#### SMARTY JONES OUT OF PENNSYLVANIA DERBY

Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner **Smarty Jones** (Elusive Quality) will not make his next start in the GII Pennsylvania Derby, as previously expected. Trainer John Servis informed Philadelphia Park officials yesterday that his star pupil will not be ready for the Sept. 6

race. "John has told us that his training since coming back off the Triple Crown break has not progressed significantly enough to keep him on track for a start in the Pennsylvania Derby," track CEO Hal Handel said in a statement. "His future plans are obviously now under discussion, but he will not be here for the Derby. We're tremendously

disappointed in the development, but are extremely appreciative that the Chapmans, John and all of 'Team Smarty' allowed us to be part of the excitement that permeated this plant all spring." Philadelphia Park-based Smarty Jones has not started since losing out on his Triple Crown bid with a runner-up effort in the June 5 GI Belmont S. Fall plans had called for the colt to run in the Pennsylvania Derby, the Pegasus S. at the Meadowlands and the Breeders' Cup Classic at Lone Star Park.

Trade Fair has another opportunity to shed the tag of a 'nearly horse' as he bids to annex the crucial Group 2 triumph he warrants. His successes in the G3 Criterion S. at Newmarket last June and G3 Minstrel S. at The Curragh last time July 18 have established him as one of the best seven-furlong performers in Europe. However, his four forays beyond Group 3 level have seen him fall short of the required standard, despite having the valid excuse of unsuitably soft ground on two occasions.

#### (Lennox S. cont.)

The sophomore Kheleyf will be a worthy adversary and if Trade Fair fails to fire again, he could be the main beneficiary. He failed to live up to his lofty reputation when finishing down the field in the G1 Middle Park S. at Newmarket in October, but looked a different proposition on his return when destroying his rivals in the G3 Jersey S. at Royal Ascot June 16. His outing in the G1 July Cup back at six furlongs at Newmarket last time July 8 was a write-off as he was hampered at a vital stage and found the trip too short. Crystal Castle seems as effective over seven furlongs as he is over six and is worthy of respect, having captured the G3 Prix de Meautry at Deauville and G2 Diadem S. at Ascot two years ago. He recaptured his old spark when finishing a head runner-up to Fayr Jag (GB) in the G1 Golden Jubilee S. over Ascot's stiff six furlongs last time June 19.

Penalised for his runaway success in the two-mile G3 Queen's Vase at Royal Ascot last time June 18, he could be compromised by this drop back to a mile and a half. Maraahel has put up two fine weight-carrying performances in competitive handicaps only to finish second to Pukka (Ire) at Newbury May 15 and Admiral (Ire) at Royal Ascot last time June 17 and rates the biggest threat.

EXCITING STORY EUTHANIZED Canadian champion Exciting Story (Diablo--Appealing Story, by Valid Appeal) was euthanized recently due to a degenerating joint condition. The seven-year-old stallion, named Canada's champion juvenile of 1999, won that year's GIII Swynford S. and was third in the GI Hopeful S. In 2001, he won the GI Metropolitan H. and the GIII Vigil H. On the board in 14 of 25 starts, Exciting Story won seven races and earned \$911,270 for owner Mockingbird Farm. He entered stud in 2003 at Lane's End Texas and his first foals arrived this year. His health problems limited his book this season.

#### BAILEY TO RIDE PLEASANTLY PERFECT

Jockey Jerry Bailey will replace Alex Solis on MGISW Pleasantly Perfect (Pleasant Colony) in the GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar Aug. 22 and in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Lone Star Park Oct. 30, according to trainer Richard Mandella, but the ride is still up for grabs when the six-year-old returns to the track in Sunday's GII San Diego H. Solis, who was injured in a fall Friday at Del Mar, has ridden the Pleasantly Perfect in his last eight starts, including a victory in the G1 Dubai World Cup at Nad al Sheba in March, the bay's most recent start. Bailey has finished second on two occasions in the \$1million Pacific Classic, most recently with Medaglia d'Oro last year. Pleasantly Perfect, winner of eight of 15 starts, has amased \$6,699,880.




