ROAD TO PEACE

While **Southern Image** (Halo's Image) merits favoritism in today's GI Stephen Foster H. at Churchill Downs based on his five-race winning streak, the road to victory will be anything but easy with the likes of **Midway Road** (Jade Hunter), **Peace Rules** (Jules) and defending champ **Perfect Drift** (Dynaformer) lurking in the shadows. Bobby Frankel's MGISW Peace Rules met up with Southern Image in the Jan. 24 Sunshine Millions Classic and was a bit too dovish in that one, running a listless fourth as the even-money chalk.

Subsequent wins in the Feb. 29 GII New Orelans H. and Apr. 3 GII Oaklawn H., however, proved the chestnut hadn't lost any of the fire in his belly, and a blistering best-of-83, four-furlong work at Belmont Monday in :45 2/5 says he's ready off the two-month break. For the second year in a row, Perfect Drift will be gunning for the upset. The five-year-old gelding reeled in 3-5 chalk and eventual Horse of the Year Mineshaft to take last year's renewal by a head, but has yet to get his picture taken in two starts this year. The bay was eighth in his seasonal debut, the GII Maker's Mark Mile over Keeneland's lawn in mid-April, then switched to the dirt and could do no better than second to Congrats in the Apr. 30 Alysheba S., a race run over a sloppy Churchill oval. "He's a little stronger and a little better [than last year]," said Johnson. "Right now, I think we're in good shape."

NOW OR NEVER

Dynever (Dynaformer) will be looking to regain some luster when he faces six rivals in the GII Brooklyn H. at Belmont this afternoon. The dark bay concluded a successful three-year-old campaign with a solid third to Pleasantly Perfect and Medaglia d'Oro in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic in October, and kicked off 2004 with a devastating turn of foot in winning the GIII San Bernardino H. Apr. 3. But he failed to fire as the favorite in the GI Pimlico Special H. May 14 at Pimlico,

fading to fifth behind Souther Image, a loss which trainer Christophe Clement attributes to the colt's tender feet. "He was awfully sore from his feet and he was just way off his best form in the Pimlico Special," said Clement, who has breezed the four-year-old twice on the turf since that outing. "He has trained very well over the last few weeks. He went well on the dirt the other day [half in :48 2/5]. He looks good. Let's go." Another four-year-old, **Congrats** (A.P. Indy), will be looking to make a name for himself. Third in the GII Jim Dandy S. last August, the bay is unbeaten in two starts this year, winning a Keeneland allowance Apr. 3 before defeating Perfect Drift in Churchill's Alysheba S. Apr. 30. "It's time for him to step up and see how he does on the big stage," said trainer Shug McGaughey. "It took him a while to get it together [last year]."

DEEP FIELD FOR DIANE

With 18 fillies set to go post for tomorrow's G1 Prix de Diane Hermes at Chantilly, the Classic has attracted the largest field since Highclere (GB) beat 21 rivals in 1974. Kieren Fallon has been booked to ride the Wildenstein Family's **Asti (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), who finished runner-up to the unbeaten **Latice (Ire)** (Inchior {GB}) in the G3 Prix Vanteaux at Longchamp May 2 and to **Ask for the Moon (Fr)** (Dr Fong) in the G1 Prix Saint-Alary back at that venue last time May 23. While she is drawn favorably in stall three, her conquerors will have to race from outside posts. Ask for the Moon will exit from the 17 hole, with only Latice drawn wider. The G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches winner **Torrestrella (Ire)** (Orpen), who has been purchased by Peter Karches and has her final start for Francois Rohaut here, will exit from the 12 hole, with Pouliches runner-up **Grey Lilas (Ire)** (Danehill) drawn in 14.

