LEOPARDSTOWN IN CARDS FOR DOYEN

Godolphin look likely to send Saturday's impressive G1 King George VI And Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. winner **Doyen (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) to Leopardstown for the 10-furlong G1 Irish Champion S. Sept. 11. Racing Manager Simon Crisford yesterday reported the four-year-old to be "absolutely fine" after his three-length defeat of Hard Buck (Brz). "Doyen's in good form and now we will have to make and finalize plans for him in the next few weeks," he told *PA Sport*. "We may well go to Ireland and we wouldn't be worried about dropping in trip." Crisford also reported the third-placed **Sulamani (Ire)** (Hernando {Fr}) to be "fine," with the G1 International S. at York Aug. 17 a possible next target for the five-year-old.

GERMAN DATE FOR BUCK?

Team Victory's Hard Buck (Brz) (Spend a Buck), who finished runner-up to Doyen (Ire) in Saturday's G1 King George VI And Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot, may take in the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden Sept. 5. Conditioner Kenny McPeek has the option of sending the five-year-old to the GI Sword Dancer Invitational H. at Saratoga Aug. 11, but he is more likely to wait for the German contest. "He's great this morning and he came out of the race very well," he told *PA Sport* yesterday. "We are going to make a decision in the next few days about where we go. We could take him back to Saratoga for the Sword Dancer, but it may be too fast for him, or we could go to Baden-Baden. He is booked on a flight home on Wednesday, so we will probably make a decision on Tuesday."

PHOENIX BLED

Winterbeck Manor Stud's **Phoenix Reach (Ire)** (Alhaarth {Ire}) was reported to have bled when disappointing in Saturday's G1 King George VI And Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot. Purse Reduction at Ellis:

Ellis Park has announced a five-percent reduction in all overnight purses, effective July 28 and through the remainder of the 54-day meeting which runs through Sept. 6. The Henderson, Kentucky track has also cancelled the meet's final three stakes: the Aug. 28 Governor's H., the Sept. 4 Dade Turf Classic and the Sept. 6 Tri-State H. "The loss of wagering revenue during the weather-related power outage at Trackside Louisville during the period of July 14 through 16 and soft on-track wagering totals have prompted this purse reduction," explained Ellis Park General Manager Paul Kuerzi. "We have had solid on-track attendance this meet, but the loss of a major wagering source such as the Trackside Louisville for that period is a factor that we will not be able to overcome at this meet. We regret the decision to reduce our purses, but we continue to face increasing competition in our home market and rising competitive pressure for both horses and a share of the simulcast wagering market from tracks with purses boosted by slot machine revenues. Those factors make it increasingly difficult for Ellis Park to absorb an unanticipated setback like the weather-related loss of simulcast revenues from Trackside Louisville."
