in front of the camera yesterday after driving to a 3/4-length score over Bowman's Band (Dixieland Band) in the GI Met Mile at Belmont Park. "He's a special horse," jockey Alex Solis said. After stumbling at the start of the Met, the Brazilian-bred moved up to chase the pace as 2-1 chalk Strong Hope (Grand Slam) took them along through a half in :46 and six furlongs in 1:10.04. It looked as if Adam Coglianese photo the crowd's choice might take them gate to wire, but Pico Central closed

with determination to take over inside the final furlong and held on for his second straight Grade I score. "I think this is the toughest race of the year so far," trainer Paulo Lobo said. Off the board in three straight before improving to be second in the May 1 GIII Inglewood H., Designed for Luck (Rahy) got back on track with a 1 1/2-length score in the GI Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile at Hollywood Park yesterday afternoon. It was the first Grade I success for the seven-year-old, who crossed the finish line first as a 58-1 shot in the 2000 GI Hollywood Derby, but was disqualified and placed fifth. Trainer Vladimir Cerin, who claimed the chestnut gelding for \$62,500 from his second career start, said, "He's just a brilliant horse. When we got to the eighth pole and I asked him, he got down and started running." As for what's next, Paulo Lobo said, "I don't have anything planned. I'm going to return to California and he's coming back there on Wednesday. We'll see how he comes out of the race and make some decisions." As for the odds-on Megahertz, her woes continued without regular rider Alex Solis, who piloted Met Mile hero Pico Central (Brz). Victor Espinoza had subbed for Solis in the GII Santa Ana H. Mar. 27, when the chestnut was disqualified for interference, and was back on board yesterday. "Into the first turn, I had to touch her shoulder a couple of times because she was getting a little bit too far back," said Espinoza. "But she just wouldn't go."

If I were to ask readers to name the 20 most outstanding stallions of the last 50 years, I'm sure that the leading candidates would include the likes of Mr Prospector, Northern Dancer, Sadler's Wells, Nijinsky II, Nureyev, Danzig, Bold Ruler, Blushing Groom, Storm Cat, Sunday Silence, Hail To Reason, Danehill and Seattle Slew. But would any of you spare a thought for one of my own favorites, Kalamoun?

As "Kala who?" would probably be the general response to this suggestion in the U.S., I will plead Kalamoun's case as one of the largely unsung heroes of European breeding.

Bred in 1970 by the Aga Khan, Kalamoun had a pedigree true to the traditions of the Aga Khan's own family. The colt's sire, Zeddaan, had won the French 2000 Guineas and the third generation of the colt's pedigree included two major winners bred and owned by the Aga's grandfather, namely the tempestuous Nasrullah and the 1950 2000 Guineas winner Palestine. Perhaps more to the point, the third generation also included Rivaz, a highly talented full-sister to Nasrullah, which meant that Kalamoun was inbred 4x4 to Nearco and to Mumtaz Begum.

Mumtaz Begum was herself a daughter of Mumtaz Mahal, the so-called "Flying Filly" who was by The Tetrarch, whose coloring and achievements combined to earn him the nickname of "The Spotted Wonder."

The Tetrarch, who was unbeaten in seven starts, was so extraordinary that he was described by his trainer Atty Persse as a freak, with Persse adding that "there will never be another like him."

In addition to having two lines of The Tetrarch through Mumtaz Mahal in the sixth generation of his pedigree, Kalamoun had two more lines through The Tetrarch's 2000 Guineas-winning son Tetratema. Although Kalamoun wasn't quite the superstar that The Tetrarch had been back in 1913, he possessed a sizeable measure of his ancestor's talents, as he showed with decisive victories in the French 2000 Guineas, Prix Lupin and Prix Jacques le Marois in 1973.

There proved to be parallels--some very good, others much less so--between Kalamoun and The Tetrarch when Kalamoun retired to his owner's Ballymany Stud. The Tetrarch had sired only 130 foals, partly because of a lack of libido which prompted his owner to describe his attitude as "monastic in the extreme." He later became sterile, but not before siring Mumtaz Mahal, Tetratema and three winners of the St Leger.

It soon became apparent that Kalamoun's fertility was also less than ideal, although there were no problems with his libido. His death, as a result of colic and a twisted gut, in March 1979 meant that he had spent only five years at stud and these five years yielded only 123 foals. However, Kalamoun sired 21 stakes winners (17 percent) and he had an astonishing record with his 50 sons. No fewer than ten of these 50 sons (20 percent) became Group winners, with five of them--Bikala, Kalaglow, Kenmare, Persepolis and Shakapour--winning at G1 level. Some of these were to prove fairly disastrous as stallions but Kenmare twice became champion sire in France and another of Kalamoun's Group winners, Kampala, sired Tony Bin, who has made an indelible mark in Japan.

Kenmare's son Highest Honor, who has also been champion sire in France, is another with a very interesting pedigree. He is inbred 5x5x4x4 to Nasrullah, 6x6x6x5x6x5 to Nearco and 6x6x6x5x7x5 to Mumtaz Begum, with some of these lines coming through Nasrullah, his sister Rivaz and their three-parts-brother Royal Charger.

You can therefore imagine the considerable build-up of these bloodlines which was created when Shakapour's daughter Vigorine was sent to Highest Honor--a mating which created 3x3 inbreeding to Kalamoun. Incidentally, these numerous lines to Nasrullah's parents were balanced by several lines to Prince Rose, through his sons Prince Bio, Princequillo and Prince Chevalier.

Highest Honor's mating with Vigorine worked quite well, the resultant foal being Vicomtesse Mag, This filly was a little unlucky not to enjoy stakes success over a mile and a quarter, being beaten only half a length in the Prix de Liancourt and a short neck in the Prix Suave Dancer-Charles Laffitte. In view of these respectable efforts and her close inbreeding to Kalamoun, she was very well bought for only 14,000 guineas by Conti Bloodstock at Tattersalls' 1997 Sales.

Now the latent power of Vicomtesse Mag's bloodlines has helped her produce a classic winner in the shape of her Derby Italiano-winning son Groom Tesse, by Groom Dancer.

Groom Tesse is the latest example of the affinity which exists between Highest Honor and Blushing Groom (another member of the Nasrullah male line). Highest Honor's matings with mares by sons of Blushing Groom have produced the Group 1 winners Dedication (out of a Sillery mare), Marotta (out of a Rainbow Quest mare) and Reve d'Oscar (out of a Baillamont mare). He has also sired the Group 3 winner Honorifique from a Groom Dancer mare.

Groom Tesse is the latest in a lengthy line of good winners sired by the 20-year-old Groom Dancer during a career which has seen him stand in France, Japan, Australia, New Zealand and Britain, where he commands a fee of £7,000 at Cheveley Park Stud. One of his New Zealand-bred foals, Lady Annaliese, won the La Zanzara H. at Santa Anita earlier this year and another daughter, the very good French filly Maiden Tower, was beaten only a nose in the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup last October.

However, Groom Tesse is only the third Group 1 winner by Groom Dancer, following Lord of Men and Le Balafre, and it could well be that his greatest value, in the long term, is going to be as a sire of broodmares. Three of his daughters have already produced G1 winners and his son Pursuit of Love has also made a bright start as a sire of broodmares, with the dual 1000 Guineas winner Attraction and the unlucky Antonius Pius leading the way.

"We will decide later in the week," he told Irish Racing online.
