Let the Lion Roar will be saddled by John Dunlop, who collected this prize in 1978 with Shirley Heights (GB) and in 1990 with Salsabil (GB). He is hopeful that the colt can make up the ground on North Light at this less undulating venue. "I couldn't be more pleased with him," he told *PA Sport*. "He didn't come down the hill at all well at Epsom and made up a lot of ground. I think the visor we put on our horse in the Derby improved him from his York form and The Curragh is a very fair track." **Percussionist (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) was another who was caught out by the undulations at Surrey, but the recent rain will help the powerful galloper. The late Robert Sangster's son Ben told *PA Sport*, "Percussionist didn't really handle Epsom and the Curragh will hopefully suit him better. Whether that will be good enough is another question." Dermot Weld, who took this in 1996 with Zagreb, is represented by **Grey Swallow (Ire)** (Daylami {Ire}), who lacked the requisite speed to shake up Haafhd (GB) in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 1. He followed a fourth there with a fine third in the Irish equivalent May 22 and looked in need of a step up in trip. Unusually, all of the five-strong Aidan O'Brien team need to improve to feature in a race he has won three times since 1996, but the manner with which **Five Dynasties** (Danehill) took last Friday's G2 King Edward VII S. at Royal Ascot suggests he could rate as a threat if the rain eases off.

Stellar Jayne (Wild Rush) won three of her five starts as a juvenile, capping her hattrick with a rallying score in the Nov. 1 Pocahontas S. at Churchill Downs. But

the gray filly fell on hard times after that effort. She ended her 2003 campaign with an eighthplace finish in the Nov. 29 GII Golden Rod S. and was off the board in her first four starts as a sophomore as well. The three-year-old improved to be third in the Apr. 9 GII Fantasy S. at Oaklawn Park, but faltered as a 40-1 shot in the GI

Kentucky Oaks, running seventh behind Ashado and Island Sand. Wayne Lukas persisted with his charge, however, and was rewarded when, showing uncharacteristic speed, she galloped to a 3 1/4-length tally at 2-1 in the June 5 GIII Dogwood Breeders' Cup S. Given little chance to repeat in the Mother Goose, Stellar Jayne pressed the speedy Ashado through the opening quarter and was head-and-head for the lead through a half in :47 and six furlongs in 1:10.97. But, instead of spitting the bit, as the crowd expected, she dug in down the lane to win going away. "Ashado ranged up to her and it looked like [jockey John Velazquez] had a lot of horse, so I said, 'you know what -- I'm going to ride her from here," rider Robby Albarado remarked. "Turning for home, she just exploded. She ran great." Looking ahead, assistant Peter Hutton said, "Obviously Wayne will talk to the owners and they'll decide where to go from here, but I don't see why she wouldn't try the [GI Coaching Club American Oaks July 24]."

A Shade Too Far...

Favored **Ashado** (Saint Ballado) tired after dueling early, but held on to be second. "Johnny [Velazquez] said she got pretty tired the last part," trainer Todd Pletcher said, but added, "She ran a good race, like she always does. Hopefully this will move her forward for the next one." The filly will face Stellar Jayne again in the Coaching Club. Second choice **Island Sand** (Tabasco Cat) may have had an excuse for her thirdplace effort. "[Jockey Terry Thompson] said she was making a lot of racket breathing," trainer Larry Jones said. "When she cools out, we'll get her scoped... there's a real good shot she entrapped." He added, "That's something we can fix."

Chorist has improved since finishing runner-up to subsequent G1 Prix de l'Opera winner Zee Zee Top (GB) in the Listed Middleton S. at York last May, winning the Listed Hoppings S. at Newcastle the following month and the G3 Golden Daffodil S. at Chepstow in July. Responding in game fashion, he cut down that rival with 150 yards remaining before asserting from the persistent Dubai Success in the closing stages. "We weren't sure whether he'd stay, but there were no other races for him, so we had to pray," conditioner John Oxx said. "He did it well and loves that ground." Despite the presence of **Cacique**, the field for this prestigious race proves that the opposition are running scared from France's new sensation **Bago**. It came as no surprise to see that colt acclaimed as Europe's champion juvenile of 2003 by the panel of International handicappers after his sparkling victories in the G3 Prix des Chenes at this track in September and G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud in November. Connections had to suffer the agony of watching the Classics pass without Bago, who was denied the opportunity to justify his lofty reputation this spring by a virus, but, making his eagerly awaited return in the G1 Prix Jean Prat on Prix du Jockey-Club day at Chantilly June 6, he upstaged the Classic itself with a highly impressive three-length defeat of Cacique, just missing the track record in the process. With normal improvement, he should provide a belated second renewal for Jonathan Pease, who has endured a long wait since Swink took this in 1986. If anybody can get the requisite progression from Cacique, it is Andre Fabre, who has won this race no less than eight times since 1989. A full brother to Dansili (GB), Banks Hill (GB) and Intercontinental (GB) and a 3/4 to Heat Haze (GB), he is bred for improvement. He took conditions events at Saint-Cloud Apr. 14 and at this track May 19 and was racing for only the third time at Chantilly. Privy Seal may have found the mile and a half of the G1 Derby Italiano too far when third in Rome May 30, but needs to bounce back from a disappointing effort when only ninth in last Thursday's Listed Hampton Court S. at Royal Ascot.

Jockey Stewart Elliott will try to match the feat of Kent Desormeaux, who guided Real Quiet to victory in the first two legs of the Triple Crown in 1998, then brought Eugene Melnyk's Archers Bay home first in the Queen's Plate the same season. Elliott rides Melnyk's Long Pond in his stakes debut. The chestnut colt is two-for-two in 2004, breaking his maiden in a sevenfurlong sprint May 14 and returning to take a 1 1/16mile allowance test June 6. "He is undefeated this year, which is great, and he beat older horses," Elliott said. "It looks like we've got a pretty good chance."
