SUCCESSFUL APPEAL TO KENTUCKY

Successful Appeal (Valid Appeal--Successful Dancer, by Fortunate Prospect), the leading freshman and juvenile sire of 2004, is being relocated to Walmac International's Kentucky nursery for the 2005 breeding sea-



son. The eight-year-old stallion, who stood his first three seasons at Walmac South/Hartley De Renzo in Ocala, Florida, is the sire of five individual winners, three of which have already won black-type events. He is the first U.S. stallion to ever sire three two-vear-old stakes winners prior to June 26. "We

always believed Successful Appeal would be a superior source of early runners, as he was an exceptional twoyear-old," said Walmac Vice President John T.L. Jones III. "But siring more stakes winners at this stage of his career than Danzig, Storm Cat, Mr. Prospector or Bold Ruler places him among the elite." The dark bay stallion, campaigned to graded-stakes victories at two, three and four by Starview Stables, has been the subject of increased interest with each and every success of his progeny. "We averaged 68 mares annually the first three years we stood him," said Hartley/De Renzo's Dean De Renzo. "But nothing quite prepared us for the onslaught of phone calls once his two-year-olds



started winning. We fielded 25 or 30 calls a day after each stakes win." Successful Appeal's first crop has been highlighted by Lunarpal, undefeated and a three-time stakes winner in four starts for William Heiligbrodt. The Texas native has the dam of

Lunarpal Four Footed Photos Lunarpal, Quiet Eclipse, back in foal to Successful Appeal. The sire of one additional stakes placed runner, Successful Appeal has progeny earnings to date of \$501,727. A stud fee for 2005 has yet to be determined. He stood for \$6,000 this year.

De Seroux Duo Due to Return for Preview Day:

Ballingarry (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), the two-time defending champion of the GIII Stars and Stripes Breeders' Cup Turf H., and **Toasted** (Hennessy), recent winner of the GII Arlington Classic, will make a return trip to Chicago July 24. Both horse are owned by 93-year-old Sid Port and trained by Laura de Seroux. Ballingarry will shorten up to 10 furlongs for the GIII Arlington H. while Toasted will take his chance in the GII American Derby, contested over 9 1/2 furlongs. De Seroux was planning on training the two up to the International Festival of Racing Aug. 14, but decided to call an audible. "They both took the trip [to Chicago] great and were literally tearing the barn down after they got home," the conditioner commented. "So I talked to Mr. Port and we decided to try these next two races with them."

Weld Shooting for Third American Derby:

All-time leading Irish trainer Dermot Weld has won the GII American Derby in two of the last four years-with Pine Dance in 2000 and last season with Evolving Tactics--and will shoot for a third win in the July 24 event with Moyglare Stud's **Simple Exchange (Ire)** (Danehill). A maiden winner at first asking last August, the bay finished fifth, beaten four lengths by One Cool Cat, in the G1 National S. Sept. 14 before winning the Listed El Gran Senor S. at Cork in his final start of the season Sept. 27. He was a staying-on fourth in the Listed Hampton Court S. on his return June 17 and should improve nicely off that effort. Pat Smullen, who guided Moyglare's Evolving Tactics to his win last year, has ridden Simple Exchange in each of his five career starts.

If you don't watch these things, they can turn into a quarter crack." **Chandtrue** (Yes It's True), a two-time stakes winner during the meet, is expected to start, while the Baffert stable will be represented by **Actxecutive** (Noactor), fourth to Chandture in the June 20 Haggin S.

Valenzuela's Attorney to Seek Restraining Order:

Neil Papiano, the attorney for suspended jockey Patrick Valenzuela, will appear this morning in Los Angeles Superior Court to seek a temporary restraining order, which would allow an immediate return to the saddle. Valenzuela was suspended for the entire month of June, but made a winning return to the races on July 1. The following day, after failing to provide a hair follicle sample, as is required of him, Hollywood Park stewards suspended Valenzuela, pending a formal hearing. He was also suspended Jan. 23 by Santa Anita stewards after taking off his mounts the previous afternoon, claiming an ankle injury. He was requested to provide a urine sample, but refused and remained out of touch for two weeks.

Leading from the outset here, the 4-7 favorite was untroubled throughout and cruised to an unchallenged four-length success from Always First (GB) (Barathea {Ire}). 
