SMARTY DRAWS THE NINE HOLE

Shortly before he arrived via police escort to Belmont Park yesterday morning, **Smarty Jones** (Elusive Quality) drew the outside nine post position for his quest to

become racing's 12th Triple Crown winner in Saturday's GI Belmont S. "I am happy with the post," trainer John Servis said. "We could sit outside of horses and he doesn't have to worry about what is going on outside of him. He just has to worry about what is going on inside of him. He will be able to secure a

position going into the first turn." The undefeated colt was installed as the 2-5 morning-line favorite with his regular rider Stewart Elliott aboard. Servis thinks that Rock Hard Ten (Kris S.) (post five) and Purge (Pulpit) (post two) have the best chance of pulling off the upset. "I think Purge and Rock Hard Ten are among the best three-year-olds in the country," Servis added. "We beat Purge twice and both times he was in front. I think going into this race that not only are they the toughest horses in the race, but any time this year I think those are going to be the toughest horses we run against." The Todd Pletcher-trained Purge finished second, beaten 3 1/4-lengths to Smarty Jones in the Rebel S. Mar. 20, then faded to finish fifth behind the handsome chestnut in the GII Arkansas Derby Apr. 10. He was last seen notching the GII Peter Pan S. by 6 3/4 lengths May 22. GI Wood Memorial runner-up Master David (Grand Slam) was on the fence for the Belmont until jockey Jose Santos and trainer Allen Jerkens convinced trainer Bobby Frankel to run. "The thing that keeps on coming back on mine and a lot of other people's mind is Spectacular Bid," Frankel said. "He looked like a cinch and he lost." With a win on Saturday, Smarty Jones would become North American's richest horse, passing Cigar's \$9,999,815 all-time earnings. With earnings of \$7.4 million already, he would add a \$5-million bonus from Visa for sweeping the Triple Crown and \$600,000 first prize for the Belmont. Post time for the Test of a Champion is 6:38 p.m EDT.

Gators N Bears (G3), from the first crop of Stormy Atlantic, wins his second Graded Stakes Race. Twice as Bad and Icy Atlantic, from the second crop of Stormy Atlantic, become two new Graded Stakes winners by winning the Lazaro Barrera Memorial Stakes (G2) and the Jersey Derby (G3) respectively.



STREAMLINED SEVEN IN OAKS

A field of seven fillies will go postward for tomorrow's G1 Vodafone Oaks at Epsom headed by Godolphin's duo of Punctilious (GB) (Danehill) and Sundrop (Jpn) (Sunday Silence), which is the smallest since User Friendly (GB) beat six rivals in the 1992 version. Frankie Dettori ended days of speculation by chosing the G3 Musidora S. scorer Punctilious over G1 1000 Guineas runner-up Sundrop, who will be the first Epsom Classic ride for Kerrin McEvoy. Lord Derby's Listed Pretty Polly S. winner Ouija Board (GB) (Cape Cross (Ire)) was the subject of an upbeat bulletin from her conditioner Ed Dunlop yesterday. "I'm delighted with her," he said yesterday. "She has been working well and has come through her preparations in as good a condition as I can get her." Out of a sister to the 1985 Arlington Million winner Teleprompter (GB), the best horse to have raced in Lord Derby's uncle's black and white colors, there are doubts as to whether she will see out the 1 1/2-miles trip, but Dunlop is hopeful she will stay. "Last year we thought she would be a staying filly, but the pedigree experts have put doubts in my mind," he said. "She has a fantastic temperament which will go a long way, and when Kieren [Fallon] rode her at the back-end of last week, he said she had got even more settled. I'm delighted to see two Cape Crosses in the Derby as it means I'm not the only one who thinks they stay." Ouija Board is the sole horse in training for Lord Derby, whose family is steeped in the tradition of the Epsom Classics. "The family have a large connection with the Derby and Oaks and that was the swaying factor to run," Dunlop continued. Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid al Maktoum's Hathrah (Ire) (Linamix (Fr)), Saeed Manana's Menhoubah (Dixieland Band) and Diane Nagle and Susan Magnier's Baraka (Ire) (Danehill) were scratched yesterday. Menhoubah and Baraka will head to Chantilly for the G1 Prix de Diane Hermes June 13, while Hathrah may join that duo or wait for Royal Ascot's G2 Ribblesdale S. June 17 after Sheikh Hamdan's Racing Manager Angus Gold explained that she needed "a little more time."

