SMARTY PARTY'S OVER

Smarty Jones (Elusive Quality--I'll Get Along, by Smile), who electrified the American public with his march through this spring's Triple Crown, has been retired from racing. Owners Roy and Pat Chapman announced yesterday their colt was found to have



bruising of the bottom of the cannon bone in all four fetlock joints, prompting the decision to retire him to Three Chimneys Farm in Midway, Kentucky. The injury would require three months of rest. "He'd start back in training about the time of the Breeders' Cup," explained Roy Chapman. "If everything went right, he might make the Dubai World Cup, but he might not. That's just too many 'ifs' for a horse of this caliber, who has done so much and who has

given us so much." The charismatic chestnut, beaten only once in nine starts, entered the Kentucky Derby with six straight wins under his belt, including a 1 1/2-length victory in the GII Arkansas Derby that stamped him as the Derby favorite. Smarty Jones splashed to a 2 3/4-length triumph in the Run for the Roses, becoming the first undefeated Derby winner since Triple Crown winner Seattle Slew and the Smarty legend was off to the races. In the first of two public morning appearances, a throng of adoring fans turned out to watch the Derby winner gallop around his home base of Philadelphia Park as he prepared for the GI Preakness. The colt affirmed their faith in him with a eye-popping 11 1/2-length victory in the second leg of the Triple Crown. In what would be the final start of his career, Smarty Jones was a gallant runner-up to the late-closing Birdstone. Original plans called for the colt to return to the races in the Sept. 6 GII Philadelphia Derby, but he was withdrawn from consideration for that race with a bruised foot. The cannon bone bruising was discovered when Smarty Jones underwent a nuclear scan last week to determine if his feet were ready for him to proceed with training. Cont. p. 2

"We consulted with [trainer] John Servis, our primary veterinarians and veterinarians in Kentucky," Roy Chapman said of the decision to retire his star. Multiple stakes winner I'll Get Along (Smile--Don't Worry Bout Me, by Foolish Pleasure), the dam of Smarty Jones, is set to go under the hammer at Fasig-Tipton's November Mixed Sale, it was announced yesterday by Fasig-Tipton and the dam's owner, Floridabased Cloverleaf Farms II. "We are honored to have the opportunity to sell this wonderful mare," Fasig-Tipton President Walt Robertson said of the 12-year-old bay. "Smarty Jones has been a positive force in the entire sporting world and his dam is a collector's item. In addition, she is in-foal to Elusive Quality and thus carrying a full sibling to Smarty Jones." A winner of 12 of 39 starts with earnings of \$277,008, I'll Get Along hit the national stage when her second foal, Smarty Jones, became the first horse since Seattle Slew to win the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness S. undefeated.

Back in early April, when forced to predict which of the numerous highly qualified new stallions would take the first-crop honors in Europe this year, I opted none too imaginatively, for Giant's Causeway. My choice was based largely on two factors. Firstly, this wonderfully tough and versatile performer appeared likely to have far more ammunition than many of his rivals, as his efforts during his single season in Ireland had produced a crop of 149 two-year-olds. Then there was his precocity to take into account. Giant's Causeway had recorded the first of his six Group 1 successes as a juvenile, during an unbeaten campaign which started in July, and precocity could be said to course through his veins. He's by Storm Cat, the third-best juvenile colt of 1985, and he's out of Mariah's Storm, who was rated only seven pounds inferior to the champion juvenile filly of 1993 after she'd taken the GII Arlington-Washington Lassie S.


Moving on to Giant's Causeway's grandparents, all four won at least twice at two and among them were champion Storm Bird, who remained unbeaten in his five juvenile starts, Terlingua, a sensation in her first four juvenile starts, and <u>Rahy</u>, who was second in the G1 Middle Park S. Surely, I reckoned, a background of this nature would hand Giant's Causeway a head start over the likes of Dubai Millennium and <u>Montjeu</u>. Perhaps I should have taken into account the widespread desire of mare owners to compensate for any shortcomings in their broodmares. For example, many a small stallion will initially be inundated with mares whose physiques are reminiscent of those old Soviet bloc shot-putters (even though these gargantuan mares tend to produce large foals, no matter how big the stallion). Similarly, many mares who needed time and/or distance are sent to stallions who possessed the speed and early maturity they lacked. Taken to extremes, the end result can be a serious dilution of the very qualities which made the stallion stand out on the track.

Giant's Causeway inevitably attracted his fair share of mares by stallions who shone over a mile and a quarter or a mile and a half with Shirley Heights, <u>Unbridled</u>, <u>A.P. Indy</u>, Rainbow Quest, Nijinsky II, Darshaan, Alysheba, <u>Sadler's Wells</u>, Generous, Secreto, Caerleon, Pleasant Colony, Nashwan and Seattle Slew among them.

