The lightly raced four-year-old made only four starts last year, winning a pair of allowance contests before running third in the GI King's Bishop and winning the Vosburgh. Ghostzapper was the 6-5 favorite in yesterday's short field of four and, never far back, he moved up effortlessly to challenge for the lead in upper stretch and quickly drew clear for a confident score. "[Trainer] Bobby [Frankel] didn't want me to kill the horse after the lavoff," explained winning rider Javier Castellano. "I had to keep him with the pace, but not go too early and over use him. He ran a big race today." Frankel added, "We'll probably point to the seven-eighths race at Saratoga [Sept. 4 G1 Forego] and maybe a race before then. NORTH LIGHT LAME The Weinstock Family's G1 Epsom Derby winner **North Light (Ire)** (Danehill) returned lame from his loss in the June 27 Irish Derby, according to connections. Conditioner Sir Michael Stoute said yesterday that the colt "came back lame on his right hind" after his half-length second to Grey Swallow (Ire). The revelation puts on hold a planned run in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth II Diamond S. at Ascot July 24. "The problem is high up on his quarter and he is receiving a lot of physio and is just walking now," Stoute said. "We'll have to wait until he comes sound to think about where he goes next."

His fine length second to Vinnie Roe (Ire) in the G1 Irish St Leger at The Curragh in September may have taken its toll, as he could only finish a disappointing third behind Scott's View (GB) in the Listed Serlby S. at Doncaster in November. 

Shirocco turned this competitive renewal into a procession to provide conditioner Andreas Schutz with his fifth Deutches Derby since 1998. After a debut second in a Krefeld maiden Mar. 27, Shirocco stormed to a seven-length success in the Listed Derby-Trial at Mulheim May 15. He disappointed as the 2-5 favorite when third behind Malinas and Omikron in the G2 Oppenheim-Union-Rennen at Cologne last time June 13, but bounced back to readily reverse that form in these testing conditions. Andreas Suborics settled the powerful galloper in a stalking third early before utilizing his bottomless stamina by committing him on the turn into the straight. Taking command approaching the half-mile marker, he drew steadily clear of the game Malinas, who stayed on at a respectable distance. Shirocco represents a landmark for Baron Georg von Ullmann in becoming his first homebred Derby winner. The colt's sire, Monsun, who was also responsible for this year's G1 Preis der Diana winner Amarette (Ger), was runner-up to Lando (Ger) in the 1993 version. Roses in May cruised to a 10-length allowance victory at Saratoga last August, but went to the sidelines after finishing sixth in the Sept. 13 Gll Jerome H. The dark bay has been unbeatable since his return, taking a Keeneland allowance test by 12 lengths Apr. 17 and adding a five-length success in an optional claimer at Churchill Downs May 21. Taking on the talented Perfect Drift in his third start of the season, the late bloomer was sent right to the lead and took them along through a guarter in :23.57 and half in :46.98. Heavy chalk Perfect Drift came after him from the rail after six furlongs in 1:10.26, but Roses of May, up to the challenge, held him at bay before edging clear late. "I knew I had a lot of horse underneath me," winning jockey Mark Guidry said. "I was just hoping he'd switch leads a little sooner than he did, but once he finally switched, I knew Perfect Drift wasn't going to come to us." Jockey Pat Day was pleased with the effort of the runner-up. "The winner is a nice horse--there's no taking anything away from him," Day said. "There's certainly no shame to get beat by this horse. I think you're going to hear more of him." Winning trainer Dale Romans agrees. "The way he trains and the way his career is shaping up, I don't think there's a limit on how high he can go," Romans said. It has not yet been decided where Roses of May will run next. FALLON DISREPUTE HEARING IN SEPTEMBER

Jockeys Kieren Fallon and John Egan will face a Jockey Club inquiry in September into allegations that they harmed the reputation of the sport of racing as a result of the *News of the World* expose earlier this year. Champion Fallon had learned last week that he will not face charges of accepting money or benefit in kind from undercover reporters in exchange for information. "The main issue in the inquiry is whether Kieren Fallon and John Egan brought racing into disrepute in their discussions and relationships with reporters from the *News of the World*," commented the Jockey Club's Public Relations Director John Maxse.

RAKTI PLANS ON HOLD

Gary Tanaka's Rakti (GB) (Polish Precedent) was reported in fine fettle by his trainer Michael Jarvis yesterday, who is pondering the next course of action after Rakti's disappointing show in Saturday's G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown. Sent off the 13-8 pick the 10-furlong contest on the basis of his success in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot June 16, the five-year-old failed to settle in the early stages before fading to finish eighth. "The ground was not ideal for him, but it wasn't desperate," Jarvis told PA Sport yesterday. "He got himself a bit wound up in the stalls, then half-missed the break before taking off. He's absolutely fine this morning though." Jarvis admitted that the original plan to chase the BHB's Middle Distance Championship by running in the G1 International S. at York Aug. 17 will be rethought. "We might consider dropping him back in trip, but I need to discuss it with the owner," he added. "I don't think his targets will be as set in stone now."