Yeats Says Nay to Derby

Longtime ante-post Epsom Derby favorite Yeats (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) has been officially ruled out of Saturday's Classic after the colt's muscle problem failed to improve. "As I have said before, if Yeats was not right for Epsom, he wouldn't run," trainer Aidan O'Brien said in a statement. "We looked at him [Wednesday] morning and his muscle problem has not improved sufficiently, so we think it is in the best interest of the horse not to run in the Derby. We plan to give him a complete rest." Unbeaten in three career starts, Yeats started the season with victories in the G3 Ballysax S. and the G2 Derrinstown Derby Trials S. May 9, the same route followed by O'Brien's previous Derby heroes Galileo (Ire) and High Chaparral (Ire). But he came up with a "tweaked muscle" last week and, despite constant physiotherapy, has not recovered in time. "It is bitterly disappointing for everyone here at Ballydoyle as Yeats has always worked like a champion," O'Brien added. "He is a very similar horse to Galileo, and I've tried to take the Galileo route with him to Epsom."

Marbye finished third behind Bright Sky (Ire) and Six Perfections (Fr) in last August's G2 Prix d'Astarte at Deauville and transferred that form to Italy later in the campaign. In three San Siro mile starts, she was successful in the Listed Premio Pietro Bessero in September before finishing fourth in the G1 Premio Vittorio di Capua in October and then took the G3 Premio Sergio Cumani a week later. Last year's campaign was concluded with a half length third-place finish behind Duca d'Atri (Ire) in the G2 Premio Ribot at Rome in November and she returned to action this year with a comfortable win in a Rome conditions event Mar. 21. She was a shade disappointing most recently when only fourth, in testing conditions, in the G3 Premio Carlo Chiesa back at the same Capanelle venue May 1, but returned to winning ways here with an impressive display, under an inspired Mirco Demuro ride, to easily dispose of Honey Bunny and the German-trained challenger Lindholm. Demuro sent Marbye to the lead from the outset and the partnership was afforded a soft lead by sleeping rivals before increasing the tempo after halfway. Marbye kicked further clear of her opponents at the quarter-mile marker and responded to Demuro's urgings in the closing stages to win comfortably. 

And though there are no more offspring of Sunday Silence--who sired the saletopper in each of the last six years--the catalogue does boast a strong international group of sires, including Brian's Time, Dehere, Forestry, Forty Niner, French Deputy, Fusaichi Pegasus, Gone West, King's Best, Point Given, Rahy, Seeking the

Gold, Singspiel (Ire), Theatrical (Ire) and War Chant. Young Japanese champions Grass Wonder, Jungle Pocket (Jpn) and Kurofune, as well as Arc hero Marienbard (Ire), also have youngsters catalogued. Among the foals scheduled to sell this year are Hip 10, a King's Best filly out of the regally bred French Group 3 winner Allurement (Ire); and Hip 68, a Dance in the Dark (Jpn) colt out of Japanese Horse of the Year Air Groove (Jpn). Recent graduates of the sale who have achieved success on the international stage include Sundrop (Jpn), a ¥50,000,000 purchase in 2001 who was the runner-up in last month's G1 1000 Guineas and will be among the favorites in Friday's G1 Oaks S. Another promising graduate is Wuthering Heights (Jpn), who sold for ¥81,000,000 in 2002. The colt recently broke his maiden in Ireland and was subsequently purchased by American interests. He stood at Shadai Stallion Station from 1984 through 2000 and sired Japan's champion threeyear-old filly of 1989 Shadai Kagura (Jpn), as well as 1992 Kikuka Sho (Japanese St. Leger) winner Rice Shower (Jpn) and Japanese stakes winners Stage Champ (Jpn), Hagino Real King (Jpn), Monsieur Siecle (Jpn) and Sunrise Jaeger (Jpn). Real Shadai is the broodmare sire of this year's Tenno Sho Spring S. winner Ingrandire (Jpn) (White Muzzle). Out of Marilyn Momoko (Jpn), the five-year-old is expected to start next in the June 17 G1 Gold Cup at Royal Ascot. Real Shadai was pensioned in 2001 and lived out his retirement at the Stallion Station.
