"It came as a big surprise when I was approached and, having been a trainer for nearly 16 years, it was in many ways a difficult decision to give up, but at the end of the day, being offered the chance to work with some of the best Thoroughbreds in the world was an opportunity I really couldn't turn down," Graham told the Post. "I think it's an exciting proposition to work with that calibre of horse in that sort of environment. It also means an end to all the worries that go with being an independent trainer." Graham, whose finest hour as an independent trainer came when winning the 1996 G3 Nell Gwyn S. with Thrilling Day (GB), had been leasing a 15-box yard from Henry Cecil since selling his Coronation Stables in February. Godolphin's Racing Manager Simon Crisford said, "Godolphin has more horses in training than we did last year, and we are anticipating 2005 to be the same. As a consequence, we have a requirement for additional personnel within the team and Neil can bring a lot to the table. He is a highly respected horseman with a great wealth of experience behind him and, in that respect, he will be a perfect assistant to Saeed bin Suroor. We are all looking forward to having him on board."

MICK BACK FOR CUP

Paul Dixon's **Milk It Mick (GB)** (Millkom {GB}) will make his reappearance in Tuesday's £100,000 G2 Betfair Cup at the Glorious Goodwood meeting. Last year's G1 Dewhurst S. hero has been off the track since disappointing when eighth in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 1, but is set to drop back in trip to seven furlongs for the race registered as the Lennox S. "He looked very well going into the Guineas, but three days after he came back it was obvious that something was amiss," trainer Jamie Osborne explained. "It's too early to write him off and his work has been very good recently." Milk it Mick is likely to face Juddmonte Farms' G3 Minstrel S. winner **Trade Fair (GB)** (Zafonic) as well as Godolphin's G3 Jersey S. victor **Kheleyf** (Green Desert).

RIDGE FACES LENGTHY LAY-OFF

Godolphin's Snow Ridge (Ire) (Indian Ridge {Ire}) may miss the remainder of the flat season, according to connections. The G1 2000 Guineas runner-up has not been seen since finishing seventh in the G1 Epsom Derby June 5, but Racing Manager Simon Crisford revealed to The Times that "he has not been in good form since." He added, "He has not done any fast work since then, and there are no imminent plans to bring him back. I can't say for sure whether he will run again this season, but the one thing he does need is plenty of time. Whatever happens, he will be back next season." Crisford also revealed that G1 1000 Guineas runner-up Sundrop (Jpn) (Sunday Silence), away since disappointing when sixth in the G1 Epsom Oaks June 4, was back in training after suffering an injury in that Classic. "She came back from Epsom with a soft tissue injury, but is back in training now," he explained. "We will prepare her for a campaign that will start in late summer."

MINOR CHANGES TO FIXTURE LIST

The British Horseracing Board (BHB) has published the 2005 fixture list, which Racing Director Ruth Quinn described as a "consolidation" of this year's fixtures. With only eight extra regional meetings announced, there are few major changes, the most significant being the usurping of Doncaster by Kempton as hosts to the first meeting of the Flat turf season Mar. 26."The 2005 fixture list seeks to make best use of racing's greatest asset, our horse population, while balancing the needs of customers and the industry," Quinn added. "It is largely a consolidation of the 2004 fixture list, which is bringing in significantly more income to racing through a more efficient siting of fixtures and by providing extra racing and betting opportunities."