Musical Chimes, winner of the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches and third in the G1 Prix de Diane last season, takes on the boys as she bids for her first U.S. victory. The four-year-old made her American debut in the GI Yellow Ribbon S. last September and just missed, finishing second by 3/4 of a length to Tates Creek. She beat only one under the wire in the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf, but bounced back to be a neck runner-up behind Heat Haze (GB) in the Nov. 30 GI Matriarch S. On the sidelines for six months after that effort, she made her first start against colts in her return, a one-mile allowance test on the Hollywood grass May 30, and closed well to run second. **Vangelis** took the Apr. 4 G2 Prix d'Harcourt in his penultimate European start. The five-year-old capped his French campaign with a seventh in the May 2 G1 Prix Ganay, but owner and bloodstock agent Hubert Guy, who purchased the gray in January, blamed the subpar performance on the course condition. "He hates soft turf," Guy said. **Continuously** came up a nose short in the Nov. 22 GI Hollywood Turf Cup, but was promoted to first when Epicentre was disqualified and placed third. He came back to be second in the Dec. 27 GII W.L. McKnight H. at Calder and was most recently runner-up again when beaten a neck in the Feb. 16 GII San Luis Obispo H.

A 40-1 outsider in winning the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff last October, the bay added a victory in the GI Santa Margarita H. at Santa Anita Mar. 14 and was runner-up in the GI Vanity H. at Hollywood May 9, her most recent effort. Carl Nafzger's **Mayo on the Side** knows something about upsets herself. The five-year-old collected her initial Grade I tally by denying 2002 Horse of the Year Azeri by a head in the seven-furlong Humana Distaff on the Derby undercard.

The Buckeye State's Derby promises to boil down to a contest between a pair of Todd Pletcher trainees, **Pollard's Vision** and GI Kentucky Derby fourth-place finisher **Limehouse**. The former proved he could handle a route of ground while winning the nine-furlong GII Illinois Derby by 2 3/4 lengths, but couldn't build off that effort and was up the track in the May 1 Derby. Stablemate Limehouse had a better Derby experience, running a very credible fourth to Smarty Jones. His spring campaign included wins in the GII Hutcheson S. and GIII Tampa Bay Derby before he filled out the tri-fecta in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. Limehouse will be reunited with Jose Santos, who was aboard for the Run for the Roses.

Hollywood Story has shown an affinity for the track that shares her name, posting a 2 3/4-length score in the Dec. 21 GI Hollywood Starlet S. in her two-year-old finale. Second by a half length to A.P. Adventure in her sophomore bow, the Feb. 15 GI Las Virgenes S., the dark bay filly was again a half-length behind that rival when fourth in the Mar. 13 GI Santa Anita Oaks. She was a troubled fifth over a muddy Churchill strip in the Apr. 30 GI Kentucky Oaks, but should improve off that effort as she looks to break her trainer's 0-for-25 streak at the meet. "The Kentucky Oaks was especially difficult for horses from the West Coast who hadn't experienced that kind of track before," Shirreffs said. "Tracks that are uneven are very hard on a horse, and it was very uneven that day." **House of Fortune** could do no better than eighth in the Kentucky Oaks, but had won five of her previous eight starts. Second in the Jan. 19 GII Santa Ynez S. to start the year, the California-bred came back to take the Mar. 6 California Oaks by a resounding 17 lengths and prepped for her appearance under the Twin Spires with a 1 3/4-length tally over subsequent GI Acorn S. winner and Kentucky Oaks runner-up Island Sand in the Apr. 9 GII Fantasy S.

"Russian Rhythm missing the mile race might now have a bearing on our decision," the syndicate's Racing Manager Matthew Budden told the *Racing Post*. "But we wouldn't want to run Soviet Song on rock-hard ground."

HANDLERS DISPUTE SETTLED Officials at Ascot racecourse breathed a huge sigh of relief yesterday after an agreement was reached in the dispute between the stalls handlers and their employers RaceTech. The ongoing dispute had surrounded the changes in benefits for the stalls handlers, who had withdrawn their services at recent meetings and, most dramatically, for last Friday's G2 Temple S. at Epsom. Their threat to take industrial action for the duration of the Royal meeting next week disappeared yesterday after their proposal was accepted by Racetech. "It has been settled and there is no further industrial action with immediate effect," commented Sim Harris, managing director of RaceTech. "Royal Ascot is safe and there is no action on Friday or Saturday at any of the courses." Ascot's Clerk of the Course Nick Cheyne added, "We are delighted that an amicable agreement has been reached, not only for us, but for racing in general. We are now looking forward to the meeting and seeing the stalls handlers here as they are a very important part of the meeting and do an excellent job. Obviously, it is a big relief."
