a rousing victory over **Sightseek** (Distant View) in yesterday's GI Go For Wand H. Whispers of the sixyear-old's decline, spawned by listless off-the-board efforts in the May 31 GI Metropolitan H. and June 19 GI Ogden Phipps H., proved exaggerated as Azeri came out running and led the way with an ideally placed Sightseek sitting just off her flank. Sightseek was nudged on to draw on even terms nearing the quarter pole, but a resolute Azeri turned back the challenge and was

edging away as she hit the wire in stakes-record time. "We've had more than one horse that people have written off and have come back to win big," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "I never lost confidence in her. We'll enjoy this one." With the win, Azeri becomes the leading female money earner of all time, edging another Lukas trainee, the retired Spain. Go For Wand cont. p2

The victory, coming in the four-year-old gelding's stakes debut, ran his record to a perfect five-for-five. Claimed by trainer Jeff Mullins for \$40,000 out of his debut in February, Choctaw Nation was allowed to settle

nearly 10 lengths off the leading trio of **During** (Cherokee Run), **Taste of Paradise** (Conquistador Cielo) and Pleasantly Perfect as they cruised through a half in :47 2/5. Kicking into gear with his customary late run, the bay drew to within striking distance at the top of the lane, reeled in the game Pleasantly Perfect and asserted late to prevail as the public's third choice. "The only angle we had was the Dubai thing," admitted Mullins. "Everybody knows that horses usually don't fire the first time back from Dubai." 
Not Perfect, But Not Bad...



Jockey Keith Dalgleish has retired from riding, it was revealed yesterday. His agent Richard Hale confirmed the news to PA Sport yesterday. "He is over six feet tall, so it is an uphill struggle and it has presumably got the better of him," Hale said.
