL FORCED TO CANCEL SUNDAY

Churchill Downs was forced to cancel the remainder of card because of dangerous weather conditions in the Louisville Metropolitan area Sunday. Hit by severe thunderstorms earlier in the day, Churchill officials decided to abandon the card after the fourth race because of renewed tornado warnings. "The health and safety of our patrons and the participants in our races is always our primary concern and the decision to end our racing program after four races was without question the proper call," said Churchill Downs President Steve Sexton. The GIII Dogwood Breeders' Cup S., originally slated for Sunday's card, will likely be rescheduled for next weekend.


