LION TAMES LONG BRANCH FOES Lion Heart

(Tale of the Cat) capped an unbeaten juvenile campaign with a victory in the GI Hollywood Futurity, but sustained heartbreaking runner-up finishes in his first three outings this year. Second by a neck in the GII San Rafael S. Mar. 6, he was a half-length behind The Cliff's Edge in the GI Blue Grass S. Apr. 10 and was second best to Smarty Jones in the GI Kentucky Derby May 1. But he folded tamely when fourth in the GI Preakness S. two weeks later and earned himself a vacation. With leading Monmouth jockey Joe Bravo in the irons as regular rider Mike Smith stayed in California, Lion Heart raced with the pace while three wide through honest fractions and went up to assume the lead heading into the far turn. But My Snookie's Boy (Crafty Friend), a \$50,000 claim Apr. 1, made the favorite work hard the length of the stretch. Lion Heart will be making another journey to the Jersey Shore. "I am 155-percent sure we will be back for the Haskell [GI, 8-8]," said winning trainer Patrick Biancone. "As long is well with him after this race, we will be back."

Apart from a second to Silent Sighs--subsequently a Grade I winner--in December, Yearly Report sports a perfect record. She rebounded from that loss to win the GII Santa Ynez S. Jan. 19, but missed some time after tying up. Returning Apr. 24 in the Cal-bred Melair S., she easily handled the two-turn question in that contest and went on the road, annexing the GII Black-Eyed Susan S. May 14. The bay hadn't raced since, but was a prohibitive favorite in this half-million dollar affair. Jockey Jerry Bailey settled her in second through six furlongs in 1:12 3/5, then asked for a bit more on the far turn. Yearly Report put her head in front and was quickly joined by Ender's Sister at the top of the stretch. The pair battled down the lane, but the Golden Eagle colorbearer kept finding more and finally edged clear in the final strides.

GET ON BOARD

Lord Derby's Ouija Board (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}) put up one of the most visually impressive performances of the season when winning the G1 Epsom Oaks last time June 4 and she bids to become the 10th filly to complete the double since 1970 in today's G1 Darley Irish Oaks at The Curragh. Her seven-length defeat of Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's All Too Beautiful (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) will take some reversing here, while Godolphin's Punctilious (GB) (Danehill) has even more ground to make up on the favorite. Trainer Ed Dunlop admitted to feeling the pressure earlier this week. "There's an expectancy," he said. "If she doesn't win, it'll be a case of 'why,' whereas at Epsom there was a bit of amazement. I was shocked by how far she won there and the time was very fast, but that's all in the past. I do strongly believe that the runner-up and the third will be more suited by a more galloping track rather than Epsom, so that's obviously a concern." Dunlop, who took the Classic with Lailani (GB) in 2001, believes Ouija Board "has always shown a lot more class" than that filly, adding, "I think she grew after Epsom and in the last two or three weeks we've been very happy with her."

All in the Family

Trainer Aidan O'Brien has yet to win this race, despite finishing runner-up in four of the last six renewals, and will be hoping for rain for the regally bred All Too Beautiful, who stepped up off her score in the Listed Salsabil S. at Navan Apr. 24 to chase home Ouija Board at Epsom. All Too Beautiful, acquired for 1.1-million guineas as a foal, is a full sister to Galileo (Ire)--the 2001 Epsom and Irish Derby hero--and MG1SW Black Sam Bellamy (Ire). "She ran very well, but she was just green," O'Brien told Racing Post after the Oaks, which was only her third career start. "She hasn't had a lot of racing." Punctilious disappointed at Epsom, finishing 10½ lengths adrift of the winner in third, but demonstrated her class when capturing the G3 Musidora S. at York May 11 and G2 Ribblesdale S. at Royal Ascot last time June 17. His Highness the Aga Khan's Hazarista (Ire) (Barathea {Ire}) represents the John Oxx stable responsible for two winners since 1997, but has to improve on her success in the G3 Blue Wind S. at Cork last time May 14. That also applies to Danelissima (Ire) (Danehill), who took the G3 Noblesse S. at Naas June 16 before finishing third behind Pongee (GB) in the G2 Lancashire Oaks at Haydock last time July 3. She hails from the Jim Bolger stable successful twice in this race, including with the 33-1 outsider Margarula (Ire) two years ago.

Favored in his return to the lawn, Silver Ticket settled into stride in fourth as GSW Bachelor Blues cruised along on the front end. He was asked to step it up in the stretch and duly obliged, collaring the pacesetter at the eighth pole on the way to his first stakes victory. "He was more relaxed today and sat back off the pace on his own," said winning rider Todd Kabel, who was winning the Toronto Cup for the fourth time in the last five years. "Sometimes he's an anxious horse and drags you up there."


