A Budding Superstar at Four...

Off for over seven months following his effort in the Jerome, Roses In May hinted at his true ability in a second-level Keeneland allowance Apr. 17, defeating a good horse in Best Minister by 12 lengths. He tacked on a five-length success in a May 21 optional claimer at Churchill Downs and completed step one of his ascent to prominence with a front-running defeat of Perfect Drift (Dynaformer) in the GIII Prairie Meadows Cornhusker Breeders' Cup H. in Iowa July 3.

Deja Vu All Over Again...

The stakes were higher and the competition deeper this time around, which resulted in post-time odds of 7-1 on Roses In May. Yessirgeneralsir (Patton) was quarter-horsed away from the gate and set suicidal fractions of :45.25 for the half and 1:08.92 for six furlongs, shadowed all the while by Roses In May and a three-wide Peace Rules (Jules). Asked to go after the pacesetter at the quarter pole by jockey Edgar Prado, Roses In May took control in upper stretch, but was quickly joined by an onrushing Perfect Drift. The latter got half a head in front inside the final 100 yards, but Roses In May showed the heart of a champion and dug in tenaciously for a richly deserved victory.

The Aftermath...

"It went just as I hoped it would play out," said trainer Dale Romans, winning the first Grade I of his career. "The fractions were fast, but my main concern was Peace Rules and he was right there with us. So, if [the pace] was going to affect us, it was going to affect him. I knew Perfect Drift would come running and when we got head-to-head, it was just a matter of who would outgame the other." For Peace Rules, it was a rare off day. "They were going too fast for me," said his jockey Jerry Bailey. "He just didn't throw his best dart today."

Bwana Charlie registered back-to-back victories at Fair Grounds, by a half length going six furlongs Feb. 8 and by 11 3/4 going a two-turn mile Mar. 6. The bay made it three straight with a 3 1/4-length win over Quick Action (Carson City) in the Apr. 4 GIII Lafayette S. at Keeneland, but had gone winless since, finishing third in the GIII Derby Trial Apr. 24, a head second in the Hirsch Jacobs S. on the Preakness undercard May 15 and most recently third to Weigelia and Classy Migration (Migrating Moon) in the GIII Carry Back S. at Calder July 10. Settled at the rear after breaking a bit slowly, Bwana Charlie began to roll at the quarter pole, came out in upper stretch and finished full of run for the win. The odds-on entry had to settle for minor placings in that event, however, as Medallist sped to a 3 1/4length score, with The Cliff's Edge second and Sir Shackleton far from disgraced in third. The slight choice against lesser rivals here, the Tracy Farmer homebred was restrained off the moderate pace set by Britt's Jules, started to close ground as they raced around the far turn and was kept to the task as the pacesetter shortened stride, driving to the front inside the final sixteenth and drawing clear. Holiday makers and serious racing connoisseurs will be treated to a feast of speed as the majority of the best sprinters in training are assembled for this intriguing affair. With only four in the line-up not having won a group race, the quality is spread across the track and that should benefit Frizzante, who showed when beating **Ashdown Express** in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket last time July 8 that she excels when she has class horses to aim at. Overnight rain helped on that occasion, as the bay struggled on a fast surface when third in the G2 King's Stand S. at Royal Ascot previously June 15. Like that filly, **Somnus** is a Group 1 winner looking for ease in the ground to revive old fortunes. He should reverse placings with Royal Millennium on better weight terms than when second in the G3 Chipchase S. at Newcastle June 26. Somnus comes off a troubled trip in the July Cup last time, where he could do no better than fifth. Of the sophomores, Whipper has strong claims, having won the G1 Prix Morny at this track last August. He confirmed his position as France's top sprinting juvenile when winning the G2 Criterium de Maisons-Laffitte in October and returned with a scintillating display in the soft when taking the Listed Prix Djebel back at that track Apr. 6. He may not have seen out the mile when fifth in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 1 and warrants respect.

The dark bay filly posted a 17-length score in the Mar. 6 California Oaks at Golden Gate Fields and added a 1 3/4-length victory in the Apr. 9 GII Fantasy S. at Oaklawn Park, but couldn't handle the off going in the Apr. 30 GI Kentucky Oaks and finished eighth. The Cal-bred rebounded from that effort to go gate to wire in the June 12 GII Hollywood Breeders' Cup Oaks.