In the circumstances, Giant's Causeway's career path at least with his Irish crop may take a somewhat different route from those of Storm Cat's more speed-oriented sons, such as <u>Hennessy</u>, <u>Tale of the</u> <u>Cat</u>, Forestry, Storm Boot and <u>Forest Wildcat</u>. He had had only two winners, the Italian Listed winner Aischa and Maids Causeway, by the end of June, but the winners are now beginning to flow, to the extent that he added five more individual winners to his tally during July.

The last 10 days of July were particularly encouraging. Maids Causeway failed by only a head to become stakes winner number two on the 22nd; another filly, Shohrah, made an eye-catching winning debut over six furlongs at Ascot on the 23rd; Shamardal then kept his unbeaten record intact with an impressive all-the-way victory in the G2 Veuve Clicquot Vintage S. on the 28th; and finally Road Rage beat some well-bred fillies over seven furlongs at Newmarket on the 31st.

The victories of Shohrah, Road Rage and Shamardal suggest that Giant's Causeway is indeed capable of injecting some speed into middle-distance mares. Shohrah's dam, the Nashwan mare Tagreem, was suited by a mile and a half, while Road Rage's dam Endorsement was a group winner over two miles. Shamardal's dam Helsinki was very much at home over a mile and a quarter and the colt's second dam, Helen Street, stayed well enough to win the Irish Oaks. Shamardal is by no means the first good two-year-old from this family, as Helen Street was a Group 3 winner at two and Helsinki's brother Street Cry was third in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile. It's an exciting thought, though, that this family tends to improve with age, so Shamardal could easily help move Giant's Causeway higher up the Anglo-Irish first-crop sire table than his current position of second to Namid.

Although it is too early to be looking for traits in the pedigrees of Giant's Causeway's winners, the many breeders who have used him since his move to Ashford will be encouraged by the prominence of the Mr. Prospector line. Aischa's dam is by Zafonic, who was by Mr. Prospector's son <u>Gone West</u>, while Shamardal's broodmare sire Machiavellian and Maids Causeway's broodmare sire <u>Kingmambo</u> are both by Mr. Prospector. Could it be that Giant's Causeway is going to prove equally well suited to Mr. Prospector line mares as his illustrious sire?

BUDDY GIL CO-OWNER HITS RECORD \$2.1 MILLION PICK 6 AT DEL MAR Scott Guenther. whose Desperado Stables is a partner in GISW Buddy Gil, was a major shareholder in the lone winning Pick Six ticket at Del Mar Sunday that paid a California record \$2,100,117. There was a two-day carryover of \$717,343 before an additional \$2,490,228 was wagered on Sunday's card, pushing the Pick Six pool to \$3,207571. The winning ticket was purchased on track at Del Mar for \$1,176. In an interesting twist, Guenther retains the services of trainer Jeff Mullins, who played no small part in Sunday's winning ticket. With the first four legs all going to non-favorites (Gent, \$11; Smokette, \$17.60; longshot bomb Short Route, \$106.20; and Ya Lajwaad, \$15.40), the last two races were taken by Mullins' runners. First, he sent out Choctaw Nation to an upset win over Pleasantly Perfect in the GII San Diego H., then his Golden Souvenir won the card's finale, a maiden special weight, as the second betting choice. Five of six winners paid \$8,230.20. The national record Pick Six payoff of \$3,068,138.60 was hit on Nov. 6, 1999 when Cat Thief's Classic victory keyed a massive single ticket in the Breeders' Cup Ultra Pick Six.

FALLON INQUIRY CHALLENGED

Kieren Fallon may not have to face the proposed Jockey Club inquiry into allegations by the News of the World paper that he fixed races in exchange for reward, the Racing Post revealed yesterday. In a new development, the champion jockey's legal team have unearthed tape recordings which could lead to a challenge in the High Court to next month's planned inquiry. In the recordings, Fallon is heard to say, "I did not tell you to back the horses so I could get money," before adding, "I've never done it in my life and I never will do it. I like riding horses and I like winning." His solicitor Christopher Stewart-Moore labeled the disrepute charge as "unsustainable," adding, "If we feel the procedures being adopted by the Jockey Club in the conduct of this inquiry breach the rules of natural justice, then we may have to seek guidance by the High Court." John Maxse responded to the Post, "At the end of the road is the disciplinary panel. In the interim, there is scope for their legal teams to consult with ours to try to establish some common ground."
