#### BREAK OUT THE BUBBLY

Jockey Ioritz Mendizabal eased Love And Bubbles to the front at the eighth pole and the partnership were not extended thereafter to easily deny the game Cattiva Generosa, with Cloon (Lure) running on well late to claim third. 
#### Lion Heart Back on Work Tab:
