GOLDEN PERFORMANCE FOR MEDALLIST

With a tough group of horses assembled for yesterday's GII Dwyer S., including GI Blue Grass S. hero **The Cliff's Edge** (Gulch), and graded stakes winners **Preachinathebar** (Silver Charm) and **Sir Shackleton** (Miswaki), **Medallist** (Touch Gold) appeared to have a tall order to fill, but the Allen Jerkens trainee was oblivious to the fact as he powered to a decisive 3 3/4-length victory in stakes record time. Gunning straight from the start, Medallist led by two lengths after a blistering quarter mile in :22.83 and increased his advantage to six following an equally sharp half in :44.45. While Medallist's early exertions may have given the others hope that he would ultimately wilt in the final sixteenth, Medallist quickly dispelled such notions. In front by seven lengths a furlong from home, Medallist had enough left in reserve to hold off stablemates The Cliff's Edge and Sir Shackleton. In addition to carving out a stakes record, Medallist was only 3/5 of a second off the track mark. STAR PARADE SHINES IN MILADY

Star Parade (Arg) (Parade Marshall) hadn't seen the inside of the winner's enclosure since February, but she made the most of a scratch-depleted race to reverse that form and win Sunday's GI Milady H. at Hollywood Park. Facing a pair of confirmed speedsters for her drop back to her most comfortable distance, Star Parade took command early and carved out sensible early fractions of :23.77 for the opening quarter and :46.29 for a half mile. Momentarily passed by Grade II winner **Quero Quero** (Royal Academy) 2 1/2 furlongs from home, Star Parade regained the advantage at the top of the stretch and inched clear late to out game her foe by a length. Third choice **Pesci** (Stormy Atlantic) ran evenly to round out the trifecta, while 2-1 shot **Victory Encounter** (Victory Speech) never was a factor and came home a well-beaten fourth. "I wasn't so sure she was going to be on the lead," trainer Darrell Vienna said. "I know that she is very game and she has never hesitated to give her all. Star Power..

Star Parade handed GI Breeders' Cup Distaff heroine Adoration a sound defeat over this track and distance in the GI Bayakoa H. last December and picked up where she left off by winning her 2004 debut in Santa Anita's GI Santa Maria H. Feb. 16. Adoration came back and

got the best of her Argentine rival next time out in the nine-furlong GI Santa Margarita H. Mar. 14, which allowed Star Parade to go off a plump 10-1 chance in the Apr. 3 GI Apple Blossom H. at Oaklawn Park. Across the wire in third behind 2002 Horse of the Year Azeri and Wild Spirit (Chi), the five-year-old was awarded second-

place money when Wild Spirit was pushed back for causing interference in the stretch. Most recently, Star Parade weakened late and finished third in the GI Vanity H. going nine furlongs over this track May 9.

Doing Everything Right..

A model of consistency, Medallist finished in the money in four of five prior lifetime starts. Third to the speedy colt Forest Danger in a seven-furlong allowance at Gulfstream Park Mar. 13, Medallist improved to second, despite a wide trip, next time going a furlong shorter over that track Mar. 31. Stretched to a mile for the first time in his career in his most recent start, Medallist responded to post an impressive 3 1/4-length win over Forest Danger in the GIII Withers S. at Aqueduct May 1. According to winning trainer Allen Jerkens, Medallist may step down in class for his next assignment. "He's still eligible for a three-other than allowance, so maybe we'll run him around two turns in an allowance race," said Jerkens. Also pondering his colt's future, trainer Nick Zito confirmed that runner-up The Cliff's Edge will make his next start in the GI Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga Aug. 8.

Martillo swooped late to deny the younger Assiun in a thrilling finish and record back-to-back successes in this contest. In doing so, he confirmed his status as Germany's leading miler. The colt started building his reputation when taking the G2 Mehl-Mulhens-Rennen at Cologne last May and proved he could hold his own on the international stages when third in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot the following month before registering a comfortable score in this 12 months ago. After disappointing when only seventh in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville in August, the bay returned to finish fifth in the G1 Dubai Duty Free at Nad al Sheba Mar. 27. He got back on the scoresheet in the G2 Prix du Muguet at Saint-Cloud May 1 before finishing ninth behind Refuse to Bend (Ire) in the G1 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot June 15. Reined back to stalk the steady early tempo here, he was temporarily short of room when the sprint began in the straight, but was switched wide and quickened to wear down Assiun and Checkit in the dying strides.

Ryono progressed from handicap company in his native Germany last term to win the Listed Prix du Ranelagh at Longchamp in October. He returned to take the Listed Premio Bereguardo in Milan May 15 and belied his long odds to upset the favorite Diamond Green in this contest. Settled in rear throughout the early stages as that rival shared front-running duties with Maxwell (Anabaa), he found a seam up the stands' rail inside the final quarter and quickened to lead at the eighth pole. Surging clear from there, he was comfortably on top at the line as Diamond Green failed to stage a rally in the testing conditions. Mike Lee S. Winner Multiplication Dead:

Multiplication (Subordination--Tricky Move, by Tricky Creek), who shipped cross country to capture the Mike Lee S. for New York-breds June 26, died Saturday morning at Belmont Park of an apparent heart attack, reports the *Daily Racing Form*. The chestnut was returning to Bob Baffert's barn following a bullet six-furlong breeze in 1:11.56 when he collapsed. A New York Racing Association veterinarian said that the cause of death appeared to be a massive heart attack. Purchased by James McIngvale for \$300,000 at the OBSMAR two-year-old sale, Multiplication began his career on the West Coast, where he took a Hollywood maiden by three lengths May 22 in his penultimate start. Multiplication won two of four starts with earnings of \$102,740.
