"She kind of got sucked down on the inside behind in her last race and never really got a chance to run," explained winning trainer Larry Ross. The last time they locked horns, Champali could only get within four lengths of a streaking Clock Stopper when third in the Perryville S. at Keeneland last October. Third to Cajun Beat in the GIII Kentucky Cup Sprint prior to his Perryville effort, he closed the year with a close fourth in a Churchill turf allowance Nov. 14. He was second in his return in a tough allowance test on the Derby undercard and took a May 26 heat by 1 1/4 lengths, and came into this off a 3 1/4-length score in the GIII Aristides H. at Churchill June 19. The second choice in the wagering, Champali set strong fractions along the inside, but left the rail open as he passed midstretch and was just able to hold Clock Stopper, who closed gamely to barely miss. "I was concerned when he tried to get out a little at the top of the stretch," winning trainer Greg Foley admitted. "He's done that before, but Jerry gave him a couple of taps and he straightened right out." Foley indicated that Champali would have one more start prior to the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint Oct. 30. Film Maker posted a pair of upsets last season winning the GIII Lake George S. at Saratoga July 28 and the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup S. at Keeneland Oct. 11, then closed out her sophomore campaign with an eighth-place finish in the GII Mrs. Revere S. at Churchill Nov. 15. Returning to the races five months later, she came up empty while sixth in the GIII Jenny Wiley S., but sprung to life most recently with a second-place effort in the GIII Gallorette H. behind Ocean Drive Preakness Day. Backed as the favorite by the Colonial faithful here, she saved ground while fourth, was eased out by the red-hot Edgar Prado for the stretch run and drew off to post an easy victory. Noisette led through pedestrian-like fractions of :25 4/5 and :50 3/5, but could do no better than second. Second-choice Sand Springs was rank after breaking slowly and tired badly to finish seventh.
