ROYAL ASCOT GETS UNDERWAY TOMORROW

With over £3 million in prizemoney on offer, the 22 stakes races, seven handicaps and one conditions race at Roval Ascot are amongst the most hotly contested in the European racing calendar. The five-day Royal meeting gets underway tomorrow afternoon, and the highlight of the opening-day program is the G1 St James's Palace S. Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid al Maktoum's Haafhd (GB) (Alhaarth {Ire}) will bid to extend the record of his owner-breeder in the major events in the one-mile St James. Sheikh Hamdan has already enjoyed Royal success with past luminaries such as G1 Prince of Wales's S. scorer Navef and Marju (Ire), who took this race in 1991. A win for Haafhd would be particularly poignant for connections, as his dam is none other than Al Bahathri, who was the first to carry the blue and white silks to victory at this meeting in the G1 Coronation S. in 1985. He faces stiff opposition from the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas scorer Bachelor Duke (Miswaki). Triumph for this challenger would ensure emotive scenes, as he was picked out as a yearling by Joss Collins and carries the straw silks of the Duke of Devonshire, two mighty characters of the turf who sadly passed away recently. A Cut Above...

Latice suggested she was well above average when defeating subsequent G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud and G1 Prix Lupin hero Voix du Nord (Fr) and G1 Prix du Jockey-Club runner-up Prospect Park (GB) in the G3 Prix de Conde at Longchamp in October. She had only to go through the motions when beating Asti (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) by a length in her sophomore debut, the G3 Prix Vanteaux at Longchamp May 2 and, with connections resisting the temptation to run in the G1 Prix Saint-Alary, she entered this Classic a fresh horse. "She is a top-class filly...I would have been very disappointed if she had lost," conditioner Jean-Marie Beguigne commented. "She didn't have a great draw here, but came in for a perfect ride and showed how well she can quicken. That was a classy field and she won like a champion. We'll decide later where she goes, but the G1 Prix Vermeille [at Longchamp Sept. 12] could be her next target." She may renew rivalry with the runner-up there, according to trainer Elie Lellouche. "Millionaia is a very nice filly and I favored her to Asti, but, unfortunately, she was not experienced enough here," he said. "She will return in the Prix Vermeille." Jockey Gary Stevens had no excuses for Grey Lilas, but was not helped by the pre-race parade. "The post parade got her upset and she wasted a lot of energy before the start," he said.
